FIRST BATCH OF WOMEN TO GRADUATE IN PLUMBING

We are always on a look out for ways to empower women. **Upskilling women through skill development courses and vocational training** is a powerful way of uplifting women.

Recently, 30 girls at ITI college finished two months training in Plumber course. 30 plumbers graduated on 26th November. **This initiative was launched by FICCI FLO Pune Chapter (2019-2020), chaired by Ritu Prakash Chhabria with support from Finolex Industries and Indian Plumbing Association.**

This has been the first ever plumbing trade course approved and introduced by Directorate of Vocational Education and Training to be incorporated in ITI Syllabus.



LOOKING AFTER SENIOR CITIZENS

We are always proactive when it comes to identifying needs and supporting different institutions, schools and organisations.

We work closely with several institutions, schools for the visually challenged, senior citizen homes, shelter for those living with leprosy and so on.

We understand that timely help with grocery essentials, physiotherapy equipment and toiletries can bring about a significant relief to the ones most distressed.

Aabhalmaya is an old-age home in Pune - it shelters 67 senior citizens and **we stepped up to provide some comfort in the form of 12 ceiling fans, 2 LED TVs and a consistent supply of monthly groceries and diapers for the last three years.**

We also helped renovate the premises of the house and Dr Aparna Deshmukh and their inmates were delighted to have us at their beck and call.



MONTHLY DIABETES CAMP: KEM HOSPITAL

Over the past 8 years, Mukul Madhav Foundation has been working closely with KEM Hospital, Pune to support diabetic patients with regular blood tests and insulin supply.
