PHC Graduation Ceremony at Bhavdan, Satara District

Mukul Madhav Foundation & Finolex Pipes went into backward integration while working among children affected with Cerebral Palsy to know the root cause of the deformity. A study showed that complications during high risk pregnancy is the main cause for this. At this juncture MMF/FIL collaborated with Symbiosis College of Nursing, Pune to create a programme to train the grass root level workers, the ASHA (health workers) & ANM nurses. This programme aims at reducing the high risk pregnancy cases & incidences of mismanaged labor with a view to reduce birth deformity among the new born.

On 23rd September 2017, 40 trainees have been awarded certificates on successful completion of this training at Bhavdan PHC.

Representatives from the ZP of Wai & Satara, medical officers, FIL local dealers, FIL representatives, and Symbiosis staff were present at the event along with our team.

We are highly obliged by the appreciation received from the government authorities & from all those who have been a backbone for this initiative.

Physiotherapy Camp at Ratnagiri

Mukul Madhav Foundation organized health camps from the 18th to 22nd September at three schools namely Archarya Vinoba Bhave Timber market Pune, Kasturbha Ghandhi School, Koregaon Park & Mathoshree English Medium school Yerawada.

The medical team comprised of doctors from H V Desai Eye Hospital, Sassoon Hospital, KEM Hospital and Bharti Vidyapeeth. A total of 1259 students were assessed to whom necessary medical advices was provided. Students who were diagnosed with complications or problems related to dental issues, speech & ENT have been referred to various hospitals for further treatment.

Each child was also given a small hygiene hamper comprising of Soap, Tooth Brush, tooth paste & some snacks for adequate care. We are monitoring the process closely to ensure treatment is given to each & every child, with the hope of curing these ailments.






Physiotherapy Camp at Ratnagiri
