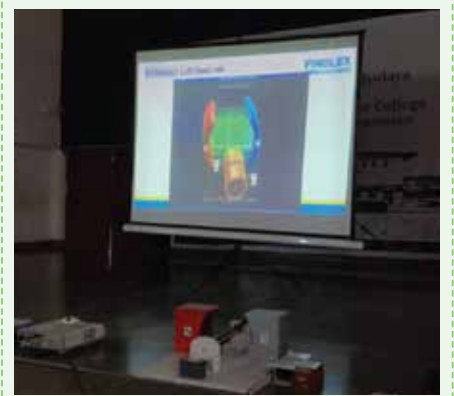
Students from Grades 5 to 12 participated in engaging sessions that included:

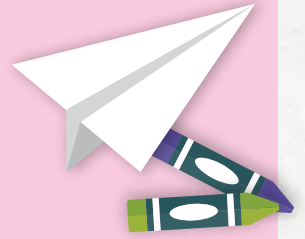

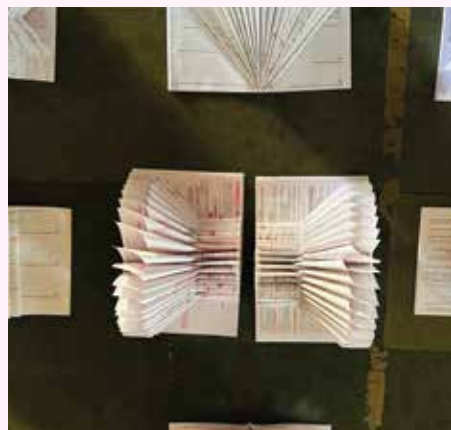
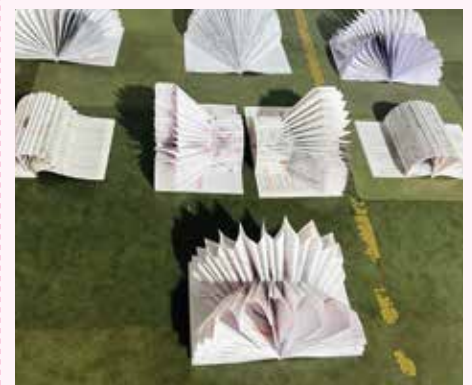

Empowering Education: FIL-MMF & Udayan Trust Join Hands to Support Children from Leprosy-Affected Families

Mukul Madhav Foundation Partners with Udayan Trust to Support Education of Children from Leprosy-Affected Families. Udayan Trust, in collaboration with Mukul Madhav Foundation and its CSR partner Finolex Industries Limited, has undertaken an initiative to support the education of children from leprosy-affected families in Kolkata, West Bengal.

Today, an official agreement was signed between FIL-MMF and Udayan Trust to support 12 children, covering their school fees, transportation, clothing, medical expenses, and nutritious food ensuring holistic care for their educational journey.

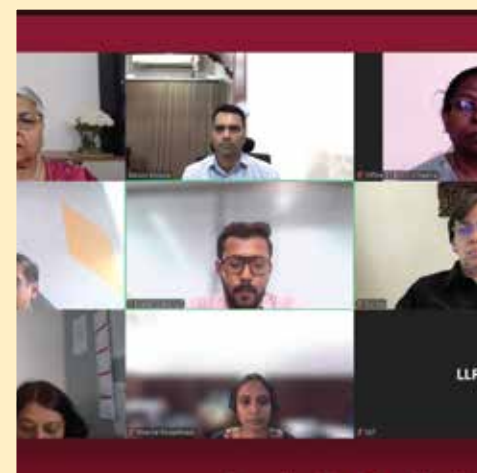
