# SPECTRUM: HEALTHCARE

## MAMMOGRAPHY AND CERVICAL CANCER AWARENESS INITIATIVE



**Activity:** Finolex Industries Limited and Mukul Madhav Foundation, in partnership with Yardi Foundation and Bharati Hospital, conducted mammography and cervical cancer awareness sessions for sanitation coordinators and women in underserved communities. The initiative covered cancer awareness, the importance of early detection, screening procedures, and camp coordination. Community mobilization efforts resulted in strong participation and registrations for mammography screening. More than 15 communities were also identified for future awareness and screening camps.



**Impact:** Increased awareness and encouraged early cancer screening, with 65 women participating and 45 registering for mammography. The initiative strengthened community engagement and improved access to preventive healthcare.

## THALASSEMIA AND DIABETES AWARENESS & SCREENING INITIATIVE – PUNE AND PCMC



**Activity:** Awareness and screening sessions were conducted across Karve College of Social Service, Bharati Homeopathy College, and ASM CSIT College, focusing on early detection, prevention, and health awareness. A total of 650 students participated, with 432 undergoing blood tests. The sessions were led by Dr. Liza Busare, Consultant Hematologist at Ruby Hall Clinic, and Dr. Neelima Nagarkar, Dietitian at KEM Hospital. This initiative is part of ongoing efforts by Finolex Industries Limited and Mukul Madhav Foundation, which have conducted awareness sessions across 22 colleges since December 2023, facilitating over 5,500 blood tests.
