MMF/FIL introduced the 'Golden Hour training' to the 12 PHCs who have completed the mid-wifery training which began on 26th May 2018 in collaboration with Symbiosis College of Nursing, Pune.

We are proud to announce that we completed this training in 4 PHCs at Wai, Satara namely Bavdhan, Kavate, Maladpur, Bhuinj. A total of 161 ASHA & ANM were trained in this session. Main topics covered were First Aid Training for Road/Home Accidents, Suicide Prevention, Snake Bite, Fracture along with home remedies for treating fever, vomiting, body/back pain, tooth ache, burns etc.

The next session of Golden Hour Training with 182 ASHA and ANM has already started in Satara covering 4 PHCs on 11th July 2018. The purpose of organising this training session was to enable the teachers to identify symptoms of mental disorders among the students at an early age.



Free Medical Camps at Schools

For the past 10 years, MMF has been conducting health camps bi-annually to ensure the well-being of school students in Ratnagiri. This year as a part of the same initiative, we organized 20th Free Medical Camp from 16th to 20th July 2018 along with Mental Health Awareness Training to respective teachers.

Along with a team of doctors from Sassoon General Hospital, H V Desai Eye Hospital, Pune and Parkar Hospital, Ratnagiri, MMF assessed 2516 students from Swami Swaroopananda Vidya Mandir, Pawas and various ZP schools such as Mervi, Boke, Gopal No. 1, Kurtade, Mahatma Gandhi Shikshan Sanstha and our very own school Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya. During this camp, students were detected with issues like dental, eye sight, ENT, cardiac & thyroid. MMF will also assist them in treatment to cure these ailments.

Additionally, small hygiene hampers comprising of soap, toothbrush, paste, biscuits and juice were handed over to students.

MMF continues to provide healthcare and financial assistance for the underprivileged to raise good and healthy children in our society.

Neuro-Physiotherapy Camp

MMF/FIL conducted a 2 days neuro physiotherapy camp at our Rehab Centre in Ratnagiri. This is a specialized therapy being used to assess neurological development problems. This month, 52 patients affected with Cerebral Palsy (CP) were assessed and attended by the Dr. Saloni Raje, Physiotherapist. These camps are organized by MMF every month to treat the CP patients in Ratnagiri.



Medical Equipment donated to Parkar Hospital in Ratnagiri

As part of our continuous Healthcare programs under the CSR activities of MMF/FIL, Mammography Camps are being conducted in collaboration with Parkar Hospital in Ratnagiri at subsidised rates. Mammography machine was donated to Parkar hospital. In July 2018. We have also donated a Konica printer to facilitate the printing of CT Scan reports. The hospital management is happy to receive this donation for the upgradation of the hospital facilities.

Second Geriatric Camp at Kudal Primary Health Care

In continuation with the last months Geriatric Camp organized on 23rd June 2018, this month a follow up camp was conducted by MMF/FIL with the team of doctors from Sassoon General Hospital, H.V. Desai Hospital, Bharti Hospital and Sancheti Hospital, Pune.

A total of 248 senior citizens attended this camp and took its benefit. At the camp, among the 248 geriatrics who attended, 40 were identified for cataract surgery, 2 for Endoscopy, 5 for 2D Echo (Two-Dimensional Echocardiography), 2 went through medical check-ups for Gynaecological problems and 13 for hearing problems. Spectacles were distributed among 50. 11 senior citizens were also diagnosed with dental problems.

Blood tests were also carried out for 145 of them. In addition, consents for Cataract Surgery received from 15 patients out of 34 identified during the first month's camp. These patients will be picked up and dropped by H. V. Desai Hospital, Pune and surgeries will be funded by Finolex Industries Limited. The remaining 19 will be operated in the near future.
