Gavsad Skill Development Center, Masar, Gujarat

1st March 2019

Through Gavsad Skill Development center FIL-MMF trained 14 women with 3 months of sewing classes undertaken by Shree Charitable Trust. The First batch completed its training and were awarded certificates.

Through this training women will be able to earn and contribute to the livelihood of their households.



Women's well-being Camp, Walawalkar Hospital, Derwan

1st to 17th March 2019

556 women availed the benefits of the camp held between 1st and 17th March at Walawalkar Hospital, Derwan. The registration fees collected from these ladies are being utilized for Sainik Welfare and are being donated to their association.



Concern for Mental Health, UK, Mental Health Training, Pune

Event 5th to 7th March 2019

Mukul Madhav Foundation and Finolex Industries Limited organized a 3 day training in the arena of Mental Health with an aim to improve the dace of Mental Healthcare in India in collaboration with Concern for Mental Health Team, UK. The team comes to India on a yearly

basis. Training was provided to care givers, psychologist, teachers, Primary Health Care Physicians and other Mental Health Professionals in Pune. 115 attended this event. Dr. Mohan Agashe presided over the event as Guest of Honor and enlightened the audience with new ways in which therapy can be given to those suffering from Mental Illness / problems.



Water Conservation Project, Soradi in Sangli District

7th March 2019

MMF / FIL supported a water conservation project in Soradi in 2017 by desilting of lake and raising the level to collect more rain water. The villagers approached once again which we responded too. 300 farmers will be benefitted by this initiative.



National Safety Week, Gujarat

8th March 2019

To observe National Safety Week training on fire fighting was provided to 312 students and staff of Shree Sagar Vidyalaya by Mr. Tushar Joshi, Dy. Manger, EHS, FIL-Masar. Information on how to act in potential disaster situations like earthquakes or fire and use of fire extinguishers was explained.



Cerebral Palsy Assessment Camp, Patan in Satara

11th March 2019

81 patients were benefitted through this camp. 55 were CP and rest were differently abled. These patients were seen by Speech Therapists from Bharti Vidyapeeth, Physiotherapists from Krishna Hospital and our own Speech Therapist, Physiotherapist and Neurophysiotherapist from Ratnagiri.

An analysis and assessment shows many surgeries and support with prosthetics will be needed. RBSK provided their vehicles to transport patients from nearby villages with the support of CEO, DHO, CS and education department of Zilla Prishad(ZP), Satara.

Cervical Cancer Vaccination, Pune

14th March 2019

100 girls above the age of 15 at Venkateshwara School, Kadakwasala in Pune were administered with the Cervical Cancer immunization in collaboration with the Rotary Club, Pune Camp.

Vaccination of adolescent girls (15-25 years of age) against human papillomavirus (HPV) has been shown to be very efficacious in preventing the development of moderate or severe cervical precancerous lesions associated with HPV-16 or -18.

As the saying goes, Prevention is better than cure, let us stand together to save the girls in our society by taking this preventive measure.



Monthly Diabetic Camp at KEM Hospital, Pune

22 patients underwent routine blood sugar testing and 36 were provided insulin during the month.

to write one or two words. Looking at his progress the doctors suggested for botox injection and hamstring release. Post-surgery he will be able to walk after attending regular physiotherapy sessions.



Surgery performed on Mast. Vighnesh Mahesh Majalkar, Pune

Mast. Vighnesh Mahesh Majalkar, age 5yr with CP Spastic Quadriplegia, has been coming to our Rehabilitation center at Ratnagiri since May 2017. During his initial assessment he was unable to sit properly and also had poor trunk control. On providing him with regular physiotherapy he is now able to control his trunk and sit with support. Looking at his progress the doctors

suggested for botox injection. Post-surgery he will be able to stand after attending regular physiotherapy sessions.




Girl with Cerebral Palsy appeared for 10th Standard Exams without a writer

Panchgani for the past three years on a weekly basis for therapy due to which she has shown a considerable change in her motor skills and hand coordination. She is also able to push the wheelchair. Her father has assisted FIL and MMF to find out children with CP in that region.

This is indeed a motivation for the student and other children suffering with Cerebral Palsy.

Donation

Finolex Industries Limited (FIL) and Mukul Madhav Foundation (MMF) created the Endoscopy Unit at Sassoon General Hospital, Pune in March 2018 by equipping it with world class equipments. Over the period of one year this unit has catered to 2567 patients at affordable costs. Patients' inflow has increased significantly for endoscopic procedures and complex interventions. To perform these procedures need has been ascertained by the hospital to donate further equipments.

On the 1st Anniversary of the Endoscopy Unit – FIL and MMF donated Endoscopy Ultra Sound along with 5 Head Protection, Thyroid Shield, Lead Apron, protective Eye Wears for doctors and medical team and OGD SCOPE to upgrade the unit as currently the department has been borrowing this instrument from other hospitals. This will enable the doctors to perform POEM

procedure, (to cut the food pipe to remove Achalasia cardia disorder) at an affordable cost of Rs. 1100/- as compared to private hospitals where the cost is around Rs. 2 lakhs.


