A **Parents Teachers Association meeting** was held with **parent representatives from Classes 1 to 12** to discuss students' academic progress, behaviour, and overall development.

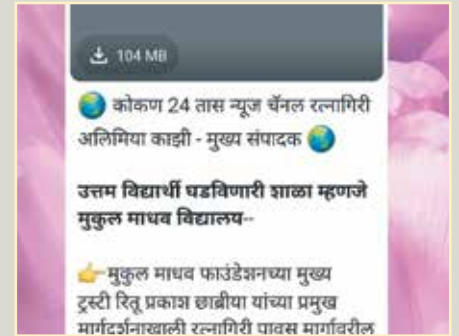
