



Assessment camp at Wai

An assessment camp for children suffering from cerebral palsy was held on 6th May 2017, at the Finolex Rehabilitation Centre, Mirajkar Hospital, Wai. In this camp, a total of 28 children received occupational therapy, eye check-ups, orthopedic consultation & speech therapy. Out of the overall patient turnout, 5 of them were suggested orthopedic surgery, 8 needed occupational therapy & 5 required speech therapy respectively.

After conducting regular physiotherapy at the Finolex Rehabilitation Centre, we have found a positive change in children.

Surgery of CP child (Sahil Pardale) from Ratnagiri

Alongside Finolex Industries Ltd, we conducted an assessment camp for children with cerebral palsy in Ratnagiri.

During the 2nd assessment camp at Kamathe Primary Health Centre, we came across Sahil Pardale; a 12 year old CP patient from Rajpur, Ratnagiri who had come over to meet Dr.Patwardhan along with his mother for further treatment.

Dr.Patwardhan suggested him a "Crouched Correction Surgery", his mother understood the importance of the treatment & approached us.On 3rd May 2017 & subsequently on 10th May, Sahil Pardale was operated at Sancheti Hospital, Pune. For Sahil's operation we supported his surgery to the tune of Rs. 35,000/-

PHP visit at Satara in association with Symbiosis College of Nursing

On 17th May 2017, Mukul Madhav Foundation & Finolex Industries Ltd. in collaboration with Symbiosis College of Nursing, started a 5 month long training program for government health workers at a grass root level for the prevention of complications during pregnancy, labour & postnatal period at the primary health center.



The training program has been desgined in a way to continuously help them grow, a session will be held every week followed by an exam in the first month. There after regular sessions will be held every month followed by an exam after 3 months. After successful completion of the training program Finolex, Mukul Madhav Foundation & Symbiosis College of Nursing will provide a certificate to the trainees.

Initially this program will be running at the Nagthane Primary Health Centre, Satara & Bavdhan Primary Health Centre, Wai. As per PHC, we will be covering all ASHA workers, ANM, LHV & approximately 60 PHC staff.



Nutrition Kits for HIV affected mothers

Nutrition packets were given to ANC/PNC mothers for 10 & 5 months (pre & post – delivery). This program which started in September 2016 is now about to reach its completion.

HIV affected mothers were happy to receive these nutrition packets, as this helps them to increase their weight & immunity. All ladies delivered & the first HIV test report of 7 babies after 3 months is negative. The remaining infants are yet to reach 3 months to undergo an HIV test.

Financial Assistance provided for Cochlear implant

Financial assistance amounting to Rs.8,78,000 was provided to Atharva Ghatge, Shravani Morde, Shivaji Farande, Atharva Vairal, Paras Gaikwad, Bhagwant Giri & Sunil Kolekar for cochlear based medication. Additional funding of Rs.2,62,000 was provided to Indorwala Memorial Educational & Medical Institute Nasik for 5 Cochlear Implant surgeries. This was supported by Finolex Industries Ltd. & Hinduja Foundation.

Inauguration of water conservation project at Sordi Zilla Sangli & Rede Village, Solapur



Sordi Village:

We began the first leg of the water conservation at Sordi Village (Sangli District – Maharashtra) with the able support of Finolex Industries Ltd. & the Hinduja Foundation. After the completion of work the nearby villages, roughly 3000 families will get the benefit of this reservoir. The waste soil which was

The waste soil which was removed will be distributed for farming.

The two major advantages of this exercise:

- 1. Farmer lands will be more developed for agriculture, after the waste soil is spread on land
- 2. Water levels will increase

For the inauguration of the water reservoir Pranth Talishidar, Talati, PWD officer, Contractor, Sarpanch & Upsarpanch, & other villagers were present. The natives were elated with the work that was taken up by us.



Rede Village:

We have initiated a water conservation project at Rede village (Solapur District) after getting requisite government sanctions. The civil work for this project has commenced & we aim to complete the construction of this reservoir by the 1st week of June, 2017. The funds allocated for this activation is to the tune of Rs. 19.40 Lakhs.
