Shri Ramakrishna Ashram School in a remote area of Odisha, provides education to 330 girls from tribal areas of Odisha. 260 km away from the state capital Bhubaneswar, the students live in the on-campus hostel and learn up until the 10th grade. To respond to the growing need, Finolex and Mukul Madhav Foundation extended financial support to build a new hostel wing to offer additional space of one hall, 2 rooms and 45 bunk beds accommodating 90 students.
