Mission Cerebral Palsy remains unstoppable

- Cerebral Palsy (CP) has been one of the closest projects that MMF has been relentlessly working since 2015 in the districts of Satara and Ratnagiri.
- What started with simple donations of special modified furniture articles, slowly saw teams of doctors comprising of neurosurgeons, orthopedicians, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, speech therapists, orthotists and optometrists from renowned hospitals of Pune come together for assessment camps and regular therapy sessions for these children.
- As on date 15 assessment camps have been completed and 986 children are on records with CP.
- April 2020 marked the third year with the beginning of the rehabilitation center at Finolex Colony, Zadgoan, Ratnagiri. They have appointed a physiotherapist and a speech therapist who provide their services on a daily basis.



Mission Cerebral Palsy remains unstoppable

- FIL/MMF initiated online therapy and patients are being guided through the generous support of the therapists planned by the dynamic team of MMF through Skype and WhatsApp Video Calls. Each parent is getting individual time over the phone via live sessions.
- We have had 103 kids enrolled during the last 3 months of the lockdown taking therapy on a daily basis from Satara, Wai, Panchgani-Mahabaleshwar, Patan and Ratnagiri. The network of Special Educator, Sarv Shiksha Abhiyan GoM has helped us to reach out to many CP Children that have come on board for the first time.
- We thank the authorities in Ratnagiri and Satara for their support towards this mission.
- MMF strives for inclusion of CP patients into society in order to ensure that they and those who care for them live the best possible life under these peculiar circumstances in which they find themselves and during these times of the lockdown and pandemic.

Supporting Young Girls with Sanitary Napkins

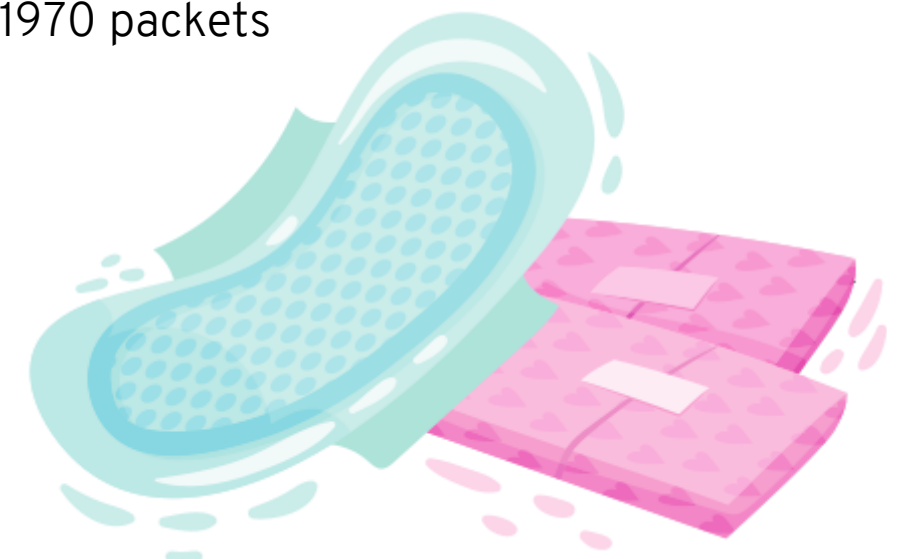
FIL and MMF collaborated with **Krishi Vidyan Kendra, Baramati** to procure sanitary towels for the welfare of the girls in our society.

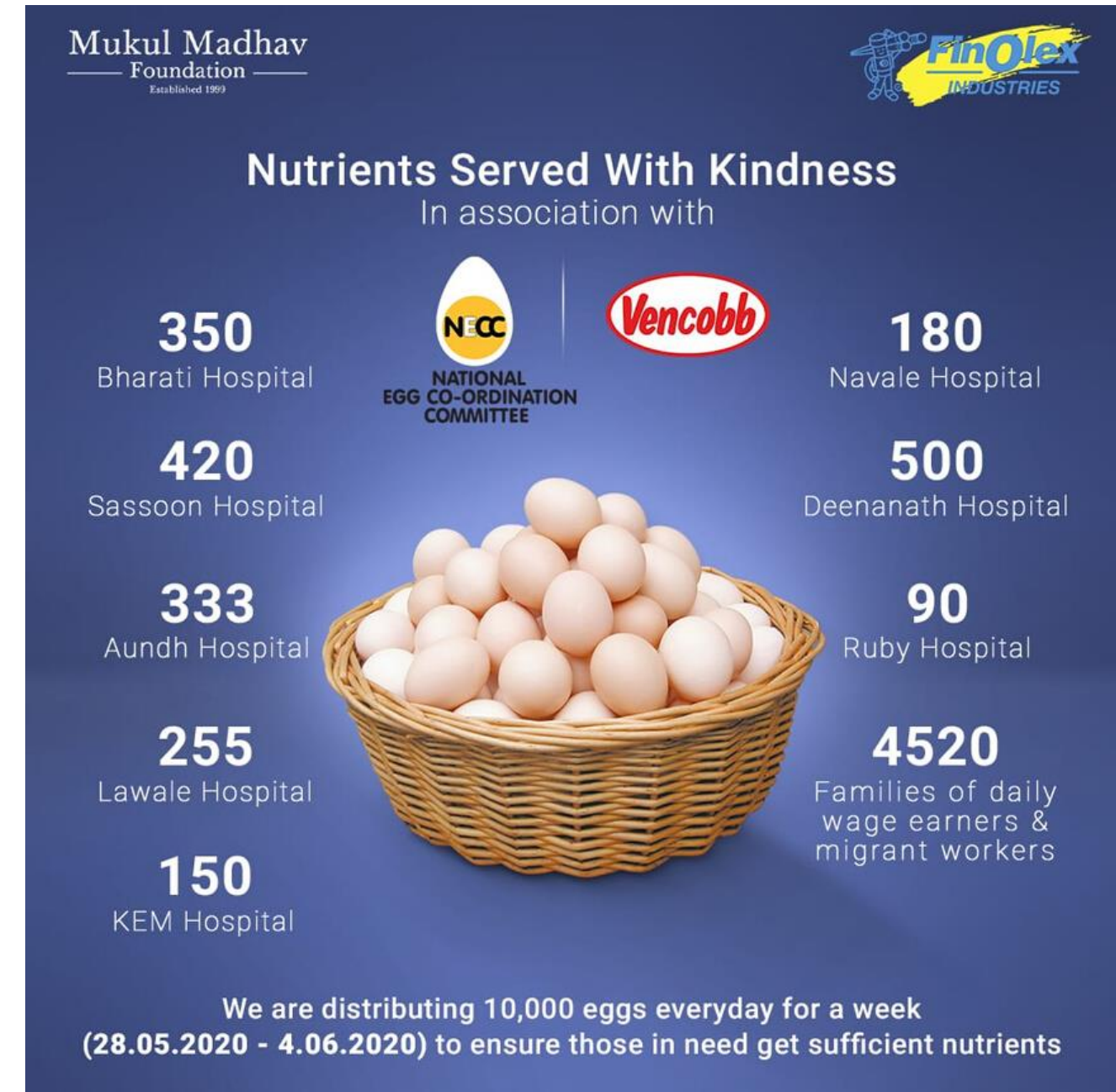

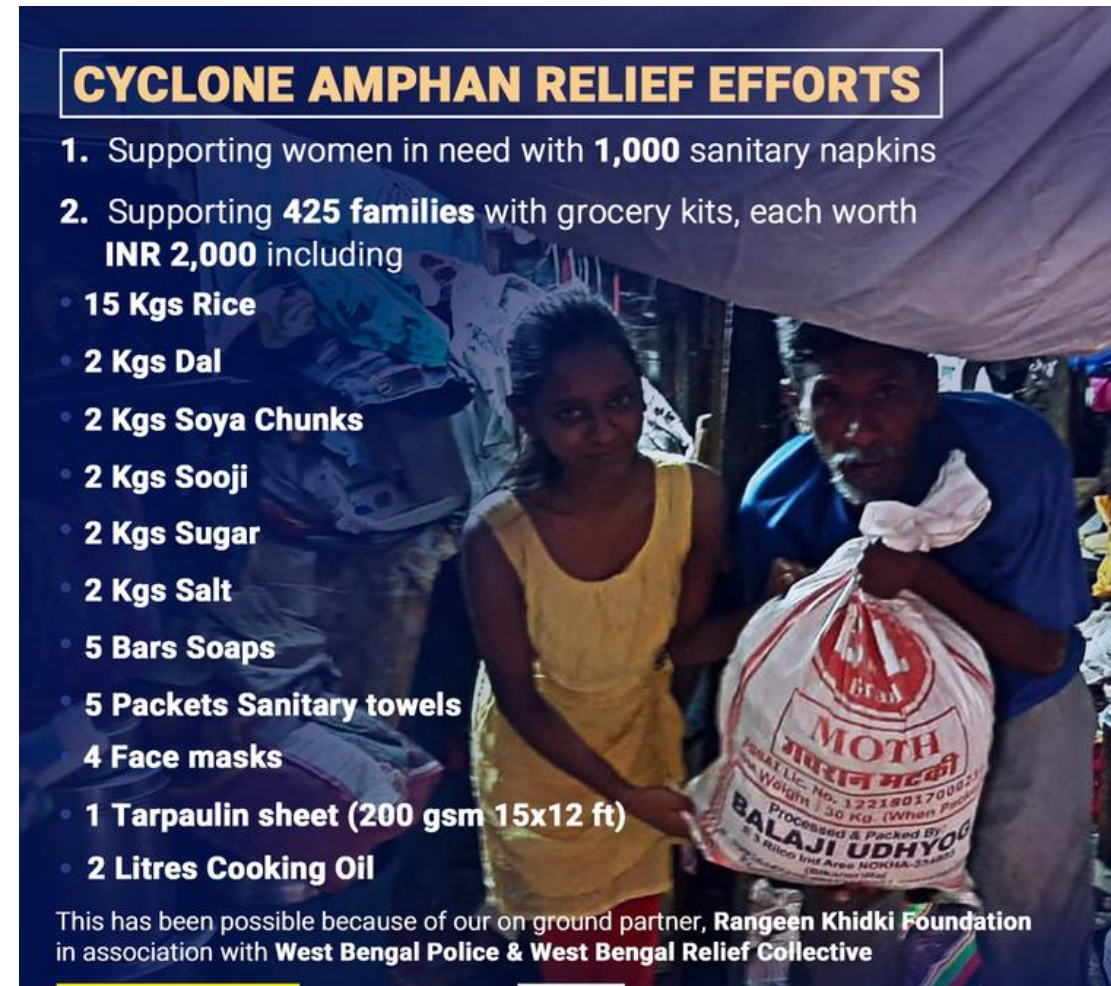

Mukul Madhav Foundation supported the donors with mask , & snacks maintaining the social distancing.



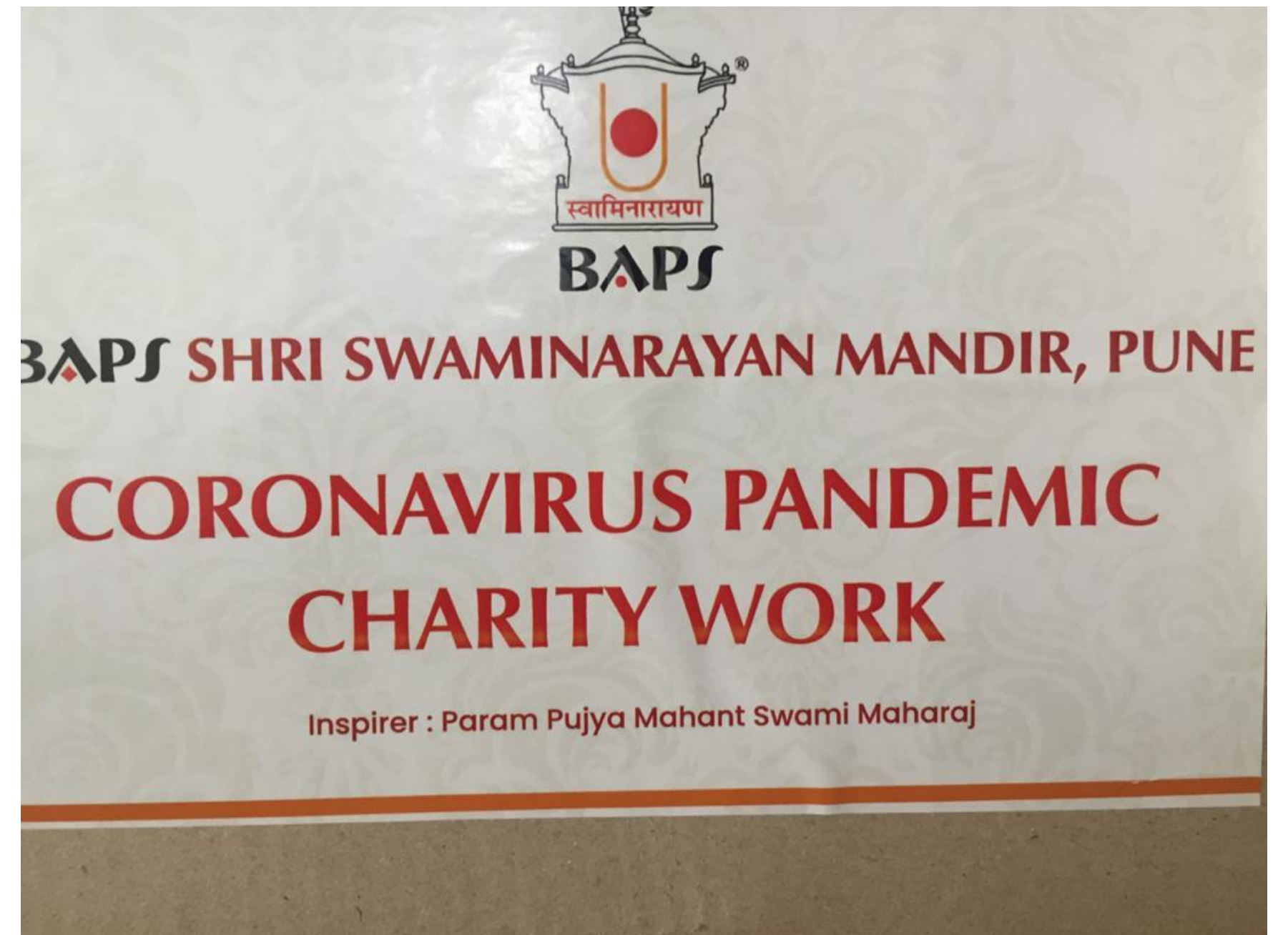

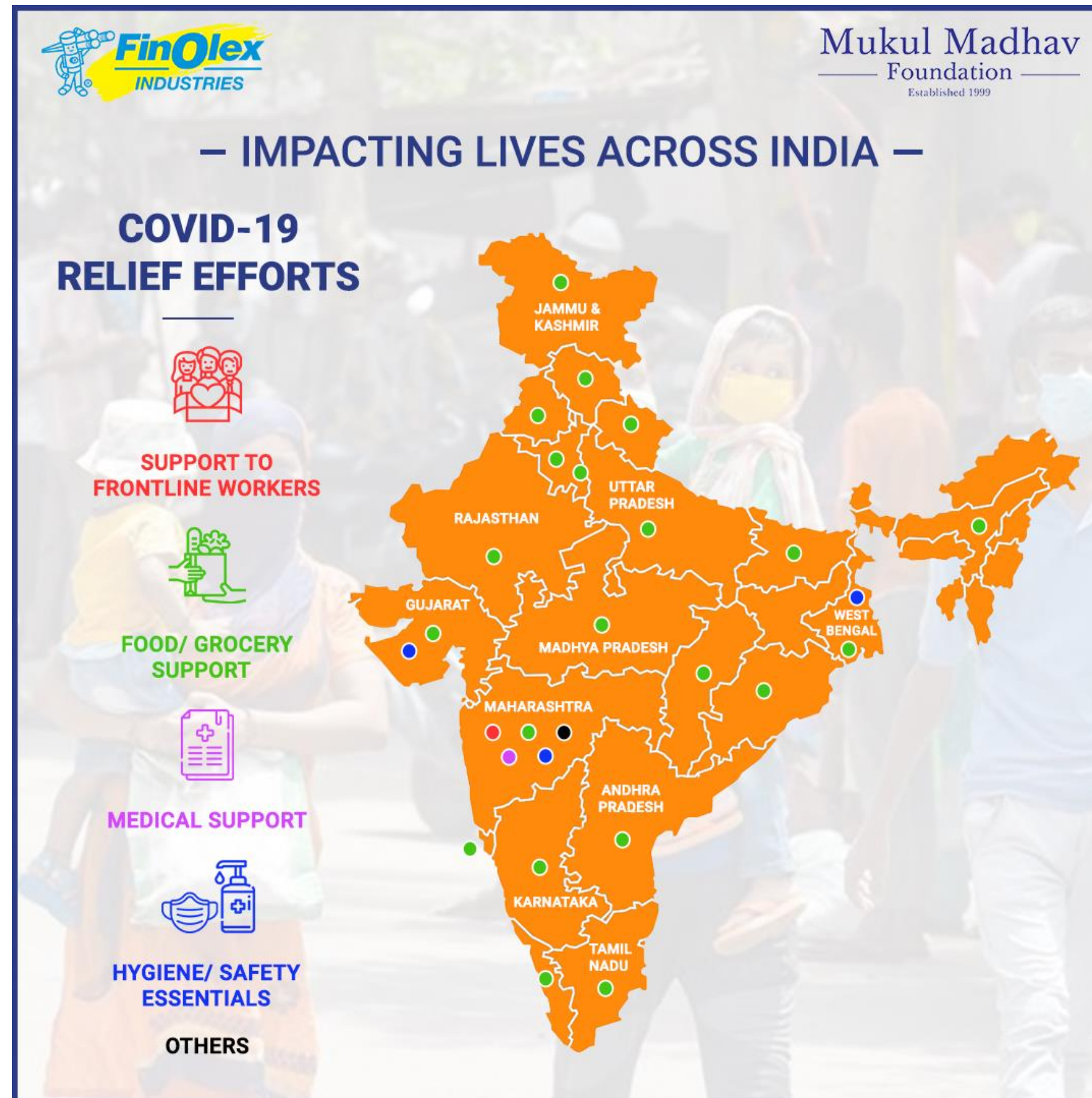
