Cattle Rehabilitation Project, Vadodara. 30th April 2025

On the auspicious day of "Akshaya Tritiya", Finolex Industries Limited and Mukul Madhav Foundation renewed their commitment to animal welfare by signing an agreement to support and adopt 78 cows and 28 calves at Lakulish Dham Ashram, Kayavarohan, Vadodara under the Cattle Rehabilitation Project.

Since January 2024, FIL-MMF has been partially supporting the nutritional needs of these cows. With this renewal, we continue to provide food and health-related support for these animals — most of whom are rescued from the streets and abandoned due to their inability to produce milk.

Lakulish Dham Ashram has been selflessly managing a Gau Shala that gives shelter and care to such neglected cattle. To sustain this noble mission, they sought support from MMF — a request we were proud to honor. Shree Pritam Muni, Guruji and Trustee of the Ashram, expressed his heartfelt gratitude to FIL-MMF for playing a vital role in ensuring the well-being of these voiceless beings. 

Preserving Water Bodies in Maharashtra. 30th April 2025

Finolex Industries Limited and its CSR Partner Mukul Madhav Foundation signed an agreement with Green Thumb to de-silt Khadakwasla Dam.

On 30th April 2025 in the presence of Mr. Saurabh Dhanorkar, Managing Director Finolex Industries Limited, Mr. Suresh Patil Founder, Green Thumb, Mr. Babalu Mokale, Mukul Madhav Foundation.





Since 2018, with support from the government and corporations such as Praj Foundation, Cummins, Tata Motors, and others, we have successfully contributed to the de-silting of 20 km of the 42 km stretch of the Khadakwasla Dam. FIL-MMF played a key role by supporting the de-silting of 4 km of this stretch. We have received an appeal to support a total of 22 kms out of which MMF and Finolex are supporting 1 kms and cost per km is Rs. 20 lacs.

It has been observed that water in the four dams (Varasgaon, Panshet, Temghar and Khadakwasla) is not proving sufficient to meet the annual water requirements of the city and agriculture. De-silting will automatically increase the water storing capacity of the dam and water requirements of Pune city will be sufficed.

As the water recedes back in month of March, April, May, primitive methods are being adopted by using JCBs, dozer, grader, poclain and dumper truck and tippers to remove the silt. The silt is then pitched and bonded on the periphery of the lake; excess silt is distributed off free to locals & farmers to gain their good will and participation.

Nutrition Kits Distributed to Widowed HIV-Positive Women, Jaipur. 10th May 2025

A special outreach activity was conducted at the CSC Office in Jaipur to distribute nutrition kits to widowed HIV-positive women. This initiative, led by the Mukul Madhav Foundation (MMF), aimed to provide vital nutritional support and raise awareness about the importance of health and treatment adherence among vulnerable women living with HIV.

A total of 10 widowed women attended the event and received nutrition kits. The distribution was carried out by Mr. Dayaram Swami (MMF), who also shared insights about the Foundation's mission and the purpose behind this initiative.

Following the distribution, a support group meeting was held with the beneficiaries. The session focused on two key areas:

- The importance of taking ART (Antiretroviral Therapy) medications on time
- The critical role of nutrition in maintaining health and well-being

The event was graced by the presence of Mrs. Shakira Bano (Project Director) and Mr. Gouran Jain (Project Coordinator), whose support contributed to the program's success.

Key Outcomes:

- Nutritional support provided to 8 HIV-positive widowed women
- Health and treatment education shared through an interactive session
- Follow-up planned for 2 women who were unable to attend
- Strengthened community engagement and support through MMF's ongoing

efforts. The event was a meaningful step toward empowering HIV-positive women through practical support and health education.

Providing Awareness about Nutrition and Hygiene. 12th May 2025

The Nutrition Kit Distribution program, organized with the generous support of the Mukul Madhav Foundation, was held on 12th May 2025 at the Sarthak Manav Kusht Ashram. The primary goal of the initiative was to provide nutritious food and essential hygiene supplies to residents affected by leprosy, and to promote awareness about the importance of health, nutrition, and hygiene.

Total 36 beneficiaries supported the event and it was graced by Shri Dayaram Swami, representative of FIL-MMF. During the event, 31 residents received comprehensive nutrition kits. These items were carefully selected to support the residents' dietary and hygiene needs.

In addition to distribution, two key sessions were conducted:

1. Dialogue Session: An open interaction with residents helped gather insights into their daily lives, health concerns, and needs. This session strengthened community engagement and built trust.

2. Awareness Session: A brief educational segment was conducted to highlight the importance of a balanced diet and personal hygiene. The residents participated with enthusiasm, showing interest in adopting healthier practices.

The program concluded successfully, meeting its objectives of support, education, and community building. Mukul Madhav Foundation considers this effort a meaningful step towards enhancing the quality of life for the residents of the Ashram and remains committed to similar humanitarian initiatives in the future.






Supporting Children with Type 1 Diabetes Across India. 29th April 2025

Mukul Madhav Foundation (MMF), has been providing consistent and compassionate support to children living with Type 1 Diabetes (T1D) across various regions in India. Our holistic approach includes the provision of life-saving insulin, regular health check-ups, and integration of children into ongoing T1D-related research efforts.

This initiative began in 2012 at KEM Hospital, Pune, where MMF started supporting children with monthly insulin and quarterly health assessments and moved in Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, Pune, Daund, Karad and Jalgaon in Maharashtra and in Assam.







We have signed and renewed the agreement with Aaishwarya Shasam Foundation in Daund Dist. Pune where we are supporting 28 children, with Idyayangal Trust, Coimbatore we are supporting 75 children and with Sudhanya Foundation, Assam We are supporting 14 children.

Ophthalmic Clinic Inauguration, Pune. 8th May 2025

Finolex Industries Ltd, in collaboration with its CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation, inaugurated an ophthalmic clinic at Gatha Mandir in Dehu Gaon in 2019, supported by Sassoon General Hospital. The clinic's activities were paused due to the pandemic but resumed on March 23, 2022, with awareness sessions conducted in the village to inform residents of the monthly OPD timings.

Since resuming operations, the clinic has been conducting over 31 screening camps per month and providing free cataract surgeries at Sassoon Hospital. To date, 929 screenings have been completed. The screenings diagnose senior citizens with conditions such as cataract, pterygium, refractive errors, and other infections, with all treatments provided at no cost at Sassoon Hospital.





Empowering Communities, Enabling Change, Odisha & Palghar. 24th May 2025


Mukul Madhav Foundation has partnered with Kherwadi Social Welfare Association to drive impactful community development in Odisha and Palghar through two transformative projects:


Agreement signed on 22nd May 2025 in the presence of Mr. Sunil Kumar Sharma CEO, KSWA and team MMF.

Odisha Project – Protection Health & Environment through Smokeless Chulhas.

Location - Mohana Block, Gajapati District







Objective: Improve women's health, reduce indoor air pollution, combat environmental degradation, and boost local livelihoods by replacing traditional chulhas with Smokeless Chulhas. Training local masons further ensures sustainability and income generation.

Palghar Project – Livelihoods through Organic Farming & Vermi Composting.

Location - Wada Taluka, Palghar District

Empowering 145 women farmers across 5 villages.

Objective: Promote sustainable agriculture, reduce methane emissions, improve soil health, and enhance women's income and resilience through vermi composting and organic farming.



Thalassemia Awareness Session at N M Waida College. 26th April 2025

We organise awareness sessions on Thalassemia followed by thalassemia testing/screening in various colleges along lengths and breadth of Ratnagiri and Pune districts. We also offer them counselling sessions and prescribe medication for anaemia, sickle cell and iron deficiency issues.





FIL/MMF conducted a Thalassemia and Diabetes awareness session at N.M. Wadia College for 50 nursing students. The event included health screenings (CBC, Thalassemia minor, and blood sugar) for all attendees.

Dr. Shweta Shah, a renowned Pediatric Hematologist, Oncologist, and BMT physician, led the Thalassemia session, while Dr. Nileema Nagarkar, Registered Dietician and Certified Diabetes Educator from KEM Hospital, conducted the Diabetes awareness talk.

FIL/MMF continues to support young Thalassemia patients through monthly blood transfusions, medication, and income-generation programs, in collaboration with the Thalassemia Society Pune Chapter, Bharati Hospital, Indian Red Cross, and The Wishing Factory.

To date, we have reached over 4,000 students across 19+ colleges in Pune, Satara, Jalgaon, and Ratnagiri, conducting 4,500+ blood tests and identifying 52 Thalassemia minor cases, followed by expert counseling and treatment.

Mammography Camp. 5th May to 9th May 2025

Mukul Madhav Foundation and Finolex Industries Limited, in collaboration with Bharati Hospital, organized a Mammography Camp from 5th to 9th May 2025 as part of their ongoing monthly health initiative for women aged 35 and above.

The camp offered comprehensive screening and consultations, including:

- Gynaecologist Consultation
- Pap Smear
- Mammography & Sono-Mammography
- CBC (Complete Blood Count)
- HIV Testing
- Dietician Consultation
- Blood Pressure, Height & Weight Measurement

In total, 60 screenings have been completed from April 5th to May 9th, 2025, reinforcing our commitment to preventive healthcare for women.
