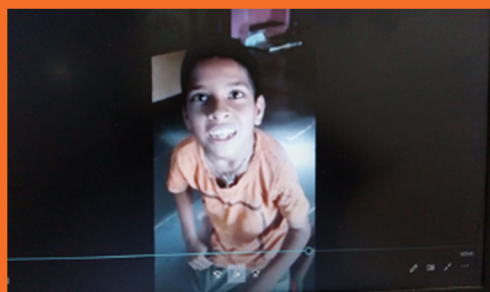


FEEDING THE FRONTLINE WORKERS
