

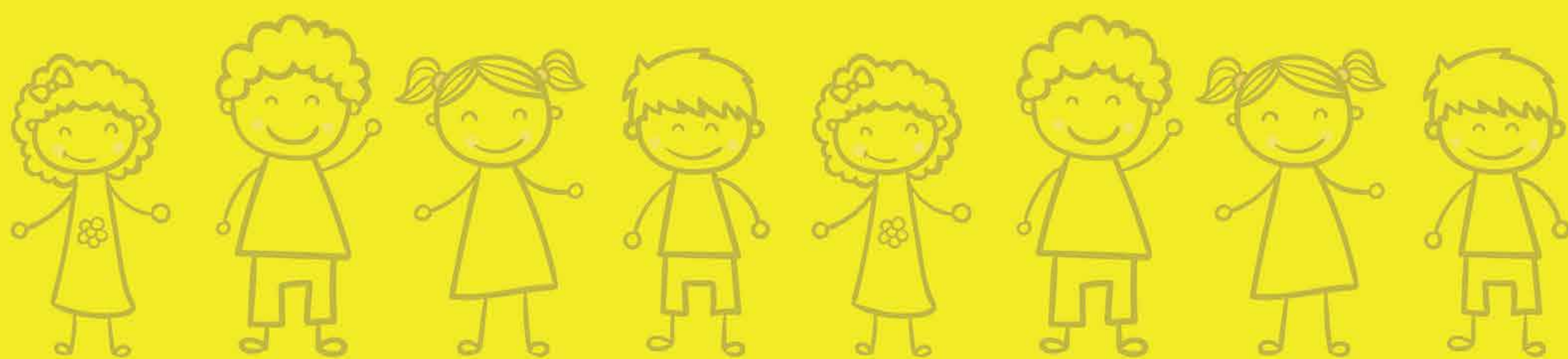

When First lady of Maharashtra comes visiting...

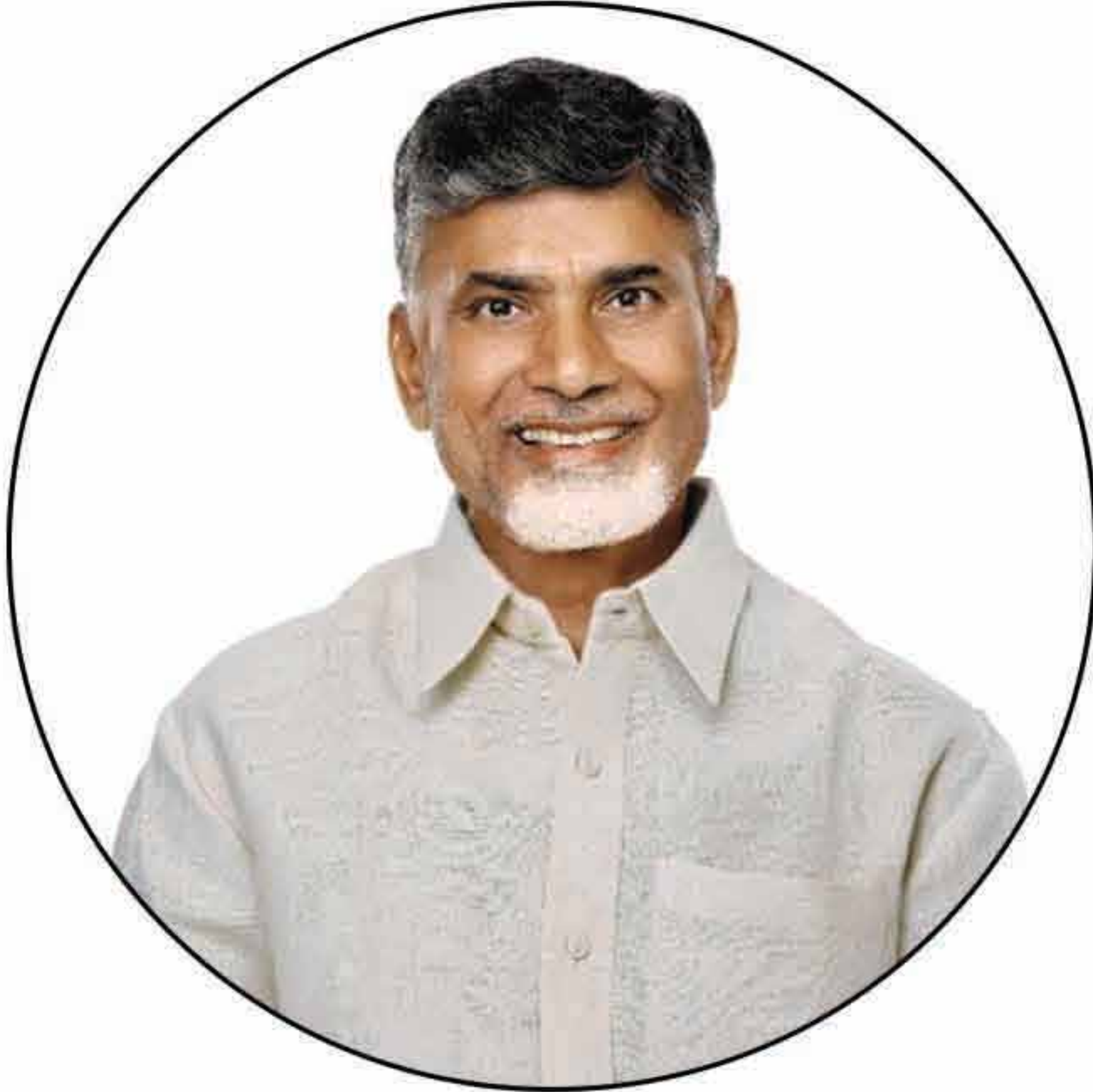

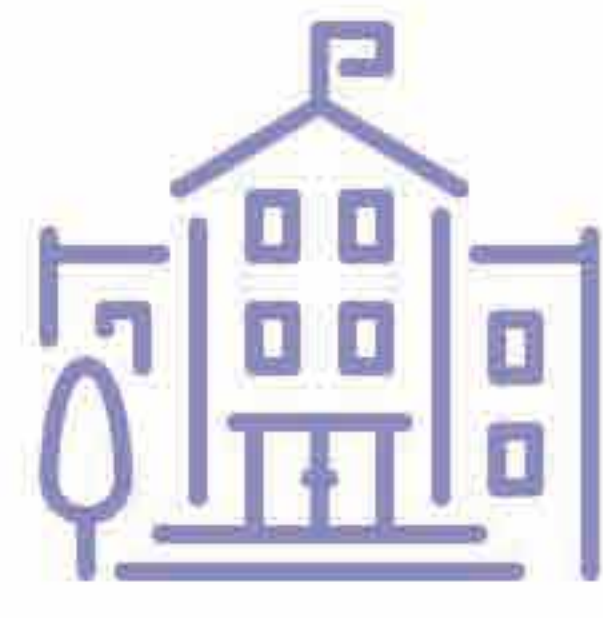




Zakir Hussain event

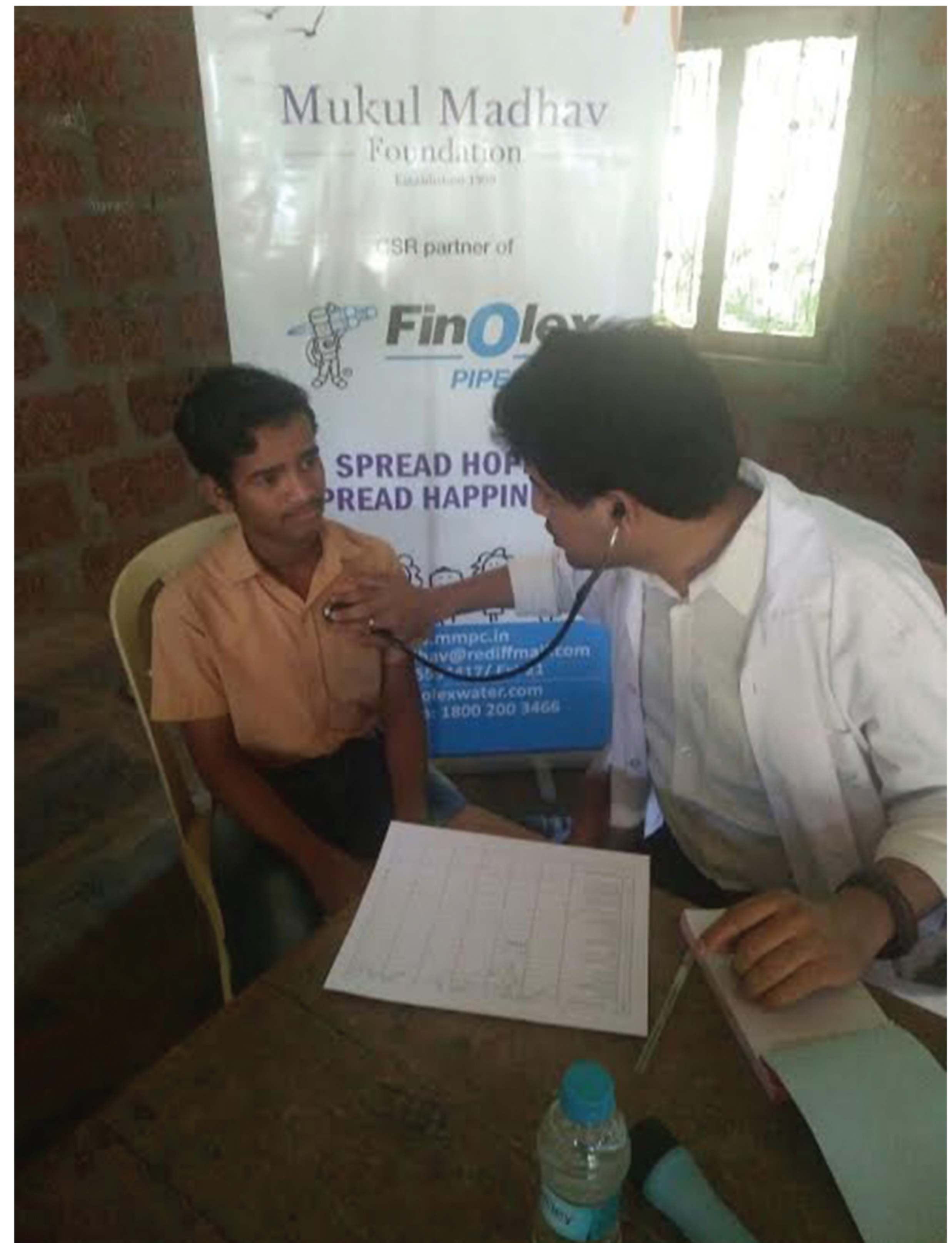
Oral Cancer Detection Camp



The Oral cancer detection camp was organised on the 8th and 9th of February for the direct and contractual employees of Finolex Industries Limited. As many as 872 people benefited by the camp. As per the recommendations of the doctors, follow up checks for the short listed cases for treatment and counselling are to be done.

Medical camp at Ratnagiri

A medical camp was held in Ratnagiri from Feb 8th to 11th. A total of 1705 students from the villages of Neware, Dhamanase, Kotawade, Khedashi, Purnagad and Gavkhadi were examined. With the consent of the parents, the treatment of the detected cases will be done.

On a visit...

A total of 28 students of class VII of Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya went on an industrial visit to the water treatment plant and the pipes section of Finolex industries, Ratnagiri on the 16th of February. They were accompanied by Ms.Pallavi Bobde, Mr.Rushikesh Shelar and Mr.Ravi Mayangade. Students interacted with resource heads of various departments and asked their minds out. A short audio-visual presentation was shown which helped the students understand the processes well. Students also visited the jetty to witness the process of loading and unloading of the cargo.



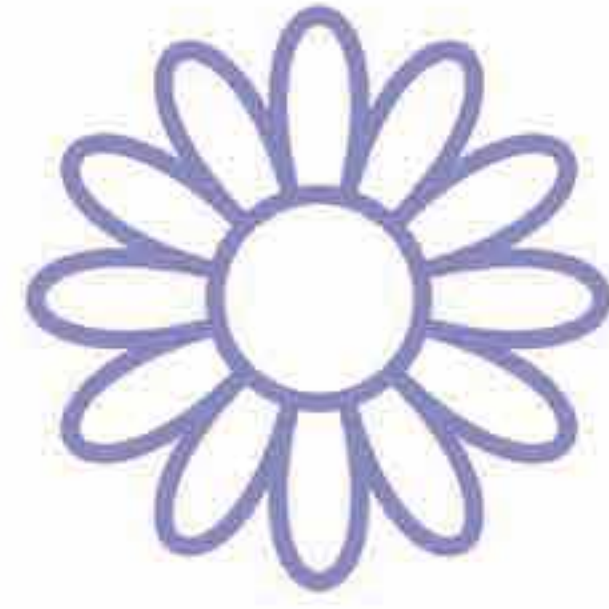
Gaining skills

The skill development centres in the two remote villages of Masar and Abhor in Gujarat conducts a 3-month certification course in computer and tailoring, for both women and students at subsidized cost. A total of 16 people took up the examination in computers in Masar and 15 passed the same. In Abhor, 12 students who wrote the computer exam came out with flying colours. In the sewing exams that were conducted, 17 students cleared it in Masar and 15 students cleared it in Abhor.



Help extended

Mukul Madhav Foundation helped eight patients with Rs.14,05,000/- for cochlea implant surgeries and 120 patients with Rs 36,98,875/- as medical assistance. A total of Rs 2,05,992 was given to eight students as educational assistance.
