Monthly Diabetic Camp, KEM Hospital , Pune

28th September 2019

12 patients underwent routine blood sugar testing and 7 were provided insulin.



Cataract Surgery, Jharkhand

29th September 2019

Free Geriatric Cataract operation was supported to 100 patients from Bihar & Jharkhand at LNJP Eye Hospital, Hazaribagh in Jharkhand. We have been assisting Nav Bharat Jagriti Kendra with Cataract operation since 2018. From then we have completed 300 geriatric cataract surgeries.



Toilets in Jaipur

30th September 2019

Kelakabass a village in Jaipur which has plumbers in every family. An appeal was received from Rajakiya Uccha Madhyamik Vidyalaya having total student strength of 500 students to provide sanitation facilities in school. One toilet block with 4 toilets & one water trough with 2 hand washing taps for girls and one toilet block with 6 toilets and one water trough 2 taps for boys has been provided.

This will ensure there is more attendance in school specially amongst the girl students.



Geriatric camp, Shirwal PHC, Satara

5th October 2019

127 Geriatric were screened as part of the camp. 89 people underwent blood testing, 72 for physiotherapy and orthopedic, 15 for psychiatry, 10 for dental, 12 with gynac problem and 3 patients were diagnosed cataract surgery

Since June 2018 till date we have screened more than 1500 geriatric patients.



Empowering 100 Women Farmers through BAIF (Bharat Agro Industries Foundation), Nashik

7th October 2019

Finolex Industries limited in collaboration with BAIF initiated a project to **EMPOWER 100 WOMEN FARMERS AS CHANGEMAKERS IN AGRICULTURE**

Project proposes to closely work with women farmers to develop their capacities on improved agriculture practices, introduction on farm mechanizations and facilitate peer learning with other farmers.

Demonstrate improved agricultural practices with other champion women farmers who will sensitize more than 500 women farmers on efficient farming practices.

The project will be implemented across six cluster each covering eight to ten villages in Sinnar block of Nasik within the duration of 12 months between October 2019 to September 2020.



Late Smt. Mohini Pralhad Chhabria Scholarship for Agriculture colleges of Mahatma Phule Krishi Vidyapeeth, Rahuri

9th October 2019

An MOU has been signed on 4th June 2019 in the presence of Mr. K P Viswanatha, Vice Chancellor, Phule Krishi Vidyapeeth, Ahmednagar, Mr. Rasal, Dean, Agriculture College, Pune, Dr. Pharande, Director of Instruction, Mahatma Phule Krishi Vidyapeeth, Rahuri, Mr. Devang Trivedi, Company Secretary, Finolex Industries Limited and Mrs. Ritu Prakash Chhabria, Managing Trustee, Mukul Madhav Foundation to provide scholarships and assistance to 36 undergraduates, 20 Post Graduates and 3 PhD students to the lower strata of the society at these universities.

65 students were interviewed for Bsc (Agri), Bsc (Hort.) which was conducted in Pune, Jalgoan, Kolhapur and Nadurbar Agriculture college. Dean of the respective colleges and students welfare officer, Representative of Mukul Madhav Foundation were present 16 students will be selected to receive the scholarship.



Reassessment Camp

A total of 122 Cerebral Palsy patients were screened by specialist doctors from Pune and have been referred for surgery, orthotics, optumologist, speech therapy, hearing aid and medicines. The camp was supported by Zilla Parishad authorities of Satara graced by the visit of the CEO Dr Bhagvat. RBSK team supported with transport facilities to bring patients to the venue.



Inauguration of B T Sahani School

19th October 2019

B T Sahani school was refurbished and renovated with new classrooms in the English section, computer lab, toilets for boys and girls and a multi purpose hall. This was inaugurated by Didi Krishna Kumari from Sadhu Waswani Mission and graced by Mr. Prakash Chhabria and Mrs. Ritu Prakash Chhabria along with other members from the Foundation and the school.



Skilling Initiative with Tata Strive

19th October 2019

Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation have been involved in skilling young people in the field of Plumbing, Radiology, Tailoring, Computers through various Skill Development Institutes.

Recently Finolex and Tata Strive which is the skill development initiative of Tata Community

Initiatives Trust entered into an MOU to train young girls in the field of GDA (General Duty Assistants).

An MOU was signed on 19th October at Finolex City Office by Mr. Devang Trivedi from Finolex Industries and Mr. Sudhakar Gudipati, from Tata Strive. To witness the ceremony we had members from both the organizations including Mrs. Ritu Prakash Chhabria , Managing Trustee, Mukul Madhav Foundation*.

From the funds that is being given to Tata Strive, 100 GDAs will be skilled over a period of 7 weeks classroom training plus 4 week of OJT (on job training). Post which Tata Strive hand hold them till they get a job with a minimum wage of 10k plus.



Celebrating Diwali with widowed farmers in Osmanabad

21st and 22nd September 2019

8th June 2019, 312 women farmers met Shri Chandrakant Dada Patil Minister of Agriculture, Maharashtra who congratulated these ladies and helped to handover 30 kg Soya and 15 kg Tur seeds to each, kindly donated by FIL/MMF with the support of MAHABIJ (Maharashtra State Seeds Corporation Ltd., popularly known by its brand name MAHABEEJ is one of the largest and leading State Seeds Corporation)

Good monsoon has helped the crops which will soon be harvested at which point KVK will once again help them and mentor them to package and sell these in Latur market.

While supporting Osmanabad with holistic approach FIL/MMF collaborate with Paani Foundation and supported one village for water conservation work and their community participation was very highly motivational.

To take this further we are now joining hands with government bodies to support and see how women can become entrepreneurs further with another project i.e establishing their own small scale business to develop this cluster in producing SOYA Milk with the collaboration of Science

and technology park Pune and Honey with the support of MSKV BK (Maharashtra State Khadi and Village Industries Board). To celebrate Diwali grocery and gifts were distributed to these women.

22nd October 2019

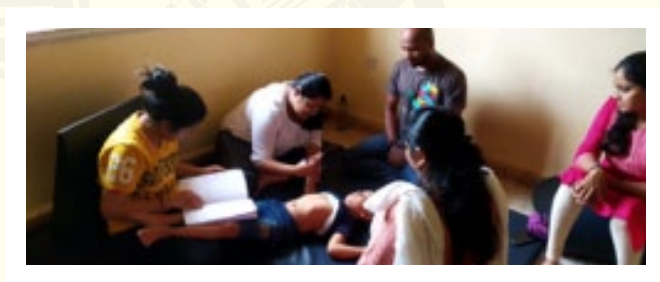
150 benches have been donated to students of Srimanta Vijay Singh Raje Patwardhan English school Kotawade.


