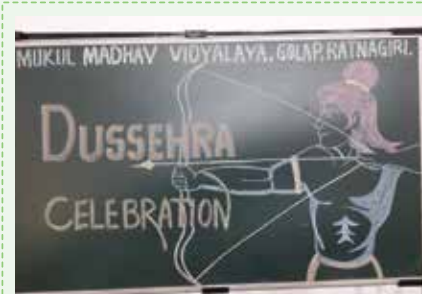
Vibrant Navratri and Dussehra Celebrations – 1st October

Academic Enrichment & Holistic Development



Academic Activity – Right Brain Activity for KG Section – 9th October
