1. Chess introduced as a part of an extra-curricular activity:

This academic year, Chess was introduced for students of 3rd to 8th std. A renowned local Chess Expert Mr. Vivek Sohani has been roped in to teach Chess at MMV. Once our students get proficient in Chess they will be taking part in various local, district and state level competitions and make a mark for themselves.

2. Sanskrit Introduced For 1st to 3rd std students:

In order to have the younger generation know their roots, Sanskrit as traditional language was introduced this year for students from 1st to 3rd std. Our In-house qualified teacher, Mr. Kiran Joshi is mentoring and teaching students in Sanskrit.

3. MMV students appear for German FIT one exams:

German Fit in Deutsch 1 exam is conducted by Max Muller Bhawan for children between 10 and 16 years of age. It certifies that candidates have acquired very basic language skills and corresponds to the first level (A1) on the six-level scale of competence laid down in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). 22 Students from 7th to 9th std appeared for German FIT one exams conducted by Max Muller Bhawan, Pune in which 3 students scored above 60%, 9 students scored above 70% while 10 students above 80%.

4. MMV appreciated by Mrs. Vaishali Dabake, Max Muller Bhawan for having students qualify for JUKU German Scholarships:

Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya, as claimed by Mrs. Vaishali Dabke, Project Manager from Max Muller Bhawan, is the only school in Ratnagiri to teach German to its students. 1 student out of 5 students who appeared for JUKU Scholarship interview, Ms. Aishwarya Kelkar (Age 14 yrs, 9th std) has successfully cleared the interview and will be going to Germany through Max Muller Bhawan for 15 days scholarship course in Germany. The other 4 students Master Sairaj Dange, Miss Darshana Dange, Miss Simrah Nakhwa and Miss Purva Salvi will be attending 3 day German Youth Camp at Cochin through Max Muller Bhawan.

5. Refund of 15% school fees:

A notification was issued by Education Department in COVID times that 15% school fees of students to be waived off. However, by the time the notification was issued, some parents had paid the school fees in full. The School Management will be adjusting 15% school fees by giving a rebate on the fees for next academic year of 2023-24, there by refunding the fees taken in COVID times.

8.Success of year after COVID 19 pandemic:

a)Discovery in Physical school post pandemic and timely remedial steps taken:

When students started coming to school physically and gave their physical exams it was noticed that their performance was not up-to the mark as compared to online exams, which clearly indicated that they have been cheating in exams.

The weak students were identified and one to one counselling sessions were conducted by teachers to understand the exact cause of low performance in exams and these students were given special attention at school and college. Further to help students of 10th and 12th std a special Helpline was set up where students can come online, connect with their respective subject teachers and get their queries solved. This Helpline was available for students when they left school/college for final exam preparations at home.

b) Interaction with parents:

Management and teachers conducted numerous meetings with parents to sensitize parents on their responsibility and required involvement in closely monitoring their wards while at home.

c) Fee recovery:

The COVID situation adversely affected the fees payment by parents for their wards. A close follow up was done by Administration department and teachers which boosted the fee recovery up to certain extent. With a series of close follow ups by our teachers and admin department with parents, the fees were recovered.

The needy and deserving students who were unable to pay their fees were supported by Mukul Madhav Foundation by identifying a sponsors for supporting their fees.

d) Scenario of Teachers during COVID 19 pandemic:

There was a situation where in many teachers were infected with COVID and had to be at home. This situation was overcome by having our other teachers and external teachers shadowing the teachers ensuring that the students' do not lose on their syllabus.

A special mention to be made here is that none of the teachers were made redundant and it was ensured that all teachers continue with their jobs and support students in imparting education during critical times.
