FIL & MMF associated with Niwant to sponsor a teacher to teach the visually impaired students at the institution for a monthly honorarirum of Rs. 15000/-. He visits the centre 6 days a week between 2:00 - 6:00pm to teach Legal language of drafting to law students, English & Grammar to 20 BA students and Grammar, Composition to 12th Std students.



Lift for Upliftment



An NGO run by the students of BJ Government College, Pune. It is the pioneer in free coaching for NEET (Medical Entrance Examination) for the underprivileged students. The programme consists of regular lecture series & weekly practice & is conducted at the Bal Vikas Sikshan Sanstha Prathamik Shaala, Pune.

On 14th July 2017, Finolex Pipes & Mukul Madhav Foundation donated school essentials, such as a box of A4 size paper, a green board, chalks, dusters & folders to the Lift for upliftment initiative.



SOS Children Villages of India

SOS is a home for disadvantaged children that helps them shape their futures & contributes to their development. To support this institution, FIL and CSR partner MMF came forward & adopted 25 children aged 10 – 16 years providing requisite educational facilities of Rs. 21,600/ for each child.

Free Medical Camp at Schools in Ratnagiri

For the past 9 years, Mukul Madhav Foundation has been conducting health camps bi-annually to ensure the well-being of school students in Ratnagiri. This year as part of the same initiative, alongside Finolex Industries Ltd., we organized our 19th free medical camp between 10th & 13th July.

Along with a team of doctors from Sassoon General Hospital, KEM Hospital, H.V. Desai Eye Hospital & Cochlea Pune & Parkar Hospital, Ratnagiri, we assessed over 2200 students from Swami Swaroopananda Vidya Mandir, Pawas, & various ZP schools such as Mervi, Golap no.1 & Maingedewadi & our very own school Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya. During this checkup, children with issues like tongue tie, tonsillitis, cardiac cases & cochlear implant were detected. MMF will assist their treatment to cure these ailments.







Additionally, small hygiene hampers comprising of soap, toothbrush &paste, snacks & glasses for students who are visually impaired was provided. Mukul Madhav Foundation continues to provide healthcare & financial assistance for the underprivileged to raise good & healthy children in our society!

Medical Camp of TFI & Akanksha schools

After the completion of the Ratnagiri health camp, Team MMF & teams from other Pune based hospital, started camps at TFI and Akanksha schools. It began on 25th July and completed on 29th July 2017 at Epiphany School, Savitribhai School, Jawahar School, NCA school in Pune. A total of 1713 children were screened. During this camp children were detected with dental problems & eye sight issues. They have been advised for further treatment & referred to the respective hospitals.





Cerebral Palsy Camp

A CP camp was organized on 15th & 16th July 2017 at Ratnagiri. We had with us Dr. Saloni Raje, a renowned physiotherapist, Dr. Sneha Choudhury, speech therapist & their teams for the camp. A total of 82 children were assessed during this camp. The local DHO (District Health Officer) helped us by providing transport facility to the patients form their villages to the Centre. We are looking forward to cover more such camps in the future.





Diabetic Camp



A diabetic camp was conducted at KEM hospital on 22nd July 2017. A total of 12 patients between 13 years to 30 years took the benefit of this camp out of which Insulin was distributed to 3 patients. The next camp is scheduled for 26th August 2017.

Surgery of Sahil Pardale

Master Sahil Pardale underwent crouch correction surgery on 22nd April 2017, however he developed infections in his leg while travelling & was required to be operated again. The second operation was successful & he will soon recover with physiotherapy. MMF & FIL contributed Rs. 65000 for the surgery.

Primary Healthcare








Launch of our New Website
