

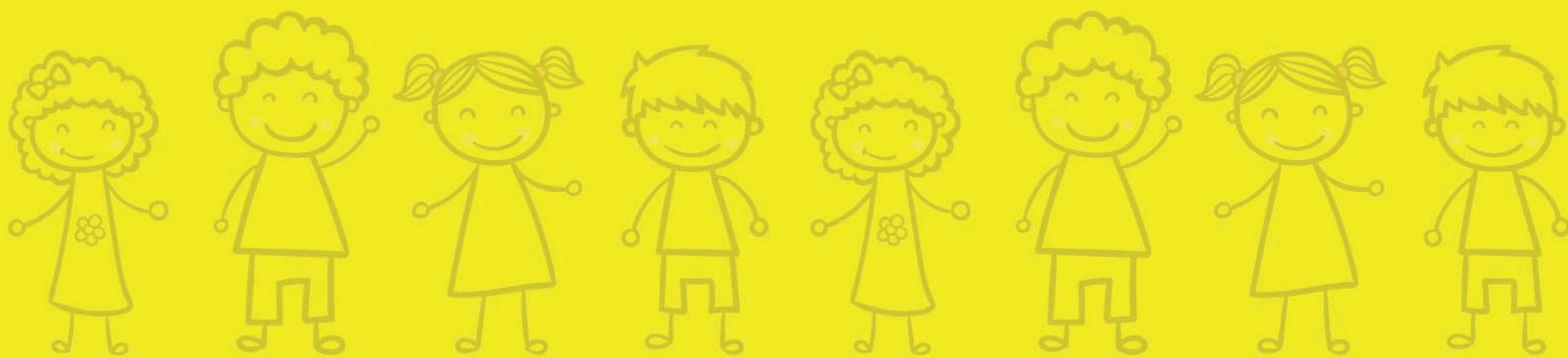

International Women's Day Celebrations

Dr. Bandorwala Leprosy hospital, Kondhwa has been operational for many years. This institution houses 180 inmates out of which 120 are women. Mukul Madhav Foundation has been helping this institution for over seven years with monthly groceries, construction of water tank, donation of 30 artificial limbs and 30 AFO walkers.



On International Women's day, March 8, 2017, MMF extended assistance to 16 women requiring prosthetic limbs.



A mammography camp was conducted from March 6th to March 11th at Ratnagiri as part of International Women's week celebrations. Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation along with Parkar Hospital offered subsidized rates for women screened with mammography and colposcopy. A total of 243 women benefitted from the camp.

A week-long camp is conducted biannually to target approximately 300 women each time. These check-ups will be followed up by Dr. Koppiker's visit on the 15th and 16th of April.

Health Camps and Follow Up

Spectacles were distributed to schools in Khedashi, Gavkhadi, Kotawade, Nevare and Dhamanase which were generously donated by H.V.Desai Hospital following the camp that took place in February. The parents of children who need to get 2D Echo done were counselled.



The monthly diabetic camp took place in KEM hospital on the 25th March 2017. A total of 23 patients attended the camp and 2 were given insulin vials. The next camp is scheduled on the 22nd of April 2017.

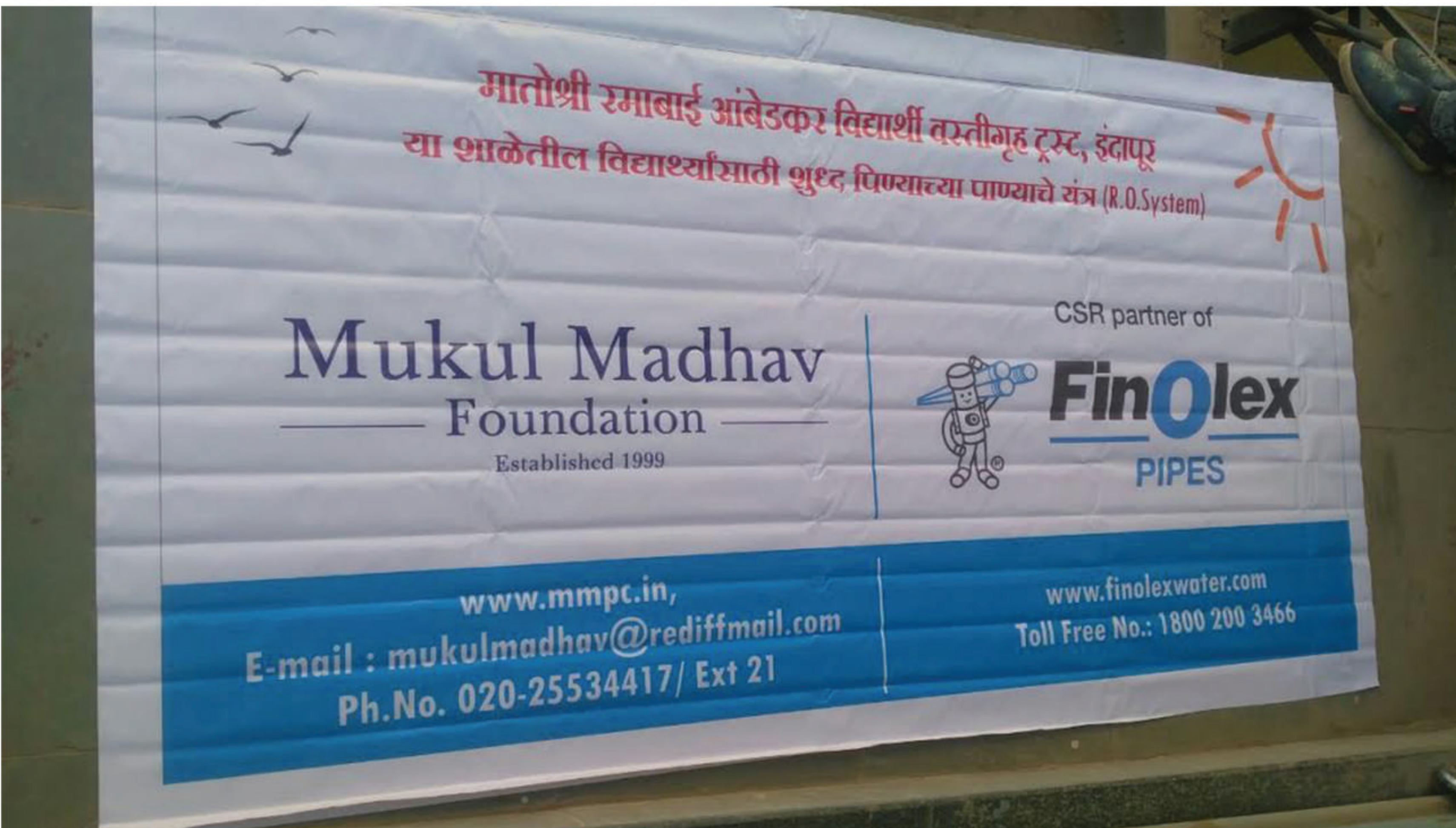




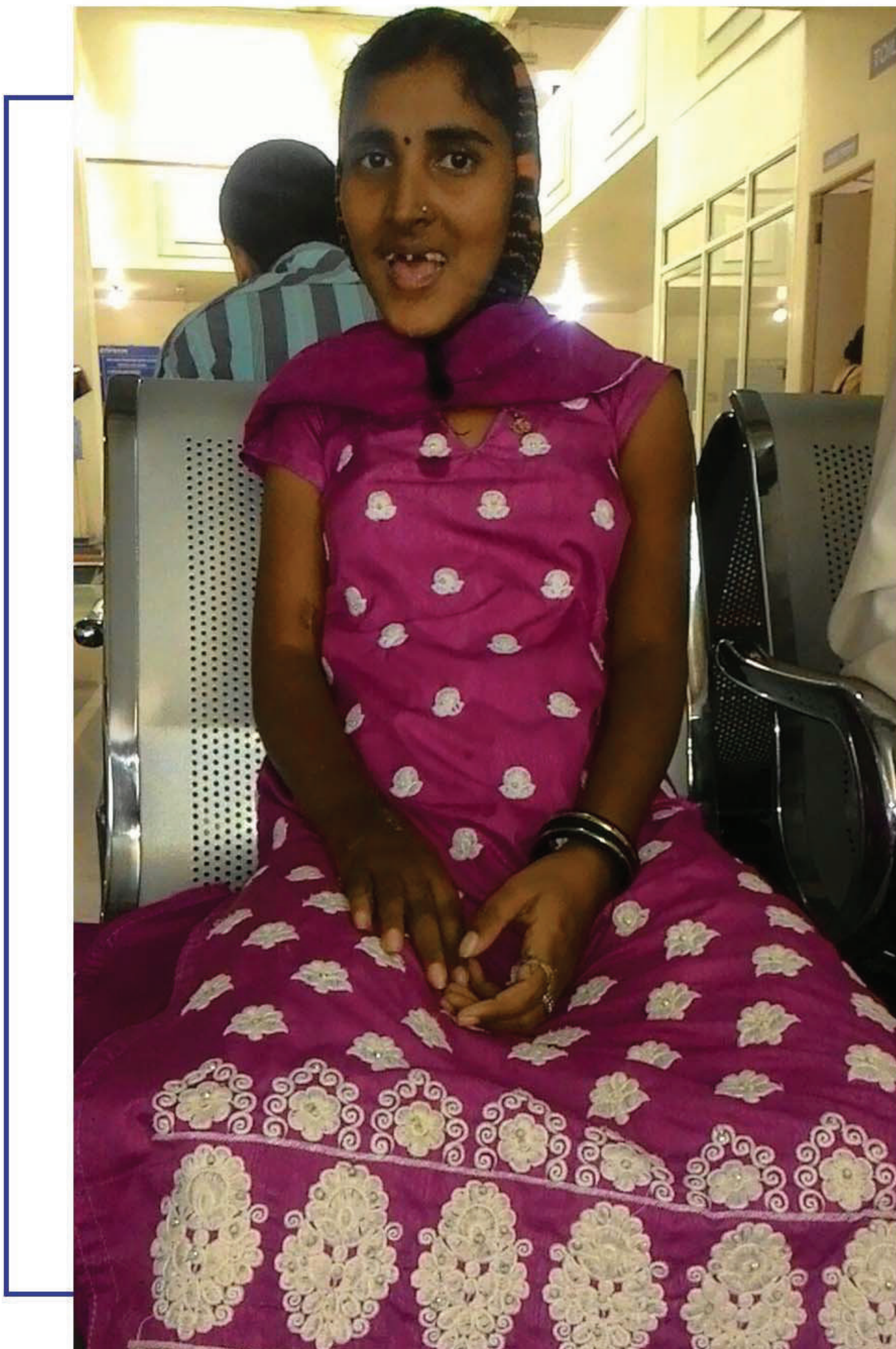
Gudi Padwa

On the auspicious occasion of Gudi Padwa, a pooja was held in Sassoon General Hospital ahead of the inauguration of the 59 bedded state-of-the-art Neonatal (NICU) at Sassoon General Hospital, ward no 20, 3rd floor. This initiative by Mukul Madhav Foundation and Finolex Industries Limited has been primarily supported by Shreemant Dagdusheth Halwai Ganpati Trust and Sassoon General Hospital.

Reverse Osmosis (RO) systems were installed at three schools - Mahatma Phule Vidyalaya, Bijwadi with 538 students, L.G.Bansude English Medium school with 412 students and Krantijyoti savitribai Phule Madhyamikashram shala with 450 students at Indapur.



Mukul Madhav Foundation took a major step to make children affected by Cerebral Palsy independent. Help was extended to two girls from Satara Taluka – Ms.Priyanka Indalkar (19) and Ms.Arпита Shevde (16).MMF donated a sewing machine to Ms.Arпита Shevde who will be helped by her mom. MMF helped Ms.Priyanka Indalkar establish a petty shop to sell stationery, cosmetics and snacks. Individual bank accounts have also been opened for them.



Tackling CP, the MMF way

Mukul Madhav Foundation and Finolex Industries Limited started the 4th Finolex Rehabilitation Centre in Panchgani Municipal school no.2 on March 4th. This centre will function every Saturday from 10.00 am to 1.00 pm. Children living in and around Panchgani and Mahabaleshwar can now benefit from this newly-inaugurated centre. In yet another initiative, MMF has started transport facility in Satara Taluka from 15th March. Children with Cerebral Palsy will be picked up and dropped from their homes to the Rehabilitation Centre for physiotherapy sessions which MMF has been conducting every Wednesday between 9.00 am and 6.00 pm in Satara Municipal School no.20. A second speech therapy centre was started in Satara on 29th March for the hearing disabled and CP children.

Mukul Madhav Foundation and Finolex Industries Ltd are happy to share the news of the completion of 3 successful years of the ambitious project of conducting quarterly pediatric cardiac camps along with Healing Little Hearts (HLH), a registered charity in the UK and Grant Medical Foundation's Ruby Hall Clinic, Pune.
