Amrutkumbha' a water reservoir at Wadgaon Anand near Taluka Junnar District Pune, was inaugurated at the hands of Mrs. Ritu Chhabria, Managing Trustee of Mukul Madhav Foundation & Director Finolex Industries Limited and Mr. Sourabh Rao, District Collector of Pune on Sunday, 1st April 2018.

Earlier, the three villages of this area were dependent on the supply of water by tankers. Finolex Pipes identified the problem faced by the villagers and decided to help them by laying pipes across a distance of 2.5 km from the canal to fill the water reservoir 'Amrutkumbha'. Finolex Pipes feels honoured to have got an opportunity to contribute to the 'Jalyukta Shiwar' (water for each farm), which is one of the dream projects of Hon. Chief Minister of Maharashtra Devendraji Fadnavis.

This is not our first venture in the area of water. In the past we have completed many water projects too at Ratnagiri and other villages in Maharashtra. We have completed 4 water conservation projects at Rede, Kondhbavi and Kalamvadi in Solapur, Soradi in Sangli and 1 rain water harvesting set up at Punyadham Ashram, Pune.

# One Year Completion of Sassoon General Hospital's NICU

With the aim to provide quality healthcare facilities to the lesser privileged sections of the society, Mukul Madhav Foundation & Finolex Pipes inaugurated a 59 bedded state of the art NICU at Sassoon General Hospital, Pune alongside Dagdusheth Halwai Trust, which has now completed its 1st anniversary on 16th April 2018.

This unit extends affordable neonatal care facilities including Total Parental Nutrition (TIN), Human Milk Bank, ROP & OAE machines. This year, we supported around 5000 critically-ill infants, & improved the mortality rate. Looking at the support from the Hospital Dean, Dr. Ajay Chandanwale & the pediatric team, we have further donated life-saving equipment on this day. In addition, to this we have requested, Dr. Ajay to let us support the 10-bedded extension of the existing NICU.

## Continued Education Program for FIL Employees

For the personal development & professional growth of employees we at Finolex Industries Ltd, Ratnagiri are providing facilities to pursue higher education while working in the organization.
