FIL/MMF started the Gavasad Skill Center in November-2018 and till date 80 plus women from 6 batches have successfully been able to complete the tailoring training and gained a livelihood from it. Presently, the 7th batch of the Gavasad Skill Center has started.

*On the day of their convocation their family members were also invited so that these women are encouraged and motivated. In addition to this their photographs, receiving certificates were framed and distributed on 2nd April 2022.

On March 30, 2022: With the aim of making rural farmers self-reliant through betel nut cultivation, a one-day beneficiary selection and awareness workshop has been organized at Devipur ADC Village, South Tripura by the Gandhian Youth Organization of Tripura Yuva Vikash Kendra with the help of Finolex Industry Limited CSR Partner Mukul Madhav Foundation, Pune. In today's program, **28 youth and women farmers of the village** have participated. All the beneficiaries have been informed in detail about this project by the organizers and the ideas have been exchanged among themselves. 

Finolex Industries and its CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundations' initiative of sanitation began in November 2016. This journey began in Palghar and has now completed the construction of **778 individual, solar illuminated toilets with soak pits**. In total 13 villages in this district is now Open Defecation Free.

21 Tribal villages in Maharashtra declared Open Defecation Free (ODF)

13 in Palghar and 8 in Gadchiroli

In continuation this initiative moved on to Gadchiroli, Nagpur. Here a total of **8 tribal villages** have been declared Open Defecation Free with a total of 260 individual, solar illuminated toilets with soak pits.

Late Smt. Mohini Pralhad Chhabria Scholarship for Agriculture colleges of Mahatma Phule Krishi Vidyapeeth Rahuri

Finolex Industries and its CSR Partner Mukul Madhav Foundation started intervention in the spectrum of Water conservation from 2014 and completed 23 projects in the districts of Solapur, Sangli, Pune, Satara, Ratnagiri and Osmanabad in Maharashtra and it has benefited more than 3 lakh people in farming sector.

While supporting farmer with water and environment Finolex and Mukul Madhav Foundation has also initiated a program to support students from agricultural sector and MOU has been signed on 4th June 2019 to provide scholarships and assistance to 36 undergraduates, 20 Post Graduates students to the lower strata of the society at these universities.

In 2021-2022 FIL/MMF increased 2 BSc students in each college. On 22nd March 2022 third year scholarship is handed over to all 10 colleges of Agriculture.

Total **76 agriculture** students now benefiting through this initiative.

This will enable students to be motivated and educated with the required expertise in the field of agriculture. Finolex Industries and Mukul Madhav Foundation continue to Spread Hope and Happiness in the lives of students.



FIL/MMF Supported to school going children with school fees

On 31st March 2022 Mukul Madhav Foundation and Yoshika Engineering pvt. Ltd. supported **40 students** from 5th STD to 12th STD of Vidya Mahamandal's Laxman Rao Apte School, Pune for their school fees. Students are from low income families and their parents are daily wages worker, Auto rickshaw driver, Maid and vegetable seller.

All these students are scoring very well in their academics this support will help these students to continue their education. In Jan 2021 MMF Supported **59 students** for the school fees.

Laxman Rao Apte School is a very reputed and aided school, catering to children from surrounding slum and low income group children to have good education in their school. School has retained excellence in academics over the years.

On 31st March 2022 Mukul Madhav Foundation and Yoshika Engineering pvt. Ltd. supported **73 students** from primary section of Nutan Marathi Vidyalay for their school fees. Nutan Marathi Vidyalaya is one of the oldest schools in Pune, Maharashtra, India. The school was founded by the Shikshan Prasarak Mandali, an educational charity on 1 January 1883.

Students are from low income families and their parents are daily wages worker, Auto rickshaw driver, Maid and vegetable seller. This support will help these students to continue their education.



Healthcare

Finolex Industries and its CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation support children with Cerebral Palsy at Snehalaya.

FIL/MMF associated with Snehalaya institute in July 2021, an NGO working in Pune for Children (65 children) with Cerebral Palsy and are supporting them with various therapies. FIL/MMF began supporting Snehalaya institute with assessment camp with the support to Sancheti Hospital and Bharti Hospital for orthopedic and speech assessment. During the camp **12 children** were suggested for Orthotic devices.

Alongside remuneration is being supported for 3 teachers at this institute since October 2021. From November we started weekly speech therapy sessions twice a week on Wednesday and Friday for 20 children's, FIL/MMF are supporting the 12 children with orthotics device and clothes has been given to them for their new outfits.



A special update on Sassoon General Hospital and KEM Hospital

In an attempt to modernize and improve the quality of medical treatment provided to children, MMF set up a Neo-Natal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) in the year 2000 and a Neo-Natal Ward in the year 2001 at KEM hospital as its first project in Healthcare.

There after many projects and initiatives have been done. Another breakthrough is when MMF created the NICU at Sassoon General Hospital. Thereafter others departments have been upgraded and a continuous follow up and reporting is done on a monthly basis.

- NICU Sassoon hospital - **125 Patients**
- Retinopathy of prematurity (ROP) is an eye disorder caused by abnormal blood vessel growth in the light sensitive part of the eyes (retina) of premature infants -

Total Screening 38

- Endoscopy surgery - **207 Patients**
- Dental Surgery - **11 Patients**

- Otoacoustic Emissions (OAE) screening can help to detect sensor neural hearing loss occurring in the cochlea. It can also call attention to hearing disorders affecting the pathway to the inner ear - **419 Patients**
- Hemophilia Screening - **4 Patients**
- Sonali ward(NICU) KEM Hospital - **2 Patients**

Finolex Industries Ltd and its CSR Partner Mukul Madhav Foundation inaugurated ophthalmic clinic at Gatha Mandir in Dehu Gaon , with the support of Sassoon General hospital in 2019, (this is re-ignited after the covid wave and should be merged with Sasson)

FIL/MMF donated advance machine for eye checkup at Dehu OPD and started eye checkup services for pilgrims and rural population of the Dehu and surrounding village.

Due to pandemics Sassoon general hospital closed the OPD services and now the Situation came an normal level we have followed with Sassoon general hospital and Gatha mandir to restart the ophthalmic clinic monthly once on Wednesday.

On 23rd March 2022, **25 Screening** has done and the referral is given to Medicine and for the surgery Sassoon Hospital vehicles will pick up all patients on Saturday and Monday they will drop the patients.



On the 17th of April 2022, at the 8th Camp 16 children with Type1 Diabetes were supported with insulin cartridges and laboratories test.

Mukul Madhav Foundation is supporting children with diabetes since 2016 and providing insulin vials and supporting with blood tests to deserving patients in collaboration with KEM hospital Pune.

To increase the support and reach of MMF in collaboration with the Diabetic Association of Vadodara (DAB) in Gujarat, MMF embarked to support up to **20 children with Type 1 diabetes** since September 2021.

The Children were given information about their insulin use and abuse by Dr Shusuil Patel, Diabetologist and Parents/children get new information regarding “Understand Diabetes in a Different Way”.

Parents and children got a chance to meet Dr Mona Shah, MD Endocrinologist, Dr Sushil Patel, Diabetologist, Dr Parag Rana, MD Physician(PG Diabetologist), Dr Vanishaben Nambiyar, Dietician and Dr Ravindra Nanavaty, Secretary of DAB to discussed their queries with these doctors regarding diet and insulin. This event was attended by Trustees and members of DAB, Senior Doctors associated with DAB, Past Diabetes Children supported by DAB, Parents and Type1 Children supported by FIL/MMF and Mr Nitul Barot from MMF were present for the same. DAB Trustees and Members expressed their gratitude and thanked the FIL/MMF management for monthly support.



Eye Check camp for drivers and ancillary staff of Finolex Industries Ltd

Finolex Industries and its CSR Partner Mukul Madhav Foundation organize Optometry and general health and well-being camp for drivers and ancillary staff. This was done in collaboration with H V Desai Hospital with their fully equipped mobile van with their medical team at Finolex Industries Ltd Corporate Office in Chinchwad 12th April and at Finolex Industries plant at Urse 15th April.

A total of **145 (62 to from Chinchwad and 83 from Urse)** individuals from both locations underwent these checkups. Further, assistance as needed would be supported by Mukul Madhav Foundation.



All the students participated and took keen interest in these activities enjoying the same.




COVID-19 Vaccination drive at Mukul Madhav Vidyalaya

As Health department opened up vaccinations for younger age group, a second round of vaccination drive was conducted on 13th April 2022 for students of the age group 12 to 14 years. Total of 100 students took their first dose of vaccination and 15 students got their second dose getting fully vaccinated. In total, **115 students** took benefit of this vaccination drive. First round of vaccination was organized on 13th January 2022 to provide vaccines to students from the age group of 15 to 18 years where 74 students took their first dose.
