PMC signs MOU with FIL / MMF to upgrade Corporation Hospitals

Finolex Pipes and Mukul Madhav Foundation have always strived to improve & upgrade the existing medical facilities for the greater benefit of the society.

Looking at our successful implementation of NICU at Sassoon General Hospital, we were invited by the Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC) Commissioner

Hon. Mr. Kunal Kumar and Guardian Minister Hon. Mr. Girish Bapat to provide a similar state-of-the-art NICU facility at PMC hospitals, namely Rajiv Gandhi Hospital, Sonawane Hospital, Dalvi Hospital and Kamla Nehru Hospital. Once these NICUs start functioning, expert medical care for new born babies will be made available free of cost.

Furthermore, specialised training and upgradation will also be provided to 8 doctors & 29 nurses at hospitals with existing NICU facilities, such as Sassoon General Hospital, Deenanath Mangeshkar Hospital & Bharati Hospital under the able guidance of Dr.Aarti Kinikar, Dr.Rajan Joshi & Dr.Pradeep Suryawanshi respectively. We hope to enhance the quality of healthcare services & uplift the economically weaker sections of the society!





Consultation Camp at Ratnagiri

A special consultation camp was organized by MMF / FIL in which 23 women were screened in October 2017 for cancer issues and were diagnosed with problems. Dr. Koppiker from the Prashanti Cancer Centre Pune went to Ratnagiri to examine the patients over two days.



Free Health Camp at Schools

In continuation of our endeavor to provide health care facilities to the underprivileged & raise healthy children in our society. Mukul Madhav Foundation organized a regular health check-up camp for the students of ZP schools in Neware, Basin, Kothawde, Khedshi, Gaokhadi, Purnagarh and our own MMV between 11th to 15th December 2017, where a total of 1921 students were screened.

Along with the doctors from KEM hospital, H V Desai Eye Hospital, Bharti Dental and ENT Hospital, we assessed students for physical examination, Dental, Eye & ENT checkup & advised necessary health safety measures for their well-being.





Health Camp at Red Cross Society

Niwant, an organization for grown up visually challenged students, approached FIL / MMF to help them conduct a health camp for their students. On 19th & 20th December, MMF / FIL along with the Red Cross society provided doctors and medical assistance.





Graduation Ceremony - Wai

FIL & MMF in association with Symbiosis College of Nursing began training ASHA & ANM nurses at grass root level to identify complications in high risk pregnancy and right methods of labour in the region of Satara since May 2017. Post completion of training assessments were conducted to assess their ability to identify issues raised during labor. We conducted a graduation ceremony on 23rd September 2017 at Bavdhan where 44 nurses graduated. On 29th December, we had another batch of 147 ANM & ASHA nurses who graduated at Wai. This event was attended by Medical officers, Panchayat Samiti President, BDO and other ZP members.

By end of March 2018 we will have 582 ASHA / ANM nurses trained in this field from 12 PHC's in Satara.

Free spectacles were sponsored by H V Desai Hospital to the Children diagnosed with vision problems at the health camp conducted in November.

Donation to Sassoon General Hospital

On behalf of Mukul Madhav Foundation & Finolex Pipes, Gayatri Prakash Chhabria donated OAE & ROP machines with computers, as well as glucometers & other such equipment for upgrading the medical facilities at Sassoon General Hospital, the only tertiary hospital in Pune.

The contribution was made in the presence of Dr. Aarti Kinikar - Neo-natologist, Dr. Ajay Chandanwalle - Dean, Dr. Ambekar - Ophthalmic Department, Dr. Sameer Joshi - ENT Department and other prominent doctors.

Through these donations, we continue to work towards the betterment of healthcare services in our country.

Mental Illness Training at Wai

Nearly 150 teachers along with MMV's teachers Ms. Pallavi Bobade and Ms. Ashvani Joshi participated in MMF/ FIL's initiative towards improving the face of mental healthcare in India by organizing a 2-day training program on Mental Illness for the primary teachers of Zilla Parishad Schools Wai on 2nd and 3rd December 2017 alongside the faculty of Sassoon General Hospital.

Cochlear Implant Surgeries

Cochlear Implant surgeries were performed on Aditya Pawar, Pratiksha Sawant and Vaibhav Dorge with MMF contributing partly to meet their medical assistance.

FIL / MMF successfully opened 2 computer centers at MMP Samplawala School & Masar Primary School where 5 computers along with a computer tutor was provided to both the schools. The school is grateful for our step taken towards improving education & inculcating computer literacy to students which will help them in their future.





RO System at Indapur

An RO System has been donated to the community at Indapur which will benefit 3242 people. The installation of the same was completed on 30th December 2017.

RO System Inaugurated at Abhor Village

The Abhor Grampanchayat appealed to MMF / FIL to repair the RO which was installed by the government. Inspection of the system was undertaken by the FIL CSR team to ascertain working conditions and repair the same accordingly. The repair work completed successfully and the RO was inaugurated in the presence of FIL team and the Masar Grampanchayat on 11th December 2017, benefitting nearly 2500 villagers.



Poona Blind Men's Association (PBMA) Sponsorship

FIL has set up a call center at PBMA for equipping the blind girls with employment opportunities. From a total of 11, presently, 5 girls are being sponsored along with a trainer, and are accessing FIL's toll free number to answer queries from customers regarding FIL pipes.





Lights at Gametha Village

70 LED lights have been provided to Gametha village in the first phase. The villagers are happy to see their village lit up as there was no provision of electricity available to them.

Donation to Sainik Board

Our Mission Cerebral Palsy Project began in the month of November 2015 where Mukul Madhav Foundation & Finolex Pipes donated 178 wheelchairs, 104 commode chairs at homes & 100 Cerebral Palsy chairs in the Zilla Parishad schools.

Having identified a total of 742 CP children at Satara & Ratnagiri, we have also successfully started rehab centres for them at Satara, Wai, Panchgani, Patan, Dervan and Finolex Colony in Ratnagiri. Furthermore, we are providing pick up and drop off facilities for these patients.

We have collected fees amounting to Rs. 4,670/- (Rs. 10/- per patient) for the month of November while conducting these physiotherapy sessions at Ratnagiri, which has been donated to the Sainik board for the upliftment of the armed force widows.

Educational assistance amounting to Rs.2,50,543/- was provided to 12 students












