TECH-TRAINING THAT WILL GIVE MUKUL MADHAV VIDYALAYA AN EDGE IN EDUCATION

The staff of Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya received IT training that **equipped the teachers to use technology efficiently while conducting online classes.**

The session was spearheaded by Mr Anil Shitap, EDP department, Finolex, Ratnagiri.

Teachers were **trained with a mix of blended learning audio-visual aids.**

This **IT training was aimed at reducing the digital divide** and catching the staff up-to-speed with the most useful Ed-tech tools like:

1. Easy navigation of Zoom and Google Meet and an introduction to the lesser known in-app applications to enhance the experience of online classrooms
2. Effective use of Google forms to conduct online tests and quizzes
3. An advanced use of Microsoft Word
4. Shortcuts and useful tactics to use Microsoft Excel effectively
5. Demo to a Math-App that will help gamify mathematical expressions during online classes

EDUCATIONAL SPONSORSHIP TO EMPOWER DREAMS

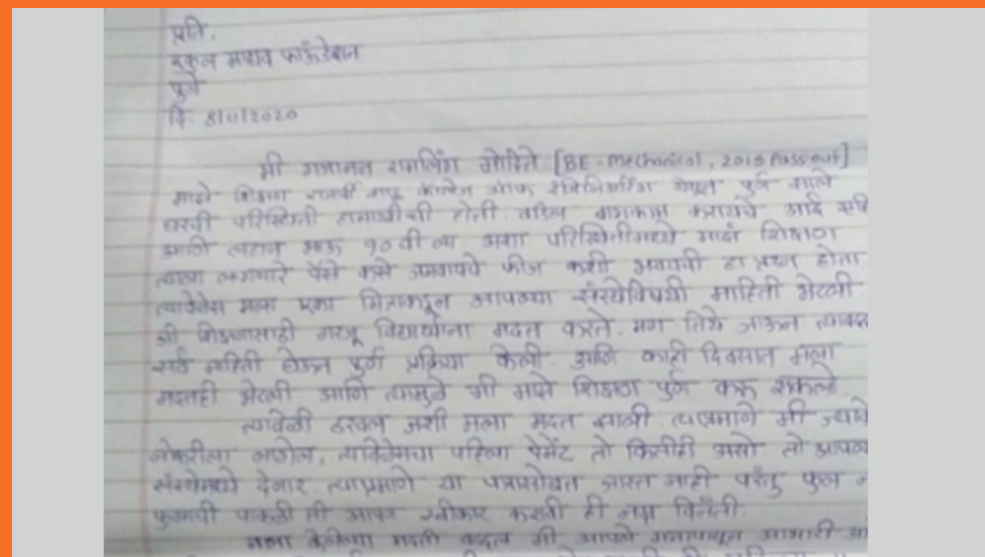
Mukul Madhav Foundation is **driven towards making educational dreams a reality for many!**

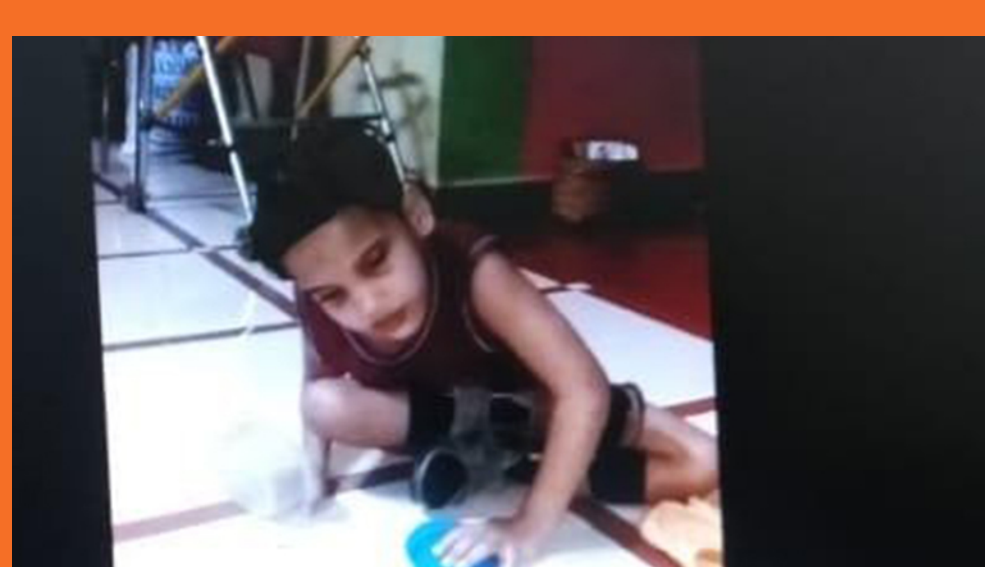
Gajanan not only graduated from JSPM's Rajarshi Shahu College of Engineering, Pune with flying colours but also gained employment thereafter.
