



In the month of January, Mukul Madhav Foundation & Finolex Pipes came together to make a difference by upgrading various facilities at Shree Sagar Vidyalaya, in the following ways.

 On 4th January, we donated sports equipment such as cricket bats, carom board, board games and many other equipment for the students.



 Additionally, MMF also donated 6 electric fans & 1 electric bell for the school's 6 newly constructed classrooms.



• On the auspicious day of Uttrayan, 18 new six-seater benches were donated for the students of standard 11th & 12th.

### Uttrayan Kite Festival in Schools

Mukul Madhav Foundation & Finolex Pipes celebrated Uttrayan, the festival representing the onset of Spring with joy & liveliness. We distributed kites & organized a kite flying festival for the students of Masar Primary School, Abhor Primary School, MMP Samplaywala High School, Shree Sagar Vidyalaya & Chitral Primary School.

# Benches for Abhor Primary School

63 benches (30 - 3 seater benches & 33 - 2 seater benches) were donated to the students from standard 1st to 7th of the Abhor Primary School.





### Toilet Blocks for Masar Anganwadi

Donated one toilet block each to Masar Anganwadi Number 3 & 4 which was inaugurated on 26th January 2018.



## Water Project at Phansop & Purnagad Kharviwada

MMF & FIL donated 3 water storage tanks of 10,000 liters capacity to Phansop Muslim Mohalla & 2 tanks of 5000 liters to Purnagad Kharviwada. These water storage facilities would help in storing clean & hygienic water to cater to the needs of 2500 & 800 people respectively.

### RO Water Filters Donated to Zila Parishad Schools

On 26th January, we inaugurated RO Filters that were donated to two Zila Parishad Schools in Sagobawadi & Kurnewadi, Baramati District.



Educational assistance amounting to Rs.75,000/-was provided to 2 needy students.

Rs.10,000/- has been contributed to Sweta Association, Pune for the mini-marathon (Run to Vitiligo).

A donation of Rs.5,00,000/- has been given to Pune Music Society towards the restoration of pianos.



### Toilet Construction at Sonale, Palghar district

On January 8 2018, Mukul Madhav Foundation & Finolex Pipes with the support of Kherwadi Social Welfare Association, inaugurated 50 toilets & funded 50 beneficiaries with Solar lights at Sonale Village. The inauguration took place in the presence of dignitaries from Zila Parishad, Palghar, Grampanchayat, Sarpanch, FIL / MMF team of dignitaries, members from KSWA, local villagers and like-minded people.

We have collected Rs. 2000/- per household for the toilets and Rs.50/- per house for the lights from the families in Sonale, which will be donated to the Sainik board for the upliftment of widows and families of the martyrs of Indian Armed Forces.

With the goal of improving health & sanitary facilities in rural areas of India, MMF & FIL have contributed over 10 lakhs towards this initiative & we will be constructing 73 more toilets, installing solar lights & organizing health camps in the upcoming phases of this project.







### Neuro-Physiotherapy Assessment & Orthotic Camp

On 20th & 21st January we organized a Neuro-Physiotherapy Assessment & Therapy Camp with Dr. Saloni Raje & an Orthotic Camp lead by Mr. Sushant, benefitting a total of 61 patients.





#### Mental Assessment Camp

A Mental Health Assessment Camp was conducted on 29th January at Satara, where a total of 142 children were assessed for learning disabilities by faculty from Sasson General Hospital who worked hand-in-hand with the medical team from Civil Hospital, Satara. Further guidance will be provided to them for treatment and correction.





#### Spectacles for Students at Health Camp

MMF distributed spectacles to 66 students at Pali school, Khedsi school, Newre school & Kothawade school who were diagnosed with eye defects during the health camp.

#### Diabetic Camp at KEM hospital

A regular Diabetic Camp was held at KEM Hospital benefitting 12 patients & a total of 14 patients were also provided with Insulin.

Financial assistance of Rs.9,94,000/- was provided to Manali Toppe, Vaishanvi Tambe, Rugved Nanekar, Sanskriti Gore towards cochlear implant.

Financial assistance of Rs.12,44,000/- was provided to 84 needy patients.



#### **Buddy Day**

On 8th January, 2018, the Buddy Day was organized for the students of KG and Sr. KG classes to bring a buddy along with their parent to visit and experience a day in the school. The students were very happy as their buddies visited the school. The parents appreciated the idea of being invited to the school informally.

It was a proud moment for the students of Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya, when Miss Behere Chinmayi Ketan, from Class I, received the first prize in the "Rangbahar State level colouring and handwriting competition". Additionally, there are 12 students who received the "Special Art Merit" and 9 students who received consolation prizes in this prestigious event.

The work of our students was highly appreciated by Kala Vikas Sanstha and the school is once again bestowed with the "Golden school award", fourth time in a row. Heartiest congratulations to the Arts teacher, Mr. Rushikesh Shelar and The Principal, Ms. Moonika Ratanparaj for this remarkable feat who have both been awarded the "Kalabhushan award" for their splendid efforts. The School management also congratulated and conveyed their best wishes to the students and staff members.
