CERVICAL VACCINATION DRIVE AT MAHATMA GANDHI SCHOOL



Location: Mahatma Gandhi School, Pune, Maharashtra

Date: December 12, 2025

Activity: Finolex Industries, in partnership with Mukul Madhav Foundation, organized a cervical vaccination drive for children aged 9–13 years to protect against HPV-related health risks and cervical cancer. The camp included administration of vaccines and awareness sessions for students and staff.

SUPPORT FOR HUMAN MILK BANKS AND NICU STRENGTHENING

Activity: Finolex Industries Ltd. (FIL), through Mukul Madhav Foundation (MMF), inaugurated an upgraded Human Milk Bank at Bharati Hospital, Pune, with new pasteurisation and milk-banking equipment—strengthening access to safe donor milk for preterm and critically ill newborns.

Impact: Improved newborn nutrition and health outcomes, reduced infection risk, and ensured equitable access to safe breast milk.

CLUBFOOT SUPPORT PROGRAM



Location: Gaya, Bihar

Date: November 24, 2025

Activity: Children born with clubfoot face challenges in walking due to twisted or misshapen limbs. Through the Clubfoot Support Program, braces and surgical interventions are provided to over 320 children from underprivileged families across Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Telangana, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, and Bihar.

On December 29, 2025, support was extended to 10 new beneficiaries. FIL representative Mr. Chandrakant Kumar and team visited Anugrah Narayan Magadh Medical College and Hospital, interacting with the children and their families, discussing treatment progress, and sharing information on ongoing and future support.

SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE



Activity: Finolex Industries Limited and its CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation conducted the foundation ceremony for the development of sanitation facilities at MN Vidyalaya and a multipurpose shed at Shree Sagar Vidyalaya in Padra Block. The interventions were undertaken based on requests from the respective schools and approved after due evaluation. Construction work has been initiated and is planned for completion by March 2026.

INAUGURATION OF MILK ATM AT URULI KANCHAN



Activity: Finolex Industries, through its CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation, in collaboration with BAIF Institute for Sustainable Livelihoods and Development and co-supported by FICCI FLO Pune Chapter, inaugurated a 150-litre Milk ATM under the Udaymita initiative with the Sankalp Self-Help Group. The community-led micro-enterprise is managed by 70 women from various self-help groups and provides affordable milk at ₹40 per litre, promoting economic independence and entrepreneurship.

Impact: Enabled women to run a sustainable livelihood, strengthened community access to affordable milk, and promoted economic independence and empowerment.

Activity: Shakti Run 2025 was organised to raise awareness on women’s safety, gender equality, and collective responsibility in preventing gender-based violence. The event brought together over **1,500 participants**, including women, men, and youth, along with civil society organisations, corporate partners, and state institutions. The run featured a martial arts display by girls from the Srijan Group and a symbolic walk showcasing women in diverse professional roles such as doctors, engineers, lawyers, police officers, athletes, and entrepreneurs.

DRINKING WATER PROJECT INAUGURATION



Activity: A sustainable drinking water facility was implemented for the Parkara Koli tribal community at Narsar Vandh, a remote hamlet under Balasar Gram Panchayat. The project includes a direct pipeline connection from the Narmada mainline, installation of a 50,000-litre overhead storage tank, and community tap stands to ensure safe and equitable access to drinking water.
