Empowering the future: Tribal Women.

On 1st Nov 2021 we announced the project Honey Bee for tribal women in Palghar district. This initiative will support them to become entrepreneurs in Palghar district through the cultivation of honey bees. There is an added advantage to this project beyond the important socio-economic dimension for these women, that it also helps in protecting honey bees, which are decreasing at an alarming rate, while they play a critical role in maintaining the local biodiversity.

Finolex Industries Limited, its CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation, Rotary SOBO Mumbai, FLO Mumbai Chapter and FLO Pune Chapter came together to support this initiative 46 women will be benefited through this initiative.

After two months Honey will be collected by MKGM at the rate of Rs. 250-Rs. 300 per kg at the village.



Saving Lives: Blood Donation Drive

FIL/MMF has been organizing blood donation camps since 2017 to support blood banks in Urse, Chinchwad in Pune Maharashtra and Masar in Gujarat.

In 2021 - 6 blood donation camps were organized

- April 2021: 3 camps in Urse, Chinchwad, Ratnagiri in Maharashtra. Total 101 units were collected
- October 2021: 3 camps in Urse, Chinchwad in Maharashtra and Masar, Gujarat total 157 units were collected.

These units were collected by Sassoon General Hospital in Pune and Dhvani Blood Bank Vadodara Gujarat.

On 9th November 2021, FIL/MMF organised the 7th blood donation, Ratnagiri. 112 Bags were collected in this drive.

Brightening Deepawali in Leh

On the Auspicious occasion of Diwali Festival, a delegation of Mahabodhi International Meditation Center, Ladakh, led by its Founder-President, Ven. Bhikkhu Sanghasena embarked on a 2 Day tour to Gya, Meru, Rong, Lato, Rumtse, Sasoma, Upshi, Kulum and Igoo villages for distribution of ration kits to nearly 800 families on the 4th and 5th of November. The program is sponsored by FIL/MMF Mukul Madhav Foundation for 2 consecutive years in partnership with Mahabodhi International Meditation Centre, Leh Ladakh. The inauguration of the program was done by Sh. Jamyang Tsering Namgyal, honorable Member of Parliament, Ladakh.



All the ration items have been procured from Jammu by the dealer but due to sudden snow on the Srinagar-Leh Highway, road was blocked for a few days but luckily just two days ahead of the Deepawali, the truck loaded with the ration items reached Mahabodhi on 2nd November. 3rd November, the members and staff of MIMC properly packed the ration items including the sticking of stickers.



Give with Dignity (GWD) Initiative

Give with Dignity™ a trademark event of Mukul Madhav Foundation in 2020 October during the festive season of Navratri, Dussehera, Diwali and beyond has been a ray of hope to those from the marginalized sections of our society.

The Foundation began by supporting 73000+ families with ration kits to suffice a family of 4 for about two weeks and impacted the lives of approximately 3 lac + individuals in 24 states of India. **Buy Local – Give local** – with this phrase the Foundation encouraged its representatives to identify and support small scale business and self help groups to have a revival for survival from this raging pandemic. 120 of them were identified pan India and supplies for ration kits were procured from them. To continue with Give with Dignity™ this time the Foundation initiated a small fundraiser and have pledged to support 10000 families across 14 states. The distribution began on 22nd October and will culminate closer to Diwali. Items for these ration kits have been procured from about 8 to 10 self help groups and others from local kirana (grocery) stores. The beneficiaries belong to various marginalized sections like visually impaired, differently abled, slum dwellers, daily wage workers who are still trying to seek a job, widows and women headed families and much more.



Spreading Smiles in Srinagar : October–November 2021

HELP Foundation is a community-based humanitarian organization established in 1997, primarily working with vulnerable women and children in Jammu & Kashmir. HELP Foundation has been conducting relief and rehabilitation activities for the most vulnerable and poor communities through its volunteers and staff, who are present within the communities and know the vulnerabilities at the grass root level.

Distribution Details

The food parcels were distributed among poor and needy families of Districts Budgam and Srinagar. The beneficiary families include women headed families, disabled, the elderly and migrant laborers. 200 food parcels were distributed in the Beerwah area of Budgam District, 200 in Downtown area of Srinagar and 100 in Tulsi Bagh area of Srinagar.

In Srinagar, 300 food parcels were distributed among 50 slum dwellers, 60 non-Muslim families, 157 local beneficiaries and 33 migrant labourers. In Budgam, 200 food parcels were distributed among 60 local beneficiaries and 140 migrant laborers, working mostly in brick kilns.



Helping Healthcare Centres

BAPS SwamiNarayan Institute which runs a multi-specialty hospital in Vaodara. Have 50 bedded COVID ward, ICU, NICU and Operation Theatres. This hospital has also been empanelled as an emergency hospital for Finolex Industries Limited – Masar employees. BAPS hospital had put in a request for ECG machines and today on 2nd Nov. 2021 the inauguration of the same took place.

For this inauguration Swami ji from Swaminarayan Sanstha did the Pooja of the Machines, Dr. Samir Brahmmbhatt – CEO of BAPS Hospital and FIL-MMF team were present for the same.



Healing through Health Care

Monthly Diabetic Camp at KEM Hospital, Pune:

Over the past 7 years, Mukul Madhav Foundation has been working closely with KEM Hospital, Pune to support diabetic patients with regular blood tests and insulin supply. This month, 14 patients were gifted with some relief and support.

Monthly Diabetic Camp at Vadodara, Gujarat

Dr. Sunil Shah, Mr. Bharat Mehta and Dr. P K Gumastha, Trustees of the Diabetes Association of Baroda presented for today's session.



Sankalp 2021: Mammography Camp

FIL/MMF in association with BKL Walawalkar Hospital, Dervan organized a Mammography Camp – Sankalp 2021 from 09th to 13th November, 2021. Inauguration ceremony of the camp held on 19th October 2021 in the hands of Dr Chitoy Maitra, ex. Dean Rajiv Gandhi Hospital Kalawa, HOD Physiology Dept. and Dr Suvarna Patil, Medical Director Walawalkar Hospital Sawarde.



FIL/MMF conducted a successfully camp from 19th Oct to 13th Nov 2021, total of 259 women were screened. In this camp following tests and consultations were provided at subsidized rate by FIL/MMF -

Sustainable Sanitation Support

Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation since June 2017 have been working closely in Palghar to create individual toilets for tribal villages in collaboration with Kherwadi Social Welfare Association's (KSWA) Yuva Parivartan.

On 24th November 2021 Finolex Industries Limited and CSR Partner Mukul Madhav Foundation with the collaboration of Kherwadi Social Welfare Association's (KSWA) Yuva Parivartan inaugurated 27 Individual toilets in Khidsa village in Palghar in the presence Mr. Sudhakar Tumbada (Gramsevak), Mr. Madhukar Golawad (Sarpanch), Mr. Ganpat Laxman Gholwad (Police Patil), Mrs. Guni Tukaram Bhusara (Anganwadi Sevika) of Khidsa village, Mr Pawan Chandrate Finolex Representative and Yuva Parivartan team.



These toilets are designed in an eco-friendly manner comprising of a squatting pan, A sub-structure (pit) containing, decomposing and disposing excreta (which over the period of 10 years will be evolved to manure that is required for farming) and a super structure (body) (2*3 ft) tiled for privacy and protection from weather factors. Each individual toilet is provided with solar light. The toilets have name boards in the name of the lady of the household.

Total 778 individual toilets were built by FIL/MMF in Palghar district and 13 villages became Open Defecation Free.

Mission Cerebral Palsy Assessment Camp

Finolex Industries and its CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation started Mission Cerebral Palsy on 15th November 2015 and established six rehabilitation centers in the districts of Satara and Ratnagiri and after the pandemic to resume all the centers and we have successfully completed another assessment camp at Satara, Patan and Wai in Maharashtra . 371 children affected by Cerebral Palsy received consultation and care by Orthopedic surgeon, Neurologist, Neuro-physiotherapist , occupational therapist, Speech Therapist, Physiotherapist, Ophthalmologist , Orthotic and Prosthetic Doctors.

CEO ZP Satara visited the camp along with CS, DHO and EO Dr Patwardhan interacted with them and explain our Mission Cerebral Palsy program CEO suggested to make plan submit to ZP and he will provide necessary requirements CS is ready to provide support for early intervention in civil hospital and at PHC level.

Day 01 Satara.

Camp total count 171, Orthopedic consultation 156, Speech assessment 160 , Occupational therapy 80, Surgeries needed 42, Orthotic device 52 Neuro referral and consultation needed 16.

Day 02 Patan.

Camp total count 93, Orthopedics consultation 93, Speech assessment 54, Surgeries needed 13, Orthotic device 15, Speech therapy required 40, Hearing aid required 08. Got good response in Patan . Krishan Hospital Team also supported well with their team of Physiotherapists.

Day 03 Wai

Camp total count 107, orthopedics consultation 96, Speech assessment 87.



Blood Donation Camp and Eye Check-up Camp




Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya celebrates 'Children's Day'
