## Update on Project : Vermi Composting and Organic Farming in Palghar district as on July 20, 2024

The KSWA team identified two gram panchayats in Wada block, Palghar district, namely, Shele and Shirsad to implement the said project. The criteria were women from the schedule tribes who have access to animal dung and are interested in implementing natural interventions.

In the first week of May 2024, the KSWA team presented the project to various hamlets in the two gram panchayats.

Each woman has been given 750 gms of earthworms to be dropped in their vermi – drums (250 gms per drum).

The first cycle of vermi compost should be ready for harvesting in the last week of August 2024 ( @ 45 days ).
