**IMPORTANCE OF HEALTH & HYGIENE**

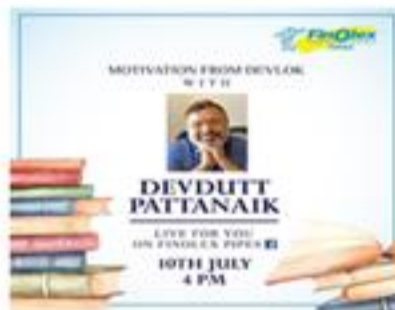
