Nine local corporates united by MMF / FIL to collaborate on CSR projects in Padra. 25th April, 2024

MMF / FIL successfully conducted a CSR Meet at the FIL Masar Plant, with representatives from nine corporate entities in attendance.

Some of the corporates, including Transpek Industry and Alembic Pharma, shared their current projects at the forum, along with MMF/ FIL sharing their work and vision for the region. Additionally, Mr. Rajiv Ranjan (President FIL Operation),

Mr. Sanjay Ugale, and Mr. Kalpesh Parmar provided insights into the social impact of Finolex Pipes.

The highlight of the meeting was the collaborative discussion on six potential projects for the Padra Block, including TB Mukt Padra, Thalassemia Awareness, Water Conservation, Nutrition Project, Anganwadi Development, and a Training Center for dropouts.



Furthermore, all the corporate representatives present expressed their appreciation and thanked MMF / FIL for organizing the CSR Forum. They mentioned that some of the projects discussed were new to them, and they found the sharing of ideas beneficial. They proposed that every three months, one of the corporate entities could take the initiative to organize similar CSR Meets for sharing works and ideas. The region is set to gain manifold with this new collective impetus.





50 students receive HPV Cervavac vaccination. 26th April, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, organized a Cervavac-qHPV vaccine drive in coordination with Serum Institute and Villoo Poonawalla Memorial Hospital at Mahatma Gandhi School. A total of 50 students received the vaccination, with a second dose planned in October 2024.

Cervavac vaccine offers protection against HPV, causing cancer as well as genital warts in females and males between the age of 9 and 26 years. This is a Serum Institute initiative for protection against cervical cancer as well as other HPV-associated cancer through Cervavac – India's 1st indigenous gender neutral qHPV. This is also the most affordable HPV vaccine available in India.





145 women farmers to be trained in Vermicomposting and Organic Farming. 26th April, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, signed an agreement with the Kherwadi Social Welfare Association for Tribal Women Empowerment in the presence of Mr. Milind Chitre CEO Kherwadi Social Welfare Association and Team MMF.

145 women farmers in Palghar Maharashtra will be trained in Vermicomposting and Organic Farming by the Kherwadi Social Welfare Association (KSWA) team, as approved by The National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), Govt of India. Equipping them to increase income, promote sustainable agriculture, and facilitate interventions that mitigate climate change.

100 women in J&K skilled to rise above circumstances. 27th April, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, signed an agreement to uplift 100 women in Budgam, J&K with Sustainable Livelihoods. This agreement was signed with Help Foundation Srinagar in the presence of Nighat Shafi chairperson of Help Foundation, Ritu Prakash Chhabria Managing Trustee Mukul Madhav Foundation, and Team HF and MMF.

Through this initiative, 100 poor and marginalized women and adolescent girls from Budgam district, J&K will engage in gainful and sustainable livelihood activity through vocational training in cutting and tailoring and traditional hand embroidery. 50 of them trained in Garment Cutting and Tailoring, while 50 will be trained in Ari & Sozni work. We will also work with them to develop a rural marketing network and train the women in rural local marketing. Widows and single-women home-heads from the region would get a dignified source of income and would be able to improve the standards of living of their family members.






The project is designed to become self-sustaining in the long run as the capacities of the local people from J&K would be built who will take up the responsibility of moving the activities further.

Expert support extended to women entrepreneurs in Jarod and Halol, Gujarat. 27th April, 2024

With a focus on uplifting rural communities by empowering the women in that community, Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, signed an agreement with BAIF Institute for Sustainable Livelihoods and Development (BISLD) to launch Project UDYAMITA in Jarod and Halol in Vadodara, Gujarat. The agreement was signed on 27th April 2024 in the presence of Dr. V.B Dayasa Regional Director BAIF and Team MMF. The primary objective of this project is to empower the women in areas providing them these rural by comprehensive training, mentorship, and support to establish and grow their enterprises, thereby fostering sustainable rural development. This will be spearheaded by an action plan that includes the formation and capacity building of 50 Self-Help Groups, with over 500 women members. 200 of these women will be trained in cultivation of High-Value Crop and its Collective Marketing.





50 women will receive support for rural non-farm enterprises; 5 women for post-harvest based enterprises, and 5 will be supported to establish Poultry Hatchery Unit along with other innovative enterprises.





Commitment renewed to support 30 Type 1 Diabetic children in Pune. 27th April, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, extended their support into 2024-25 for the Juvenile Diabetic Project run by KEM Hospital and Diabetic Centre in Pune Maharashtra. The agreement was signed by Prof Chittaranjan Yajnik, Director, Diabetes Unit, KEM Hospital and team MMF. This collaboration began in December 2015, with MMF/FIL supporting Type 1 Diabetic children with monthly insulin and blood tests. 30 children currently benefit from this monthly support in Pune, and will continue to do so in 2024-25 too. Besides these 30 children in Pune, MMF/FIL also supports monthly insulin and blood tests for 122 other Type 1 diabetic children in Maharashtra (70 children in Jalgaon, 27 in Daund, and 25 in Karad Satara), 27 children in Vadodara, Gujarat, and 20 children across Vellore, Madurai and Coimbatore in Tamil Nadu. A total of 199 children every month.

SGH Scholarship for economicallydisadvantaged Engineering Students. 27th April, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation signed an agreement in the presence of Dr. Sonawane Registrar, College of Engineering at Pune Technological University, Professors and team MMF.

Funded by Managing Trustee Ritu Prakash Chhabria under the SGH Scholarship (Shri. Sanjay Gopichand Hinduja Scholarship), 10 M.Tech engineering students will be supported in their academic ambitions at the University. Covering the 2-year course, this scholarship will identify students at the College of Engineering who are from an economic-disadvantaged background and marginalized community to encourage them to complete their engineering course.









44 newly-weds in Padra gifted double beds. 28th April, 2024

Bariya Samaj organized a mass wedding (Samuhik Vivha) for 44 couples from underprivileged communities in Padra Block, near the FIL Masar Plant. Responding to a request for support from the community, MMF/ FIL gifted the newlyweds 44 double beds.

Around 5000 plus people attended this Samuhik Vivha, along with the Local MLA, MP, all Sarpanches of Padra Block, and representatives from MMF and FIL. The President of Bariya Samaj expressed gratitude for the gifts, mentioning that they had received a gift of 25 pressure cookers in 2022, 43 Steel Containers (Set of 6) in 2023, and again this year, they were blessed by FIL and MMF. The entire Bariya Samaj community expressed gratitude to the Company and Management.

INR 40 lakhs sanctioned to alleviate water problems in Pune city. 29th April, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, signed an agreement with Green Thumb to support de-silting of Khadakwasla Dam, in the presence of Mr. Anil Whabi Former Managing Director of Finolex Industries Limited, Mr. Saurabh Dhanorkar, Director Finolex Industries Limited,

Mr. Yogesh Aprukar Sales FIL Pune, Col. Suresh Patil Founder Green Thumb and Mr. Babalu Mokale Mukul Madhav Foundation. Support has been extended for 2 kms out of a total of 25 kms, at a cost of Rs. 20 lakhs per km.

This year, desilting of the dams around Pune city has been undertaken to increase the water storing capacity of these dams and thus meet the water requirements of Pune city and surrounding areas. Four dams (Varasgaon, Panshet, Temghar and Khadakwasla) is being desilted in the months preceding the monsoons, when the waters recede, allowing for desilting using JCBs, dozer, grader, poclain and dumper truck and tippers. The silt is being pitched and bonded on the periphery of the lake, while excess silt is being distributed to locals and farmers for free.








Livelihood skilling for young women in urban vulnerable communities. 30th April, 2024

Most young women in communities on the fringes of urban areas, especially slums, are easily compelled to seek income sources which compromise their dignity and sense of power. On 30th April 2024, Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR Partner to Finolex Industries Limited, signed an agreement with Action Aid Association to create decent work opportunities for Young Urban Women (YUWs) from urban slum areas and Young Women from Vulnerable Communities in Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.


This agreement was signed in the presence of Mrs Ritu Prakash Chhabria, Managing Trustee, Mukul Madhav Foundation, Mr. Sandeep Chachra, Executive Director, Action Aid Association and team MMF and AAA. This initiative seeks to enhance employability and livelihood options among Young Urban women - to provide them support to start their own enterprises, and to link them and their families with protection schemes and other government benefits. These bright young women will trained in speaking English Communication, in skills required to run and manage a Beauty Salon, with training in Nail Art and Professional Makeup. Some can also choose to be trained to drive E-Rickshaws. The support to these women will extend into helping them to set-up and market their enterprises too. Ensuring that they can choose to live a life of dignity, on their own terms.



Water supply infra installed to benefit 85 HIV-affected children. 3rd May, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR Partner to Finolex Industries Limited, collaborated with Survodaya Foundation to fulfill the water requirements of 85 HIV-affected children (across 24 families) residing in Sevalaya NGO.

Located in Latur, Maharashtra, the institution needed a well and pipeline to fulfill the water needs of the residents. With water required for drinking, cooking, sanitation, and other purposes. MMF/FIL stepped forward with a water supply scheme in collaboration with Survodaya Foundation, thereby fulfilling the water requirements of the HIV-affected children and their families and improving their quality of life.







Monthly TB Support

Mukul Madhav Foundation supports NI-KSHAY (Ni=End, Kshay=TB) an initiative of the Government of India. Mukul Madhav Foundation has extended support in Pune, Ratangiri, Gujarat and Uttar Pradesh in line with the National TB Elimination Programme (NTEP), which aims to eliminate TB by 2025 as announced by the Honorable Prime Minister Shri, Narendra Modi.



304 students to benefit from sanitation project in Tamil Nadu. 3rd May, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR Partner to Finolex Industries Limited, signed an agreement with Seppakullampatti Govt. Primary and Middle school and Perumparrampuppati Govt. Primary and Middle School to support them with the renovation of their existing toilet block and sanitation facilities that will benefit 304 students, along with teachers and staff.







Refurbished Audiometry Room at KEM Hospital, Pune. 6th May, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner of Finolex Industries Limited, built upon its continuing partnership with KEM Hospital, Pune. This time, as part of the birthday celebrations of Executive Chairman of Finolex Industries, they refurbished and upgraded the Audiometry Room.

Set up 50 years ago, the Audiometry room at KEM Hospital, Pune was in need of immediate refurbishment. MMF responded to the appeal by Big Ears at KEM Hospital, Pune to promptly get the Audiometry room redone as quickly as possible so as not to inconvenience patients.

This inauguration was done at the esteemed hands of Dr. Vikram Phatak-Chairman Indian Red Cross, alongside Dr. Neelam Vaid, ENT surgeon & HOD Big Ears KEM, Dr. Madhur Rao - Dy Medical Administrator, KEM, , Pune, Mr. Milind Purandare - Board member of Indian Red Cross and MMF representative.

MMF's past and ongoing support to KEM Hospital includes setting up the first PICU in Pune, Sonali ward in the NICU, play room, monthly diabetic camp supporting 15 to 20 children, monthly chemist payment that supports needy patients, medical equipment, NRIS and Nanoduct machine to support children have been provided.

Renovation of Government School infra and facilities in Jaipur. 6th May, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR Partner to Finolex Industries Limited, signed an agreement with Govt. Upper Primary School Badhbaldevpura, Kotkhawda Block, Jaipur, to undertake comprehensive renovation and upgradation of the school infrastructure and facilities. On 8th May, the work commenced with a pooja and a coconut-breaking ceremony in the presence of Mr. Hemant Chaturvedi (Representative, MMF), Mr. Harish Kumar (Head Master), Mr. Sudhir Mishra (Representative, Finolex) Mrs. Renulata, and Mrs. Radha Sharma, Mr. Dharamsingh Gujjar (Teacher), Gopal ji (SMC Member), Kalji (Bheem singh Builder) Ramji Lal (Wardpanch).



As per the agreement, MMF will carry out renovation work including constructing a new roof for one classroom, maintaining roofs of the remaining 7 classrooms, repairing toilet facilities, installing interlocking tiles, constructing a handwashing station, repairing the boundary wall, and building an assembly platform. This collaboration aims to significantly improve the school's infrastructure and create a conducive learning environment for the students








125 visually impaired families supported in Vaingani, Maharashtra. 6th May, 2024

Some people might be denied an ability like sight or mobility, but in its place they always seem to have been endowed with an abundance of resilience and positive enthusiasm. Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR Partner to Finolex Industries Limited, engaged with one such group of 125 visually impaired families on 6th May 2024. Not letting their visual impairment stop them, they earn a living singing, or selling small-ticket items on trains running between Karjat, Lonavla and Pune.

On the occasion of the birthday of the Executive Chairman of Finolex Industries, Mr Prakash P Chhabria, the company gifted a month of grocery support to these families living in Vaingani near Karjat, Dist Raigad. This was done in the presence of Mr Sambhaji Badar Trustee, Mr Dhumal, Mrs Sheetal Kalidarsan and Mr Jadhav Jitendra from MMF and other staff members.

37 screened at monthly ophthalmic camp in Dehu Gaon. 8th May, 2024

If you've been following this initiative over the last couple of months, you would know the ups and downs it has endured. The monthly ophthalmic clinic at Gatha Mandir in Dehu Gaon started in 2019. with the support of Sassoon General Hospital. The pandemic stopped it, and when it restarted there were very few who would attend the OPD every month. With consistent efforts. visiting neighbouring villages to create awareness. arranging for transport, etc there was a gradual increase in monthly attendance. With a monthly average of 30 screenings, and free cataract surgeries as follow-through done at Sassoon Hospital.



This month saw a slight but heartening increase in attendance, with 37 senior citizens being screened. Out of which 8 have been referred to Sassoon Hospital for cataract surgery. This brings the total number of screenings to 700 since 2019. With senior citizens screened for cataract, Pterygium, refraction, and other eye infections, all receiving free treatment post-camp at Sassoon Hospital.

This project marks a significant step towards improving the lives of those living on the outskirts of Piludra Village, ensuring they have access to clean drinking water. The community expresses gratitude for the support and efforts of all those involved in making this project a success.

250 rural families to get permanent supply of drinking water. 10th May, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, signed an agreement and attended a Coconut Breaking Ceremony at Piludra Village (Near FIL Masar) for a water supply scheme that will benefit 250 families on the outskirts of the village. The project aims to provide sustainable, equitable, consistent, economically safe, and adequate water to support the community.

The installation of the pipes has begun and is scheduled to be completed by the end of June. This project ensures permanent drinking water security in rural areas and addresses the drinking water problem faced by villagers. The ceremony was attended by the Village Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat Members, beneficiaries of the project, as well as Mr. Sachin Bhatiya, FIL Civil Manager; Mr. Nayan Rana, FIL EHS Manager; and Mr. Nitul Barot, CSR Department MMF-FIL representative.

Impacting 10000 families with surgical interventions within Ahmedabad slums. 10th May, 2024

On May 10, 2024, a significant agreement was formalized for Phase 2 between Mukul Madhav Foundation and SAATH Livelihood Services in Ahmedabad, along with a team of doctors based in the city: Dr. Rahul Jindal, Dr. Keyur Buch, and Dr. Kranti Vohra. This landmark initiative focuses on Surgical Accredited & Trained Healthcare for low-income households residing in the Slum GIDC areas of Vatva, Ahmedabad.



During February and March 2024, MMF, along with implementation partner SAATH, conducted the Pilot Project, covering a total of 3,727 households with a population of 14,530. They identified 182 unmet surgical needs, of which 38 surgeries were completed, with the rest to be covered in Phase 2.

Besides completing the remaining 144 identified surgical needs, Phase 2 is set to positively impact over 10,000 families. Collaborating with implementation partner SAATH, the initiative aims to address and reduce the unmet surgical needs within marginalized populations. By leveraging Government Hospital facilities and government schemes such as the Ayushman card, the project endeavors to enhance access to free or subsidized surgical care for the marginalized population in the target area.





Furthermore, SSWT will involve these children in vocational training programs and provide opportunities for them to participate in special sports events at both national and international levels. This holistic approach aims to not only enhance the physical and cognitive abilities of these children but also to promote their social inclusion and overall well-being.



69 differently-abled children to receive on-going therapy. 10th May, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation has recently signed an agreement with Sharda Social Welfare Trust (SSWT) for the second consecutive year to extend support to a CP Center in Gujarat. This center provides children with Cerebral Palsy (CP) and other disabilities, with regular therapy sessions conducted by trained therapists.

Under this collaboration, a total of 69 patients diagnosed with cerebral palsy, mental retardation, autism, multiple disabilities, hearing impairment, Down syndrome, and other disabilities will receive therapy from physiotherapists, occupational therapists, and speech therapists. Additionally, MMF and SSWT will jointly organize assessment camps twice a year to monitor the progress and tailor therapy plans for these patients.

60 women to be trained in Beauty and Wellness. 10th May, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR Partner to Finolex Industries Limited, in collaboration with Samparka, signed an addendum FICCI FLO Bangalore Chapter for the Women Livelihood-Beautician and Wellness initiative in Bangalore Karnataka. This was done in the presence of Mr. Rajanna S. Managing Trustee Samarpaka with Team Dr. Nupur Handa Chairperson FLO Bangalore and team, and Team MMF.

The program will cover 60 women and adolescent girls divided into 10 batches, in identified talukas and towns of Chikkaballapur district, 60 kms from Bangalore, Karnataka. With the objective to empower and train these women as beauticians and wellness experts, such that they can improve their chances of employability in rural and semi-urban communities, enabling them to work out a sustainable model for the communities to manage their livelihood.



Mukul Madhav Foundation and BAIF Livelihoods signed an agreement aimed at driving rural development in the Padra Block, Vadodara. Covering five villages and impacting over 1280 residents and their livestock, this project is set to make a profound difference.

The first phase planned from May 2024 to March 2025, will look at Crop Diversification, Vegetable Production, Livestock Management, Empowerment of Women Increased Milk Productivity, Farmers. Capacity Building, Holistic Development and Income Generation. With the express intention to: Enhance Milk Productivity: Through genetic improvement; Improve Cattle Health: Ensuring the livestock; Increase Vegetable well-being of Production: Resulting in increased income for Empower Women: Economically farmers: empowering women farmers and reducing farming drudgery; Create Economic Resilience: Contributing








to overall economic resilience and improved livelihoods in the villages; Increase Household Income: Elevating the standard of living for participating households.

Through this collaborative effort, we are committed to fostering sustainable development, empowering communities, and creating a brighter future for rural India.



The project aims to organize rural poor women with entrepreneurship potential into groups to build their capital through regular savings, disciplined credit and secure social security for themselves. Equipping them with domain specific knowledge and skills to tap local resources and map entrepreneurial opportunities. And then linking them to smart micro-entrepreneurship with Govt Schemes and CSR. This is set to impact 50 Self-help groups (new and old), with over 500 women members. With 200 members in cultivation of high-value crops and their collective marketing, 50 women in rural non-farm enterprises, and 5 members in post-harvest based enterprises.

500 women in Self-help groups to benefit from initiative in Uttarakhand. 11th May, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, signed an agreement with BAIF Institute for Sustainable Livelihoods and Development (BISLD) to launch Project UDYAMITA in Haljora In Haridwar region, Uttarakhand. This was signed in the presence of Mr. Raviraj Yadav – Regional Director North BAIF, Mr. Mori, Mr. Sandeep Yadav and Dr. Rajashree Joshi Director of BAIF and Mr. Nitul Barot from FIL Gujarat and Mr. Babalu Mokale from MMF Pune.



Sustainable Mushroom Cultivation for 150 women in Assam. 14th May, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, identified an opportunity to empower tribal women in Nalbari and Kamrup District of Assam State. Taking this on in collaboration with FICCI Flo North East Chapter, an agreement was signed in the presence of Ms. Shweta Jindal, Chairperson Flo Northeast, Mr. Mujimdar Director, Yuva Vikas Kendra, and Team MMF. This project seeks to empower 150 women with financial independence through training and support in mushroom cultivation. Each will receive training in the principles and practices of mushroom cultivation, the skills and knowledge to establish and manage their mushroom



production units, and support to sustain it. Besides fostering entrepreneurship and income generation among these women, this will also help promote sustainable livelihood options and improve nutritional security in these rural communities.

57 screenings done at Mammography Camp. 15th,16th,17th May, 2024

A three-day mammography camp was conducted at Bharati Hospital where a total of 57 screenings and testings were done. This camp is conducted every month, with over 297 screenings till date of women above 35 years. The camp offers women Gynecologists' Consultancy, Pap Smear test, Mammography, Sono Mammography, CBC (Complete Blood Count) and HIV, Dietician Consultation, Blood Pressure, Height, Weight Measurement.







200 women in West Bengal buffer household income with Poultry farming. 20th May, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, in collaboration with FICCI FLO Kolkata Chapter signed an agreement for Poultry Development Services Programme with Shivia Livelihood Foundation to support 200 farmers with Poultry Farming Know-how and Kits. This was signed in the presence of Ms. Shradha Murarka Chairperson FLO Kolakta and FLO Kolkata members, Ms. Khursheed Khurody, Chairman Shivia Livelihood Foundation, Ms. Olivia Belcher, Director and Team Shivia along with Team MMF.

The project is focused on increasing the income of extremely poor and vulnerable tribal households in the Chhatna district of West Bengal, by offering 200 tribal women 1,200 toolkits that include 10 one-day old chicks/ducks, poultry vaccinations and medicines to prevent disease and 2 kg bag of poultry starter feed to last two weeks. This will give them a supplementary income, and a sense of dignity with an improved standard of living.

200 women in Odisha to train in Bio-farming. 20th May, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, signed an Agreement with Shivia Livelihood Foundation for Agri-management Services (AMS) in the presence of Ms. Khursheed Khurody, Chairman Shivia Livelihood Foundation, Ms Olivia Belcher, Director and Team Shivia along with Team MMF. The project will be implemented in the Gajapati district of Odisha with 200 small and marginal women farmers training in biofarming and sustainable agricultural practices using natural resources. This will decrease cost of crop production, increase yield, ensure food security for this community, and simultaneously increase their income by at least 25-30%.
