









Description

Situational analysis is a critical first step in planning an education program. It offers a comprehensive understanding of the current environment by identifying strengths, gaps, opportunities, and challenges in the school's ecosystem.

The LLF team conducted a situational analysis across all five schools to ensure the RTL program aligns with the student's specific needs.

The objectives of the situational analysis includes:

- Building rapport with school management, including principals and teachers, to encourage collaboration
- Assessing IT infrastructure and the available resources within the schools
- Gaining insights into the demographics and socioeconomic context of students and surrounding communities
- Developing a tailored strategy for effective program delivery, addressing the unique requirements of each school

- 2. Enrolment of boys in grades 11 and 12 is low, as many prefer Diploma or ITI courses to pursue job opportunities.
- 3. Smart TVs and desktops are available, but stable internet connectivity remains a challenge.
- 4. Some schools already have desktops and a designated computer teacher.
- 5. Majority of students belong to families engaged in agriculture, small-scale animal husbandry, or factory work.
- 6. Parental migration for work often affects student attendance

Collaboration with schools for student data collection and Psychometric Test

Description

- ❖ After conducting the SA in schools, the team focused on collecting data for students in Grades 9-12
- ❖ A list of all Grade 12 students was compiled to create login credentials for the psychometric test
- LLF resource person organized multiple visits and follow up to ensure the accuracy and completeness of the data

Activity

Orientation of school leaders

Description

- Individual orientation meetings were held with school principals to provide an overview of the program, program timelines, and the roles and expectations for their schools.
- These sessions, led by the senior team of LLF, fostered mutual understanding and alignment, setting the stage for effective program implementation.

Key observations during discussion with the school Principals:

- Students in Grade 12 lack basic computer knowledge
- Language barriers and the prevalence of superstitions in the community
- High dropout rates after Grade 10, particularly among girls
- Grade 9-12 students require training on adolescent wellbeing
- Students show more interest in Arts over Commerce streams
- Schools have good infrastructure, and students are polite and open to learning

Enrolment of students & psychometric assessment

Program induction &Training of SRPs towards certification in Career Counselling & Guidance

The psychometric assessment was conducted for students from November 18th onwards in all 5 schools.

The team has successfully completed basic training on:

- ❖ Project implementation model, internal policies, processes
- The team underwent training on customized digital literacy content
- The SRPs have undergone 3 days of training on Career Guidance through a third party, i.e., Dheya. The team was trained on how to analyze the psychometric results and personality traits and counsel students. This training was conducted in the Finolex Office, Vadodara.







Insights from the Psychometric Test

Current Assessment Analysis: The analysis of 218 was conducted. The results show consistent patterns across regions confirming the assessment's reliability:

- 1. Similar percentages of perfectionist profiles
- 2. Comparable distribution of objective thinker profiles
- 3. Expected prevalence of appraiser profiles (communicative, humble, accommodative, sales-oriented individuals)
- 4. Higher business/commercial interests in Gujarat, aligning with regional characteristic




