Pipeline work at Wadgoan Anand

An appeal was received from the governor of Maharashtra to provide pipes to Wadgoan Anand village to bring water from the source to the destination. A bund has been evacuated to lay the pipe line which is 2 km. This will service water requirements to 3000 nearby villages in the radius. The work is in progress and due to be completed shortly.

Skilling Centre - Ratnagiri

The Skilling centre began in 2008 at Pawas and then relocated to Phansop and Golap. It has now been relocated at Bhatye Beach and was inaugurated by coconut breaking by the Sarpanch, Mr. Bhatkar followed by ribbon cutting by Dy. Sarpanch Mrs.Naik. The women are skilled in tailoring and we have appointed a tutor who is at the centre from Monday to Saturday.





Donation to Ashadeep

MMF/ FIL began supporting Ashadeep, a residential facility for mentally abled children by providing grocery for Rs. 5000/- on a monthly basis. Last year the amount was increased to Rs. 9000/- after reviewing their need. The concept 'Ek Mutti Annaj Ki' was introduced to students of MMV and since last 2 years they have donated 70 kg rice to this organization. Taking this association forward MMV donated a gas stove and 17 chairs worth Rs. 15,200/- which is a profit acquired from sale of Macmillan books to students. We thank Macmillan for providing this discount with which we were able to help for a Nobel cause.

It is a 3 month training given to the students following which they undergo a test. The centre has skilled more than 100 women till date. Many women have started earning their livelihoods after undergoing the training and in the process earning respect in their homes and community.

Training of PMC nurses & doctors at Sassoon / Deenanath / Bharathi

In light of Children's Day, Mukul Madhav Foundation & Finolex Pipes has begun fulfilling an appeal received from the commissioner of the Pune Municipal Corporation for the development of 4 NICU wards that will cater to the children of Pune. The appeal has requested the construction & refurbishment of 4 NICU wards in PMC hospitals Kamla Nehru, Rajiv Gandhi, Sonawane & Dalvi Hospital.

While the construction of NICU wards are being completed, MMF took the initiative to begin the training of 8 doctors & 24 nurses to CPAP level at NICU present hospitals such as Sassoon General, Deenanath Mangeshkar & Bharthi Hospital under the guidance of doctors Aarti Kinikar, Rajan Joshi & Pradeep Suryawanshi.

Post training, the doctors & staff will be appointed to the upcoming NICU wards of Kamla Nehru Hospital, Rajiv Gandhi Hospital, Sonawane Hospital & Dalvi Hospital. Two of the Four NICU wards will be inaugurated by March 2018 with the goal of providing specialized care for newborn children.

Mental Illness Workshop at Satara for ZP teachers

On 18th November, 2017, Mukul Madhav Foundation & Finolex Pipes took a step towards improving the face of mental healthcare in India by organizing a 2-day training program on Mental Illness for the primary teachers of Zilla Parishad Schools alongside the faculty of Sassoon General Hospital.

This program was organized with the aim to assess the mental health of the students in the school and to improve the skills of teachers to identify children with special needs. Furthermore, an advanced training course will be provided by the UK team of Concern for Mental Health & Illness in February.





Monthly Diabetic Camp KEM

Monthly diabetic camp was conducted on 18th November at KEM hospital. 20 patients have benefited form this camp and insulin was provided to 3 patients.





Medical camp at Schools (Khandala, Umbraj, Takari & Pali)

Mukul Madhav Foundation organised a medical health check-up camp for all the students from Junior Kg to 10th Std at schools mentioned below from 21st to 25th November 2017.

The health camp was organised with the objective of providing free medical examination /check -up ,with the help of doctors from H.V Desai Eye Hospital, Bharti Dental and ENT Hospital, which included General Physical examination, measurement of height and weight, Dental Check-up, Eye Check-up, ENT Check-up, Necessary medical advice and precautionary measures were given to the students. 3030 students have availed the benefit of this camp.

The training program included 5 sessions for 8 hours each.

44 ASHA and ANM nurses graduated on 23rd September at Bavdhan, in light of which a lunch party was organized to celebrate their experiences & success stories on 24th November 2017. The event was attended by a medical officer of PHC, Finolex staff, MMF team and a gynaecologist from Sassoon General Hospital, Pune.

It brings us great joy in sharing this, that by the end of March 2018, we will have 582 ASHA / ANM trained in this field from 12 PHC's in Satara.
