


**Date:** July 4, 2025

**Impact:** 140 children given the gift of mobility, this initiative tackles a major barrier to independent, healthy childhoods for under-resourced families.

#### SYMBIOSIS HOSPITAL NICU UPGRADE

**Date:** July 7 & 25, 2025

Activity: Agreement signed for a major upgrade and capacity expansion of the hospital's Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, responding to rising births and critical need for advanced newborn care in 32+ rural villages.

**Impact:** The NICU will help in critical care of new born needs in 32+ villages of the Mulshi Taluka.

**Beneficiaries:** Infants from 32+ villages in the Mulshi block of Pune

#### KEM HOSPITAL NICU ENHANCEMENT

**Date:** July 17, 2025



**Date:** July 26, 2025



**Date:** July 24, 2025

**Implementation Partners:** BAIF Development Research Foundation

**Impact:** Inmate rehabilitation, skill development, and reduced jail operational expenses, advancing a self-sustaining model for institutional farming.

Beneficiaries: Inmates of Yerawada Jail

# S-CAN (STRENGTHENING COMMUNITY ACTION FOR NUTRITION) PHASE-II—COMMUNITY ACTION FOR NUTRITION



Location: Junnar, Maharashtra

**Date:** July 10, 2025

**Activity:** Second phase of project focused on improving nutrition through community engagement, Nutri-Garden establishments, school and household outreach, and public health infrastructure.

**Implementation Partners:** Anusandhan Trust

Impact: Anticipates 10% reduction in undernutrition among children under 6, with 10 Nutri-Gardens, 30 Child Food Corners, stronger local health systems, and over 17,000 people impacted.

**Beneficiaries:** 958 children, 767 parents, 196 pregnant/lactating women; 17,302 population reached

## DONATION OF ROTI MAKING MACHINE TO PANDHARPUR VITTHAL RUKMINI MANDIR



**Location:** Pandharpur Vitthal Rukmini Mandir, Maharashtra

**Date:** July 17, 2025

**Activity:** Donation of a new Roti making machine along with agreement signing for continued support.

**Impact:** Enables the Mandir to serve free lunch and dinner daily to devotees.

**Beneficiaries:** Approximately 5,000 devotees per day.

#### MANGO TREE PLANTATION DRIVE



Location: Panwadi Village,

Maharashtra

**Date:** July 12, 2025

**Activity:** Large-scale plantation of 550 mango trees in association with OneLess along with broad community participation to improve ecological balance and green cover.

**Impact:** Increases village biodiversity, supports shade and fruit for locals, and drives community engagement in long-term environmental stewardship.

Beneficiaries: Entire village community

#### MASS TREE PLANTATION DRIVES



**Location:** Gondawale, Satara, Maharashtra; Mokhampura, Dudu, Jaipur, Rajasthan; Padra Block with six locations, Gujarat

**Date:** July 2025

Activity: Coordinated plantation drives with volunteers, 1,300+ saplings in Satara, 250 at Gondawale (with local youth), 120 at a school in Mokhampura, and ongoing expansion in Padra and Satara.

Impact: Revitalizes barren lands, instills environmental values in youth, and connects communities through shared stewardship with a focus on care and survival of new saplings. (900+ already planted, 3,100 more planned).

#### **GUJARAT TREE PLANTATION INITIATIVE**



**Location:** 10 sites in Gujarat (hospitals, schools, cemeteries, crematoria, PHCs, educational institutions)

**Date:** July 18, 2025

Activity: Launched a plan to add 1,821 saplings of varied ecological value (fruit, shade, medicinal), building on a legacy of 7,000+ trees planted previously in healthcare and community sites.

Impact: Deepens roots of sustainability, supports public health infrastructure and nutritious ecosystems, and celebrates community champions like Dr. Gyanendra Arya.

Beneficiaries: Institutions at all 10 sites

#### TREE PLANTATION AT FINOLEX COLONY



Location: Finolex Colony (Phase III),

**Date:** July 8, 2025

**Activity:** Student-driven tree planting with role models and science-based learning—each sapling tagged for ongoing education and engagement.

**Impact:** Empowers youth as green ambassadors, increases campus biodiversity, and creates a lasting legacy of environmental awareness.

#### WATER CONSERVATION PROJECTS



**Location:** Shelgaon and Ravgaon, Karmala taluka, Solapur, Maharashtra


**Date:** July 25, 2025
