Supporting ITI Ratnagiri with Water Pipeline network scheme.

An appeal was received from ITI Ratnagiri to donate plumbing material for the water pipeline network for boy's hostel and tree plantation project in ITI Ratnagiri campus which was responded and sanctioned. It will benefit continuous water supply to boy's hostel building accommodating **100 students**, watering needs for **150 mango saplings and garden**. This project involved shramadaan (self-work) by the students of the ITI Ratnagiri, under the able guidance of their teachers.

This was inaugurated on 1st January 2022, at the hands of District Vocational Education and Training Officer (DVEO) Mr. Kotawadekar and ITI principal Mr. Shetye. Project coordinator Mr. Madre, Mr. Pawar, Fitter Instructor, other ITI staff, students and FIL/ MMF team were present for the inauguration ceremony. ITI Ratnagiri expressed their gratitude towards this support.



FIL/MMF provided January month groceries to Gram Swaraj Uttar Buniyadi Hostel (Nr. FIL Masar, Gujarat)

This hostel provides food, shelter and education free of cost to underprivileged boys from 8th to 10th standard. Gram Swaraj Trust relies on donation, from which they support the school and hostel, they had requested FIL/MMF to provide monthly grocery support for the hostilities, which FIL/MMF started support from September, 2021 and continues every month. Through this initiative 11 children will be provided breakfast, lunch and dinner which would help in their growth and development.

Healthcare

Finolex Industries and its CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation support children with Cerebral Palsy at Snehalaya.

FIL/MMF associated with Snehalaya institute in July 2021, an NGO working in Pune for Children (65 children) with Cerebral Palsy and are supporting them with various therapies. FIL/MMF began supporting Snehalaya institute with assessment camp with the support to Sancheti Hospital and Bharti Hospital for orthopedic and speech assessment. During the camp 12 children were suggested for Orthotic devices. Alongside remuneration is being supported for 3 teachers at this institute since October 2021. From November we started weekly speech therapy sessions twice a week on Wednesday and Friday for 15 children's, FIL/MMF are supporting the 9 children with orthotics device and measurement of the clothes has been taken for their new outfits.



A special update on Sassoon General Hospital and KEM Hospital

In an attempt to modernize and improve the quality of medical treatment provided to children, MMF set up a Neo-Natal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) in the year 2000 and a Neo-Natal Ward in the year 2001 at KEM hospital as its first project in Healthcare. There after many projects and initiatives have been done. Another breakthrough is when MMF created the NICU at Sassoon General Hospital. Thereafter others departments have been upgraded and a continuous follow up and reporting is done on a monthly basis.

- NICU Sassoon hospital - **172 patients**
- Retinopathy of prematurity (ROP) is an eye disorder caused by abnormal blood vessel growth in the light sensitive part of the eyes (retina) of premature infants - **Total screening 75**
- Otoacoustic Emissions (OAE) screening can help to detect sensor neural hearing loss occurring in the cochlea. It can also call attention to hearing disorders affecting the pathway to the inner ear - **523 patients**
- Endoscopy surgery - **313 patients** • Dental Surgery - **11 patients**
- Hemophilia Screening - **5 patients**
- Sonali ward (NICU) KEM Hospital - **3 patients**
- Nano duct it measures cerebral pressures in extremely difficult neurological emergencies - **2 patients**

Finolex Industries and its CSR Partner Mukul Madhav Foundation Supported Sassoon Hospital with a laptop at NICU.

An ROP machine (a device used to test babies for blindness) was donated to Sassoon General Hospital in 2017. Babies needed to be shifted from the NICU for this diagnosis. MMF bridged the gap by providing a Laptop on 3rd January 2022 in order to ensure that the laptop is connected to the ROP machine within the NICU. Alongside this Sassoon has mandated this procedure for all the babies that are being discharged from the hospital.

MMF and FIL continues to support and upgrade facilities at Sassoon as it is catering to the masses in Pune and around its periphery.



GWD Is Still Going On

State transport workers in Maharashtra are on strike since last 2 months.

FIL & MMF distributed dry ration kits to these families at Parner & Shrigonda depot in the district of Ahmednagar. 100 kits were distributed in each depot in presence of our representative Mr. Dada Gadakh & a friend of MMF Mr. Raj Deshmukh.

MMF Support to Senior Citizen Homes.

MMF has been supporting senior citizens by providing them with diapers, monthly grocery, health camps in Satara rural region and more recently during the pandemic supported them with transportation and refreshments to avail their vaccinations. Various outreach programs like tree plantation and extracurricular activities have been conducted to keep them energetic, enthusiastic and encouraged. **Recently we conducted a magic show and a musical evening at Abhalmaya, Niwara, shantiben and Sankalp old age home and catering services to a total of 185 senior citizens.**

He translated the Marathi book Dnyaneshwari, which was written by Saint Dnyaneshwar. The language used in this book was very difficult to understand for common people. So, he translated this book into simple Marathi language as Abhang Dnyaneshwari. He also translated Changdev Padashti and Amrutanubhav into Marathi. He translated Bhagavad Gita into Marathi as Bhavartha Gita. He took Samadhi on August 15, 1974.

A big beautiful temple is now built on his Samadhi. Thousands of devotees visit this temple every year and take blessings from Shri Swami Swarupanand.
