Period Positive Holiday Home and Smokeless Chulhas built in Gadchiroli 28th October 2023

Mukul Madhav Foundation has been collaborating since 2017 with Kherwadi Social Welfare Association to support Tribal and Rural communities in Palghar, Gadchiroli, and Ratnagiri Districts in Maharashtra.

In Gadchiroli Mukul Madhav Foundation supported 15 villages with Period Positive Holiday Homes and Individual toilets for tribal families along with smokeless chulhas.

On 28th Oct 2023 Mukul Madhav Foundation inaugurated 3 new Period Positive Holiday Homes (taking the total to 18), and installed 40 smokeless chulhas in Yedasgandi, Kondwahi and Godalwahi village in Gadchiroli in the presence of Grampanchayat Members, villagers, and Mr. Bhagwat Pankaj, Finolex Representative from Nagpur.


The villagers were very happy and welcomed Finolex and those present with their traditional program.

This initiative is to empower and support tribal women in these villages, impacting their overall health and well-being. Period Positive Holiday Homes give tribal women the dignity they deserve, where previously they were treated like outcasts during their menstruating days, and banished to unsafe and dilapidated huts on the outskirts of the village. The innovative smokeless chulhas replace the traditional chulha that not only adversely impacted the health of women and children at home, but also impacted the environment.



Mukul Madhav Foundation extended their support to 17 government schools in Buxar – Bihar and Kota – Rajasthan. 30th October, 2023

On 30th October, Mukul Madhav Foundation signed an agreement with Yuva Unstoppable for the project School Transformation Project in Buxar - Bihar and Kota - Rajasthan in the presence of Shri Rahul Kumar (IRS), PS, Shri Ashvini Choubey (Minister of State for Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution from Buxar Bihar and Shri Raghvendra Singh, OSD, Shri Dinesh Parita, Executive Officer, OSD, Shri Om Birla (Speaker, Lok Sabha) along with Finolex Industries Limited representatives Mr. Anil Whabi, Former Managing Director Mr. Saurabh Dhanorkar Non-Executive Director Mr. Ashutosh Kulkarni CS and head legal, Mr. Sachin Kulkarni and Team Mukul Madhav Foundation, Mr. Amitabh Shah Founder Yuva Unstoppable and Team Yuva Unstoppable. In the 1st Phase of collaboration with Yuva Unstoppable, Mukul Madhav Foundation supported 9 government schools in Lucknow as per the appeal and request made by Shri Yogi Adityanath ji, Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh. We responded with 13 toilets for both boys and girls, 9 drinking water areas, 6 mid-day meal sheds and 7 dishwashing areas. Fully funded by Finolex Industries, the entire work of refurbishment, new tiling, new hardware.



Other such support will benefit 5491 students.

In this second phase, Mukul Madhav Foundation will support 7 schools in Buxar – Bihar, and 10 schools in Kota – Rajasthan with sanitation facilities, Mid-Day meals, and Clean and safe drinking water facilities which will benefit 5543 students.

This furthers our belief in creating sustainable, ongoing impactful projects.

Mukul Madhav Foundation has initiated holistic development through training for the women of Gavasad Village, including tailoring classes.

Mukul Madhav Foundation will conduct an awareness training session for the tailoring students, covering topics such as health, basic first aid, personal grooming, hygiene, personality development, communication skills, the importance of education for children, banking services and their benefits, and entrepreneurship for tailoring.

Today, on the 30th of October, the team from Shree Charitable Trust, a Vadodara-based NGO, delivered an awareness session on Budget Management, Negotiations, Marketing, Market Research, Entrepreneurship Skills, and how to set up a Small Business.

The women gained valuable insights into entrepreneurship skills and learned how to set up a new business.




Mukul Madhav Foundation supported Marathwada Mitra Mandal Polytechnic College in Pune with 24 computers for their language lab. 30th October, 2023

Mukul Madhav Foundation support destitute and vulnerable women in Jammu and Kashmir 30th October, 2023


In an endeavor to support livelihood opportunities for women-headed families, widows, farmer women and other vulnerable women, Mukul Madhav Foundation support 12 villages across the Kupwara / Pulwama & Budgam districts with the project Livelihood Support to Jammu Kashmir Vulnerable Families through Agro-based Small Scale projects. Directly benefiting 50 households in 1st Phase for livestock support (Microeconomic Initiative for landless women-headed households. 300 households benefited with Inputs (Seeds and tools) vegetables/fruits for small landholders/ poor farmers.

Indirectly benefiting 20000 rural population, in six villages with awareness sessions and better farming techniques.

Last year Mukul Madhav Foundation supported 20 women with 100 sheep in Jammu & Kashmir, now these women are benefitting very well with good income from the wool business.

Our on-ground partner is HELP (Human Efforts for Love and Peace) Foundation headed by Mrs Nighat Shafi Pandit who works with rural communities in violence-scarred Jammu and Kashmir. Belonging to a well-known Kashmiri family, Pandit is one of those rare women who stepped out of a comfortable home to address the pain and trauma of people caught up in a 16-year-long conflict.

Her organization, the Help Foundation, Jammu and Kashmir, focuses on, among other things, educating orphans, rehabilitating widows, and promoting peace and intercommunity harmony.

Our team got an audience and an attentive listening ear from the Personal Assistant to the Chief Minister of Maharashtra. It was a fruitful meeting, and a promise of deep and long collaboration with the government.

We discussed ways to collaborate on the various initiatives that the Government of Maharashtra is planning to start across districts.

- 1) Digital literacy
- 2) Supporting Farmers with basic equipment
- 3) Solar lights in rural Maharashtra
- 4) Online education for 10th class students
- 5) Skill development courses in school
- 6) Water management in cities
- 7) Spreading awareness and use of the Menstrual Cup





Besides these there are also other initiatives that they would like to implement with the collaboration of NGOs and CSR programmes.

We also shared details on the various initiatives we are currently implementing across Maharashtra, and India. Shri Kaksha expressed a readiness of the Government to collaborate on these initiatives too. He assured us of help on-ground from the CM office across all departments.

This meeting was very encouraging and gives us great hope to see our work find more impetus going ahead.





Mukul Madhav Foundation continues to support Yerwada Open Jail in Pune. 1st November, 2023

Mukul Madhav Foundation have been supporting the Yerwada Prison over the last 8 years with a health camp for women and children, skilling in tailoring for women prisoners, agriculture support in the open jail by training the inmates, and in August 2023 supported them with a canteen which is now operated by the Open Jail Prisoners

On 1st Nov. 2023, Mukul Madhav Foundation signed an agreement to renovate Daulatrao Jadhav Jail Officers Computer Training College Yerwada Jail Pune after their appeal and request for the same. This was done in the presence Mr. Amitabh Gupta (IPS) who is an ADG, Jails, Maharashtra, Dr Jalindar Supekar DIGP Deputy Inspector General of police, Mr. Nagesh Patil Superintendent Training Centre Jail and Mukul Madhav Foundation team.

This Training Center is to train Superintendents and Jail staff from all the districts of Maharashtra

2nd November, 2023

The inauguration was attended by Mr. Rajesh Gadhiya, the Superintendent of Police of Kheda District. During his visit, he had the opportunity to observe Mukul Madhav Foundation CP Center and expressed appreciation for our support. In his speech, he mentioned that it is truly commendable that though there are many industries in Kheda District, a company like Finolex Pipes Industries from Vadodara, supports this special cause in an unrelated district.



Our CP Center's initiative was covered by the Doordarshan News channel.

Our team also met with Mr Mehul Parmar, the Director of Sharda Social Welfare Trust (SSWT), and a physiotherapist. The key points discussed during the meeting were as follows:

- The therapy for the children is progressing well, and they are maintaining detailed records in a notebook. They also provide us with weekly therapy progress reports.
- SSWT recently organized an eye checkup camp with the support of the Lions Club, where children were diagnosed and provided with the necessary spectacles and guidance from doctors.
- Mr Parmar expressed his gratitude to FIL Management for placing an order for Toran and providing a platform for product showcasing at the Yellow Ribbon fair.
- As discussed with Chirag Sir, there is a plan to procure Diya Boxes for Gujarat's GWD kits from SSWT, and Mr Parmar requested it would be greatly appreciated if FIL/MMF could place an order for the same.
- Mr Parmar also requested, if possible, to provide 70 kits to their centre's children, including materials such as T-shirts, dental and hygiene kits, Diya, and sweets. This would serve as motivation for both specially-abled children and their parents. We promised that we would fulfill this appeal at the earliest.

We have been working in various domains such as Health, Education, Environment, Sanitation, Water conservation, Community Development and women empowerment for the last 30 years.

We have also been supporting various other projects and schemes that will help the community and other government departments. In continuation with the same, Mukul Madhav Foundation have donated 550 helmets to



the Police Department, Ratnagiri on 3rd November, 2023. The ceremony was held at police parade ground, Ratnagiri.

SP Ratnagiri Mr. Dhananjay Kulkarni, Additional SP Mrs. Jayshri Gaikwad, Director Technical, Finolex Industries, Mr Saumya Chakravarthy and members of Mukul Madhav Foundation team were present for the ceremony. SP Mr. Kulkarni appreciated this kind gesture of donating helmets taken by the Mukul Madhav Foundation. He stated that this will help prevent serious injuries in case of unavoidable accidents thereby benefitting the victim and improving Road safety. He also added that Mukul Madhav Foundation have always supported the Police department in various activities for many years.

Honourable District Collector, Mr. Devendra Singh also thanked Mukul Madhav Foundation for donating helmets to the police department. He also added that the use of the Helmets by the Police Department will increase awareness about the safety measures needed to be taken by the common public.

Kotana Village, near Masar plant, requested RO maintenance due to its high repair cost. The gram panchayat couldn't afford it, causing around 1200 villagers to suffer from a lack of pure drinking water. Mukul Madhav Foundation supported the cause.

The inauguration program on 10th November was attended by the President of Padra Taluka Panchayat, Village Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat Members. Mukul Foundation Villagers, and Madhav representatives. The Sarpanch of Kotana Village expressed gratitude, stating that the RO was non-functional for the last 6 months, causing significant hardship. He thanked Mukul Madhav Foundation for their support.

This Diwali, Mukul Madhav Foundation illuminated Jalalpura Village (Near FIL Masar) with LED Streetlights, symbolizing the triumph of light over darkness for the entire community.

10th November, 2023

Previously, Jalalpura Village had inadequate lighting, causing safety concerns and difficulty in moving around after nightfall. Responding to Jalalpura Gram Panchayat's request, Mukul Madhav Foundation supported the initiative by installing 100 streetlights, covering the entire village.

The inauguration was attended by the Village Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat Members, Villagers, and Mukul Madhav Foundation representatives.
