13 more cochlear implants were supported this month to commemorate the International Day of Disabled Persons.

This support benefitted several people across Maharashtra from the following towns and villages

Impact: 286 implants since 2010.



Hot meals and grocery



Mukul Madhav Foundation firmly believes that no one should have to go to bed on an empty stomach.

We have been **feeding people with hot meals and catering to grocery requirements since February, 2020.**

Impact: 1.19 crore people.

Upskilling the Migrants



In collaboration with Yuva Parivartan, MMF has **supported 150 migrants to upskill and be equipped to earn a livelihood and sustain themselves better.**

Trained in System Rice Intensification (SRI), providing kitchen garden supplies (2 kgs), Paddy seeds, urea briquettes (18 kgs) and 40 saplings per household.

Impact:
Rs 23, 850 total harvest value per household.
150 migrants impacted.
