STRENGTHENING HEALTHCARE THROUGH REFRIGERATORS



Activity: Finolex Industries Limited, in partnership with Mukul Madhav Foundation, extended support to Hemophilia Society Pune Chapter by providing a 315-litre Blue Star refrigerator. This initiative is part of their continued commitment to strengthening healthcare support systems.

Through this support, Finolex Industries Limited and Mukul Madhav Foundation aim to enhance the storage and handling of essential medical supplies required for the care of patients with Hemophilia. MAMMOGRAPHY CAMP

Activity: A mammography camp was conducted in collaboration with Bharati Hospital, where a total of 23 screenings and tests were carried out. The services included gynaecologist consultation, Pap smear, mammography, sono-mammography, CBC (Complete Blood Count), HIV testing, dietician consultation, and blood pressure, height, and weight measurements. This is a monthly camp for women above the age of 35.

Impact: The camp enabled early detection and preventive screening for women above 35 years by providing comprehensive diagnostic services, including mammography and other essential health tests, ensuring timely medical consultation and increased awareness of women's health and cancer prevention.

On this occasion, Plant Admin and IR Head Mr. Sagar Chivte, Dr. Gijabile, Dr. Sayali Ranade, and Mrs. Zore from Nexlyfe Clinico Laboratory were present.

The launch of this Diabetic OPD in a place like Pawas has been highly appreciated by the local residents.

Impact: The establishment of the Diabetic OPD in Pawas has improved access to essential healthcare services, especially for early diagnosis and regular monitoring of diabetes at the community level. The initiative promotes preventive healthcare awareness, enabling residents to manage their health more effectively and reduce complications associated with diabetes.

TB NUTRITION SUPPORT INITIATIVE



Location: Vadodara, Gujarat

Date: 25 April, 2026

Activity: The agreement signed with the District TB Department was successfully completed at the TB Office in Vadodara. In addition, the monthly ration support agreement was formally signed.

Under this initiative, monthly TB nutrition kits will be provided to 200 patients across 9 Primary Health Centres (PHCs) in the Padra and Karjan blocks of Vadodara district. The program will be implemented for a period of one year, from April 2026 to March 2027, ensuring consistent nutritional support to patients undergoing TB treatment.

Impact: The initiative in Vadodara will provide consistent nutritional support to 200 TB patients across 9 PHCs, helping improve treatment adherence and recovery outcomes. Supported by Finolex Industries Limited, the program also reduces the financial burden on patients' families while strengthening efforts toward a TB-free community.

It is expected to reduce the risk of TB transmission among family members, lower TB-related mortality, and significantly improve the overall health and nutritional status of the beneficiaries.

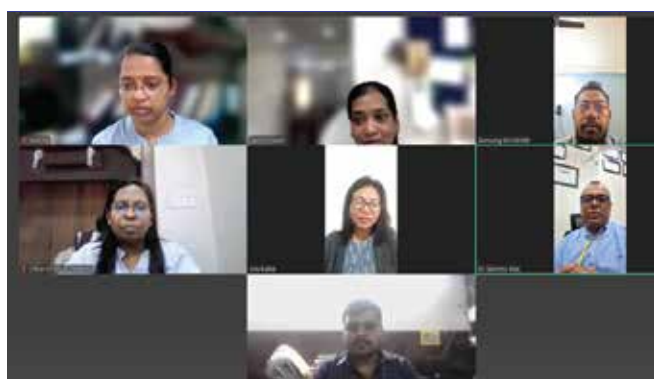
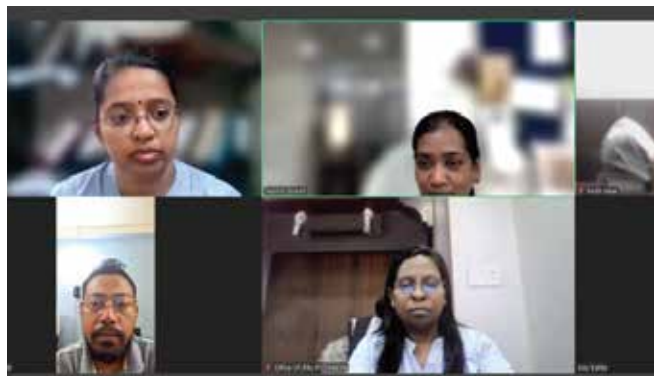

SUPPORTING COMPASSIONATE CANCER CARE



Location: Nagercoil, Kanyakumari,
Tamil Nadu

Date: April 30, 2026

Activity: Finolex industries Ltd. and Mukul Madhav Foundation continue their commitment to supporting compassionate cancer care through their partnership with Sreeram Cancer Trust, Nagercoil, Kanyakumari District.

In 2023, the partnership extended support for a fully equipped palliative care vehicle to strengthen the Trust's home-based cancer care services led by Dr. Senthil Kumar. This support significantly improved the organisation's ability to reach patients across the district, especially in remote and underserved communities.

Dr. Senthil Kumar currently supports more than 250 patients, and the dedicated vehicle has transformed service outreach. Earlier, home visits depended on auto-rickshaws, taxis, and two-wheelers, making access to distant villages difficult. With the vehicle in place, timely, regular, and dignified care has become far more efficient.

Building on this meaningful impact, the partnership has now been renewed for the current financial year to support medicines and medical assistance for palliative care patients on a monthly basis over the next 12 months.

Impact: The initiative has significantly strengthened home-based palliative cancer care in Nagercoil by improving outreach to over 250 patients across remote and underserved areas. The dedicated vehicle has enabled timely, regular, and dignified care delivery, greatly enhancing service efficiency and accessibility while ensuring better continuity of treatment and support for patients and families.

CONSTRUCTING SANITATION UNITS FOR SCHOOLS



Location: Multiple locations across Karnataka

Date: April 08, 2026

Activity: The agreement was signed to support six schools by constructing toilets for boys and girls. A coconut-breaking ceremony was conducted to mark the commencement of the work. The work has begun in Gudibandhe, covering Somenahalli, Adarsha Public School (J.P. Nagara), and Dapparthi.

Impact: The initiative will significantly improve sanitation and hygiene facilities across six schools by providing separate toilets for boys and girls. This will promote better health, reduce absenteeism, especially among girl students, and create a safe and dignified school environment. The project will also support increased school attendance, enhance students' overall well-being, and contribute to long-term behavioral change towards hygiene and cleanliness in the community.

ENABLING SAFE SANITATION AND HYGIENE PRACTICES



Activity: We successfully inaugurated 100 individual household toilets across three villages in the Gadchiroli district.

This initiative goes beyond infrastructure creation. In addition to constructing toilets, the program emphasized awareness on hygiene and cleanliness, while also supporting households with essential sanitation materials such as buckets and mugs.

It has enhanced community awareness on cleanliness and menstrual hygiene, encouraged behavioral change, and strengthened women's sense of ownership and empowerment.

The newly inaugurated lab is expected to provide students with practical exposure, digital resources, and a platform to nurture innovative ideas and start-up initiatives.

We have been associated with Mahatma Gandhi School since 2018. The support began with the provision of computers and has gradually expanded to include monthly salary support for five teachers. Over the years, additional contributions have included distribution of groceries during Diwali, as well as sarees and other essential items for those in need.



Mahatma Gandhi School is dedicated to providing free and quality education to underprivileged children, including orphans and children of prisoners, sex workers, single mothers, and daily wage earners. The initiative aims to bridge the gap between students from disadvantaged backgrounds and those studying in private institutions.

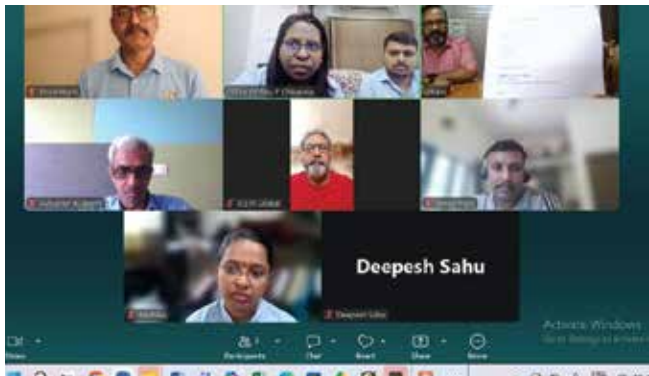

Location: Ranchi, Jharkhand and Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh

Date: April 30, 2026

Activity: Finolex Industries Limited, along with its CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation, continues to support children and adults with deafblindness and multiple disabilities through its ongoing partnership with Sense International India.

On 30th April 2026, the agreement was signed to commence Phase 2 of the Deafblind Projects in Ranchi, Jharkhand and Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh, further strengthening inclusive care and long-term support systems.

The renewed partnership builds on the strong impact created during Phase 1, where specialised interventions included centre-based services, home-based support, therapy linkages, mobility training, family counselling, and inclusive education initiatives.

Impact: The initiative has significantly strengthened inclusive care for individuals with deafblindness by expanding access to specialised services, therapy, education, and family support across Ranchi and Ujjain. Phase 1 established strong regional and state resource hubs while reaching underserved communities and building stakeholder capacity. Building on this foundation, Phase 2 will further expand support to 340 beneficiaries, deepening long-term rehabilitation, inclusion, and opportunities for independent and dignified living.
