303 GROCERY KITS DISTRIBUTED AT LEPROSY VILLAGE, KONDHWA, PUNE.

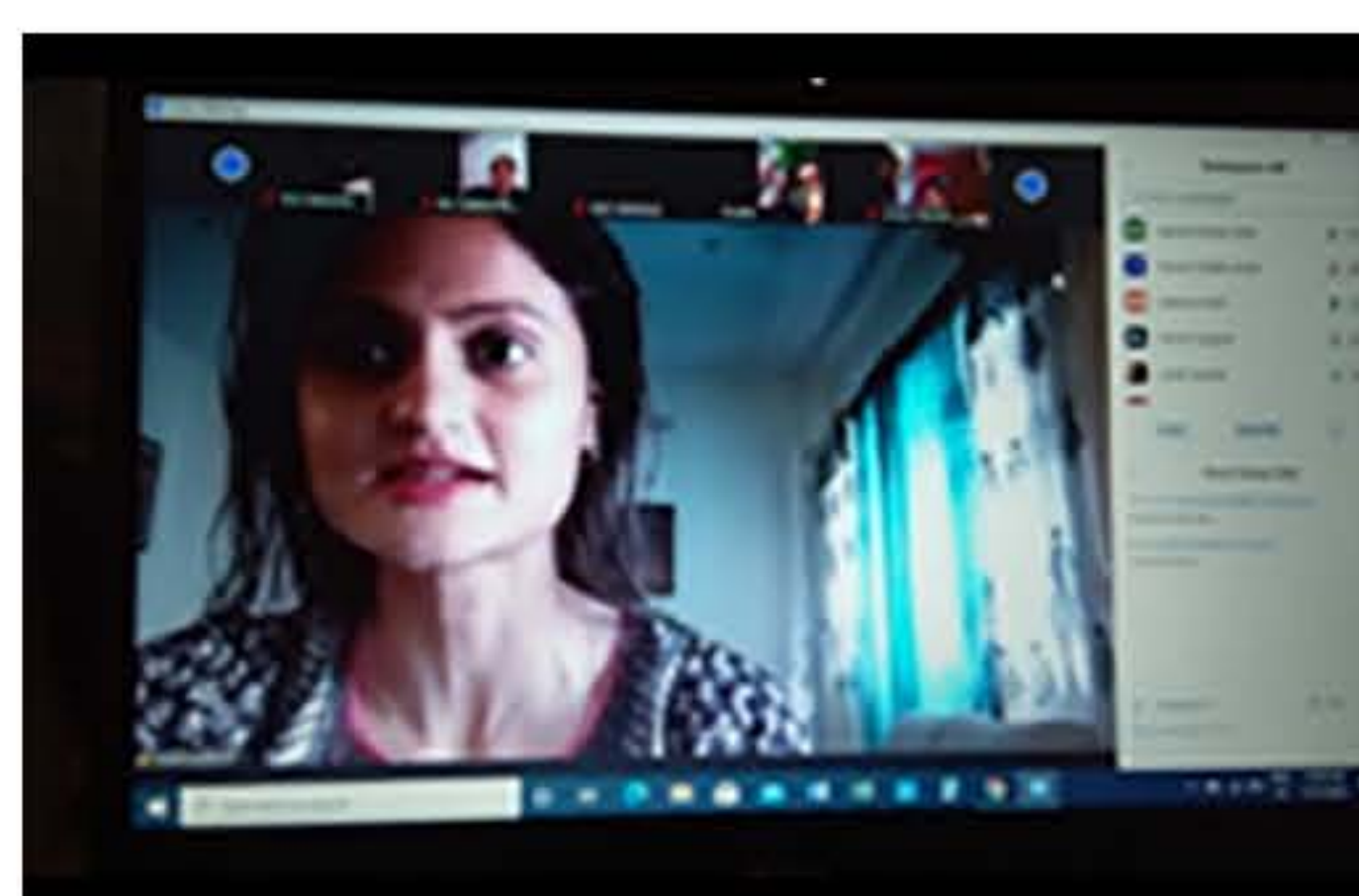
FIL/MMF extended their support to Leprosy Village at Kondhwa, Pune by distributing 303 grocery kits.



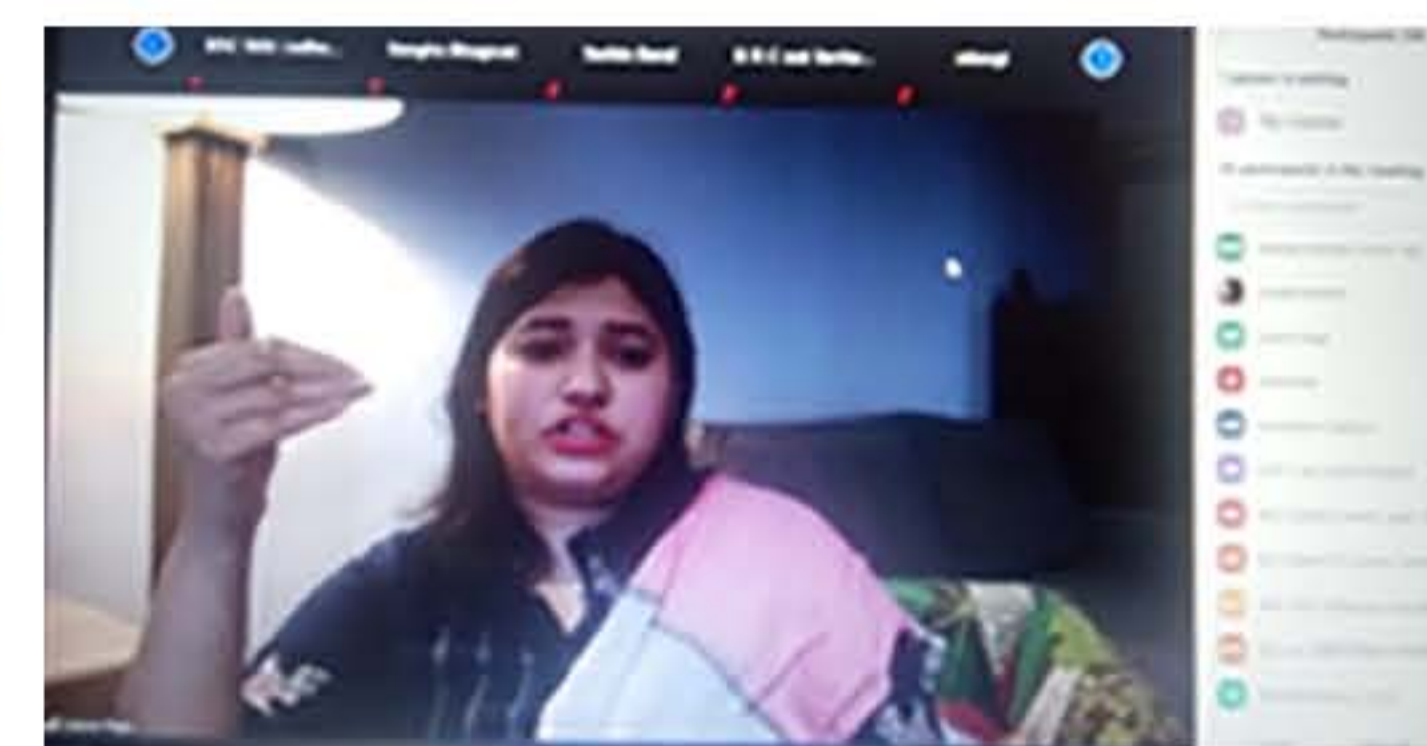
ONLINE EVENTS

8 DAYS OLD BABY GIVEN A SECOND CHANCE AT LIFE

8 days old baby born at Sassoon General Hospital was diagnosed with critical congenital heart disease requiring urgent cardiac surgery.

Father of child who works as mechanic at Garage near CME Gate, Pune appealed for help to Mukul Madhav Foundation. After consulting Dr. Naik of Jupiter Hospital, Pune we came to know that baby would require a palliative Midline modified BT Shunt to save the child.

Managing Trustee Mrs. Ritu Prakash Chhabria generously stepped in to support. Baby was moved to Jupiter Hospital from Sassoon NICU and got operated. We are glad to share that baby is now hale & hearty.
