67 screened at monthly Mammography camp at Bharati Hospital. 27th - 29th August, 2024



A three-day mammography camp was conducted by Mukul Madhav Foundation and Finolex Industries Limited in collaboration with Bharati Hospital where a total of 67 screenings and testings were done. Tests included Gynecologists' Consultancy, Pap Smear, Mammography, Sono Mammography, CBC (Complete Blood Count) and HIV, Dietician Consultation, Blood Pressure, Height, Weight Measurement. This is a monthly camp for women over the age of 35.

9000+ vulnerable people across Mumbai to be impacted through new collaboration. 29th August, 2024

A significant collaboration between the Mukul Madhav Foundation (MMF) and the Rangoonwala Foundation (India) Trust (RFI) was formalized on August 29th in the presence of Mrs. Ritu Prakash Chhabria, Managing Trustee of MMF, along with her team, and Mr. Asif Rangoonwala, Trustee and Founder of RFI, alongside RFI trustees and team members.

Overall, the project is expected to reach across various vulnerable groups.

The partnership aims to implement a six-month pilot project designed to support 9,000 beneficiaries in vulnerable communities across various regions in Mumbai, including Andheri, Malad, and Kandivali. Beneficiaries will include 5189 students, 250 teachers, 150 teenagers, 120 parents, 1600 women, 1180 seniors, and 720 young people. The project will primarily focus on fostering education, health, and community engagement through life skills building, environmental and health awareness, mentoring and counselling, mental health support, social programmes, cultural sensitization and vocational training.



145 students attend health camp at Pune school.
30th August, 2024

On 30th August a Health Camp was conducted at Dr Kalmadi Shamrao High School, a Kannada Medium school in Pune, in collaboration with doctors and staff from Bharati Hospital and H V Desai Eye Hospital. A total of 145 students in the age group of 13-15 years were screened, along with informative sessions on health, hygiene and nutrition. Prescriptions were handed over to the respective class teachers. Out of the 145 students, 43 were referred for refraction, 5 were referred to Pediatrics, 7 to follow-up with ENT, and 92 were suggested dental treatment. One 14 year old girl who complained of chest discomfort was administered urgent treatment.



Food kits distributed to flood-affected communities in Jambusar, Gujarat.
31st August, 2024

Incessant rains in parts of Gujarat left many villages inundated, and families stranded. The villages in Jambusar taluka in Gujarat were severely affected with the Dhadhar river rising above danger levels to submerge farms and homes. Causing significant damage to crops, homes and livestock.

With further cyclone alerts being issued across Gujarat by the authorities, the villages in Jambusar were stranded without food. Responding to the situation, Mukul Madhav Foundation, with the support of its CSR partner Finolex Industries and the BAPS Swaminarayan Temple in Jambusar, Gujarat, travelled door-to-door distributing food kits in the affected areas. A total of 1,000 kits were handed over, each containing biscuits and savouries. These efforts were graced by the presence of Pu. Shri Gyanved Swami and Pu. Shri Narayan Kirtidas Swami, along with dedicated volunteers from BAPS Temple. Representing MMF-FIL were Mr. Bupendra Parmar, Mr. Kiran Solanki, Mr. Tasvir Suthar, and Mr. Nitul Barot.





Essential ration and hygiene kits provided to flood-affected workers in Vadodara. 3rd September, 2024

The cyclone over Kutch and several parts of Gujarat, inundated Vadodara. Leaving citizens stranded and without basic essentials. Amongst distressing news from the region, the plight of several locals associated with the CSR partner of Mukul Madhav Foundation, Finolex Industries Limited was brought to notice of Mr. Paresh Prajapati of the Sales team. Around 140 labor workers, tempo and pipe delivery drivers, and shopkeepers were identified in Vadodara in need of immediate relief. In association with Finolex Dealer in Vadodara - Atul Trading Corporation, essential ration and hygiene kits were distributed. The kits included rice, wheat flour, moong dal, desi channa, sooji, oil, sugar, tea, Dettol soap, Dettol liquid, matchboxes, candles, toothbrushes, toothpaste, biscuits, and namkeen.



Collab with BAIF to empower rural communities in Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra. 3rd September, 2024

Marking a significant step towards enhancing agricultural practices and rural livelihoods in specific regions of India, an agreement was signed between Mukul Madhav Foundation, as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, and BAIF Development Research Foundation to spearhead projects in Bundelkhand, Uttar Pradesh, and Khandala, Maharashtra. The agreement was signed in the presence of Mr. V. B. Dayasa, Regional Director of BAIF; Mrs. Rajashree Joshi, Director of BAIF; and Ms. Lily Shukla, Sr. General Manager Finance at Finolex Industries Limited, along with MMF teams. The project aims to cover three districts in Bundelkhand, Uttar Pradesh, with an emphasis on integrating modern agricultural techniques and sustainable practices. While focussing on three villages in Khandala, Maharashtra to address local agricultural needs and community development there.



Strategic emphasis will be placed on Empowering Rural Women, Creating Sustainable Enterprises, Group Enterprise Formation, and Improving Market Access. Though diverse, these areas are interconnected and simultaneous focus will not only boost individual livelihoods but also contribute to broader community development to create a holistic improvement in the lives of rural communities.

MMF supports Sangram Singh's journey into Mixed Martial Arts.
3rd September, 2024

The commitment of Mukul Madhav Foundation to society as a whole, with the support of CSR Partner Finolex Industries, goes much beyond the expected spaces of healthcare, education, women empowerment and sanitation. 3rd September 2024 witnessed the commitment of MMF/FIL to empowering youth and society through sports. Showing their support for two-time Commonwealth Heavyweight Champion, Sangram Singh's foray into Mixed Martial Arts (MMA) at a press conference organised by GAMA in Delhi that was graced by Indian Actress Payal Rohatgi, George Gocheleishvili, (President and Founder of GAMA), Giga Kukhalashvili (Chairman & Founder of GAMA and World Champion Fighter), Bhupesh Kumar (Indian Coach), and Jitendra Singh (owner, Heinrich). 24 seniors screened at Monthly
Ophthalmic Clinic.
4th September, 2024

On September 4th, a total of 24 senior citizens were screened for conditions such as cataract, pterygium, refractive errors, and other irregularities as part of a monthly ophthalmic clinic at Gatha Mandir in Dehu Gaon. Mukul Madhav Foundation, as CSR partner of Finolex Industries Ltd, has been conducting these clinics since 2019 (with a break due to Covid in 2020). Supported by Sassoon General Hospital, awareness sessions are conducted in nearby villages to inform residents of the monthly OPD timings, ensuring an average of 30 screenings every month, with 724 screening till date. Out of the 24 screened in September, six were identified with refractive errors, while five seniors were referred for cataract surgery which was immediately conducted the next day for free at Sassoon Hospital.



146 bags of precious blood collected
across 2 blood donation camps.
5th September, 2024

On 5th September, two Blood Donation camps were conducted in Pune at Agriculture College and Government Polytechnic College. There was a great response to the call for blood, with a total of 146 students stepping forward to make a difference. Thanks to this conscientious act, a total of 146 bags of blood were collected, that amounted to over 51 litres of this life-giving fluid. With 63 donors from the Agriculture college, and 83 donors from Government Polytechnic college. This generous donation holds the potential to save the lives of nearly 430+ people.



MTEch scholarship students
enter 2nd year.
6th September, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner to Finolex Industries Limited, has been supporting the education spectrum since its inception as part of the vision of its founders. With scholarships given in India and overseas to students in multiple streams. Some scholarships are dedicated to Agriculture through Agriculture College, Nursing through Lila Poonawala Foundation, Laboratory Technology through BEL AIR, and STEM scholarships at Kings College London.

Since 2023 MMF/FIL have also been supporting 20 engineering students pursuing their M Tech (2023-25 batch) at College of Engineering, Pune.

These students have been selected under the Late. Smt. Mohini Pralhad Chhabria scholarship. As the scholarship enters its second year, an interaction was organised on 6th September between the student beneficiaries and team members of MMF and FIL.




70 villages in Bihar set to become safe
and nurturing spaces for children.
11th September, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner of Finolex Industries Limited signed an agreement with British Asian Trust to build family and community resilience, ensure children are in school and strengthen systems for child protection. Looking to implement a holistic prevention model to create 70 child-friendly villages in six blocks across four districts of Bihar.

The project plans to build community leadership to address issues related to child well-being; ensure safety nets for child protection; build economic resilience of the poorest families by linking them with relevant social security schemes; build relationships with critical government stakeholders; and upscale the impact of community-level initiatives for systems change at the district-level.



These interventions will be essential in mitigating the vulnerabilities that often force families to pull their children out of school, and in extreme cases, send them to work to supplement family income, or arrange a marriage to reduce the financial burden

**Rural Ayurvedic Hospital upgraded with state-of-the-art equipment.
11th September, 2024**

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner of Finolex Industries Limited signed an agreement with Shri. Shivparvati Sarvajanic Vikas Trust to support Green Fingers Ayurvedic Hospital and Research Centre, Shankarnagar Akulj, with state-of-the-art equipment - Dental Chair, OT tables, Ophthalmic Chair, ECG Machine and X-ray Machine. This will support the stellar work being done by the hospital for people in the rural part of Solapur and surrounding small villages, offering them free medical checkups and ayurvedic medicines.

Dysfunctional diagnosis machine replaced at Pune NICU. 13th September, 2024

In 2017, Mukul Madhav Foundation and Finolex Industries Limited set up a 59-bed Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at Sassoon Hospital, a facility dedicated to providing comprehensive care for neonates. Since its opening, the NICU has equipped itself with essential diagnostic tools, including 2D echo for heart screening, ABG machines for blood analysis, ROP screening for eye health, and OAE screening for hearing, all aimed at ensuring that babies are discharged in good health.

The involvement of MMF/FIL did not end with the setup, but in fact began there. The foundation constantly seeks ways to maintain the excellence of care provided by the NICU with regular maintenance, repair, replacement and upgradation of the equipment. Besides organising regular training and awareness programmes for staff and parents. Recently, the otoacoustic emissions (OAE) machine was found to be malfunctioning. This device is critical in detecting any hearing abnormalities in a newborn child. Following an urgent appeal from Sassoon Hospital, MMF/FIL immediately arranged for a new OAE machine and successfully handed over the same to the NICU department. The handover was conducted on 13th September in the presence of Associate Professor Dr. Sameer Pawar, OAE Technician Dr. Santosh Nale, Resident Doctors, MMF team members Mr. Yogesh Rokade and Miss Yasmin Shaikh.





Sexual & Reproductive Health Education Program launched in Gadchiroli. 13th September, 2024

On 13th September, Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR Partner to Finolex Industries Limited signed an agreement with SEARCH Organization to launch a Sexual & Reproductive Health Education Program for Youth, Adolescents & Women in Gadchiroli.

The agreement was signed in the presence of Mrs. Ritu P. Chhabria Managing Trustee – Mukul Madhav Foundation, Dr. Abhay Bang Director, SEARCH, Dr. Rani Bang Co-director, SEARCH, Mr. D. V. Iyer Company Secretary Finolex Industries Limited and Team MMF.

This ambitious project seeks to impart sexual and reproductive health education to youth and adolescents (SRHEYA) & women in Gadchiroli to increase awareness about sexual health and to bring appropriate changes in their behaviour resulting in better health of youth, adolescents & women; and to prepare training module to enable SRHEYA through the use of social media, reaching youth all over Maharashtra; as well as to promote sports for healthy lifestyle and community leadership amongst the tribal youth of Gadchiroli. It will in total impact 12000 youth from various colleges, 6000 parents and 15000 tribal adolescents in ASHRAM Schools in all 12 blocks of Gadchiroli.



**Boarding costs support for 260 resident students in Rajasthan.
14th September, 2024**

On September 14, 2024, Mukul Madhav Foundation and Finolex Industries Limited signed an agreement with Rashtriya Balkalyan Sansatha (RBKS) Rajasthan that will effectively improve the health, nutrition and allied aspects crucial in reducing drop-out rates amongst the tribal girls in Jhadol, Rajasthan.

The agreement was formalized in the presence of Mrs. Ritu P. Chhabria, Managing Trustee of Mukul Madhav Foundation; Mr. Girja Shankar Ji, CMD of RBKS; and Mr. D.V. Iyer Company Secretary Finolex Industries Limited and Team MMF.

Since 2019, MMF/FIL has been supporting RBKS in addressing various education-related needs for these tribal girls. This year this support will cover mess charges, maintenance costs, and miscellaneous expenses, including toiletries, for 306 individuals (260 students residing in the hostel at Jhadol and 46 staff members).

**MMF supports fundraising event by Red Cross for Thalassaemia.
14th September, 2024**

Mukul Madhav Foundation (MMF) and Finolex Industries Ltd. proudly supported a fundraising event organized by the Red Cross to raise funds for thalassaemia patients. The event aimed to generate awareness and provide critical resources for those affected by this genetic blood disorder. Represented by Shalom Paul at the event, MMF and Finolex Industries contributed to the program, reinforcing their ongoing commitment to healthcare initiatives and community welfare.



**700 individuals to benefit from project for Deafblindness and Multiple Disabilities.
14th September, 2024**

Taking forward a fruitful relationship that began in 2023, Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR Partner of Finolex Industries Limited, signed an agreement with Sense International to enhance support for individuals with deafblindness and multiple disabilities in Assam and Rajasthan through education and rehabilitation services.

This agreement was signed in the presence of Mrs. Ritu P. Chhabria, Managing Trustee of Mukul Madhav Foundation; Mr. Akhil Paul, Director of Sense International; Mr. D.V. Iyer, Company Secretary of Finolex Industries Limited; and teams from Mukul Madhav Foundation and Sense International.

With the aim to strengthen comprehensive education and rehabilitation services for 175 children and adults with deafblindness and multiple disabilities, the project will impact a total of 500 individuals in Assam, and 200 in Rajasthan, including the afflicted, their parents and siblings.



Dialysis machine donated to
Dr Babasaheb Ambekdar Cantonment
General Hospital.
16th September, 2024

Mukul Madhav Foundation as CSR partner of Finolex Industries Limited is rigorously intent on supporting hospitals, clinics, health care centres and medical systems to stay relevant, useful and upgraded. Especially in regions plagued by poor infrastructure and deteriorating facilities. Further to this MMF signed an agreement with Khadki Cantonment Boards'.

Dr Babasaheb Ambekdar Cantonment General Hospital in the presence of Dr. R. C. Bhonsale Medical officer, Mrs Pooja Anand and team Mukul Madhav Foundation. With this agreement, MMF/FIL added a new Dialysis machine to the hospital which will help patients from marginalized communities. This joins the ventilator provided in 2022 to the hospital. Besides this hospital, MMF/FIL has now successfully established dialysis centres in three other places - Jejuri Devstan Saswad, Sewabhavan Pune, and Seth Tarachand Hospital, Pune.



Earlier MMF/FIL also supported the Hospice with a vehicle for home-based palliative care, along with grocery kits for Cancer Patients and their families.

New Wing inaugurated at Ganga Prem
Hospice, Rishikesh.
16th September, 2024

Work on a new West wing at Ganga Prem Hospice in Rishikesh, Uttarakhand was started on 11th December 2023 with support of Mukul Madhav Foundation and Finolex Industries Limited. Nine months later, on 16th September, the thoughtfully designed space was ready.

Located at the foot of the Himalayas on the bank of the river Ganga, at Gohri Maphi near Rishikesh and Haridwar, the Hospice provides medical, emotional, and spiritual support for individuals and their grieving families.

**Agreement inked to benefit 2000+ children across Padra Block.
17th September, 2024**

In an exciting new development, Mukul Madhav Foundation is partnering with Learning Links Foundation (LLF) with a vision to prepare young adolescents for the 21st century and their post-school lives ahead. LLF is a not-for-profit organization that works to improve education and support social innovation in India.

On 17th September an agreement was signed for the Road to Livelihood Program, in the presence of Mrs. Ritu Prakash Chhabria and team MMF, alongwith Ms. Nuriya Ansari and Mr. Dibyayan Datta representing LLF.

With an initial 18 month plan, this project aims to deliver life-changing outcomes to 2000 children across 5 schools in Padra Block. Equipping students with essential 21st-century skills to help them navigate adolescence and reach their full potential so they can thrive post-school. Building their competency in Information and Communication Technology, to prepare them for a technology-driven future. Boosting spoken English skills, enhancing communication and confidence for effective real-world communication. Providing them with comprehensive guidance and counseling, so that each of them can identify and achieve their career goals.

Ensuring that each of these 2000 children stand tall and proud as contributing citizens of India.

On 21st September, District Collector Ratnagiri and ZP Ratnagiri organized a "Cleaning Drive" for all beaches in Ratnagiri District. **402 college students screened
for Thalassemia.
24th - 25th September, 2024**

Mukul Madhav Foundation, in collaboration with Finolex Industries Limited as their CSR partner, organised a Thalassemia and Diabetes awareness sessions at Maratha Mitra Mandal on 24th September, and at Government Polytechnic College on 25th September with total attendance of 200 and screening of 142, and 352 attendance and 260 screenings respectively. This was done with the coordination of Dr Nita Munshi (Thalassemia Society of Pune chapter) and Dr. Neelima Nagarkar (KEM Hospital).

MMF/FIL began to actively promote Thalassemia and Diabetes awareness across Pune, Satara, Ratnagiri, and Jalgaon in October 2023. Since then over 4000 students have been reached through awareness sessions, over 3200 tests at 19 colleges have been conducted. Identifying 52 students with minor Thalassemia and other conditions like anemia, sickle cell disease, and diabetes.
