SPECTRUM: EDUCATION

SCHOOL TRANSFORMATION PROJECT – KARNATAKA



Activity: Finolex Industries Limited, CSR partner of Mukul Madhav Foundation, has been supporting government schools in Karnataka since 2023 to improve sanitation, safe drinking water, and learning infrastructure.

2023 – Magadi Taluka:

- 41 new toilets constructed
- RO drinking water filters installed
- Benches provided for students

2024 – Koppal District:

- Support extended to 43 schools
- 30 sanitation blocks constructed
- 36 RO units installed
- 720 desks distributed
- Play equipment installed in 2 schools

2025–26 – Gudibande Taluka :

- Agreement signed on February 2, 2026 to support 15 schools
- Installation of 15 RO drinking water units
- Agreement signed during a virtual meeting in the presence of MMF and Samarpaka representatives

Impact:

Improved sanitation, access to safe drinking water, and better learning environments for students across multiple districts.

Finolex Industries Limited and Mukul Madhav Foundation have been associated with the institution for the past 8 years, supporting educational sponsorships, scholarships for girls, pipeline support, and infrastructure development.

Impact: Improved the working environment for caregivers and strengthened the institutional support system for children.

Activity: An agreement was signed with Rayat Shikshan Sanstha for the renovation of boys' and girls' toilets at Shri Hanuman Vidyalaya. Bhoomipujan was conducted on February 14, 2026, marking the formal commencement of the renovation work.

Impact: Improved sanitation facilities, supporting better hygiene, health, and the overall school environment in a rural area.

SUPPORT OF CUPBAORDS TO SHREE SADGURU LIBRARY DEVROUKH RATNAGIRI



Activity: Finolex Industries Limited and Mukul Madhav Foundation signed an agreement with Shree Sadguru Library, Devrukh, Ratnagiri, to support the institution's infrastructure. The meeting was attended by Mr. Joshi, Mr. Paranjpe, and other members of the library.

Activity: Finolex Pipes & Fittings, along with its CSR partner Mukul Madhav Foundation, inaugurated the cremation ground renovation project at Abhor with a Bhoomipujan and agreement signing ceremony. The programme included traditional rituals such as coconut breaking and foundation marking, attended by company representatives, the Svades NGO team, Gram Panchayat members, and the local community.

Ongoing monthly support continues for 60+ institutions, including groceries, medicines, diapers, and other essentials.

THALASSEMIA & DIABETES AWARENESS SESSION AT PUNE



Activity: An awareness session was conducted for 300 students, with 257 blood tests carried out for early screening. The session was led by medical experts from Bharathi Hospital and KEM Hospital. Since December 2023, 23 colleges have been covered, facilitating over 5,000 blood tests.

Impact: Promoted early detection, preventive healthcare, and informed lifestyle choices among youth.

MAMMOGRAPHY & CERVICAL CANCER AWARENESS SESSIONS AT PUNE



Activity: Finolex Industries Limited and Mukul Madhav Foundation successfully conducted their 12th awareness session, reaching a diverse group including school and college teachers, residents of slum communities, non government organization staff, police officers, sanitation workers, Anganwadi workers, security personnel, and other community members.



In addition, the 18th mammography and cervical cancer awareness session was organized in the Pandav Nagar slum area in Pune in collaboration with Yardi Foundation. The session focused on promoting awareness of early detection and preventive healthcare among underserved communities

Impact: Enhanced awareness of cancer prevention and increased mammography registrations among underserved women

Activity: Mukul Madhav Foundation completed its 24th Period Positive Holiday Home, converting unsafe menstrual huts into safe, hygienic, and eco-friendly spaces with toilets, bathing areas, solar lighting, and clean water. The initiative was implemented in partnership with Yuva Parivartan and supported by Finolex Industries Limited.

Impact: Promoted dignity, safety, and menstrual health awareness among tribal women and girls.

GERIATRIC HEALTH CAMP AT SATARA



Activity: A geriatric health camp was conducted in coordination with Sancheti Hospital, HV Desai Hospital, and Kasibai Navale Hospital. A total of 241 patients were screened. The camp included 20 dental referrals, 15 ophthalmology referrals, 150 orthopaedic and physiotherapy cases, and distribution of 15 spectacles.

Impact: Provided comprehensive health screening and referral support for elderly and community members.

FOOD SUPPORT FOR EYE CAMP PATIENTS – CHITRAL GUJARAT



Activity: On the occasion of Mahashivratri, Finolex Industries Limited and Mukul Madhav Foundation initiated ration support for food preparation at eye camps organized by Shree Sanket Charitable Trust, with medical support from Sankara Eye Hospital.

Impact: Ensured dignified meal access for 250–300 patients and their families per camp, while supporting the smooth functioning of rural eye care services across nearly 30 villages.

Activity: Support was provided to the Child Malnutrition Treatment Centre (CMTc) with kitchen equipment including a refrigerator, gas stove, and water jugs. Earlier infrastructure support in 2020 included an RO system, water cooler, beds, and mattresses.

Impact: Improved nutritional care and comfort for children (0–5 years) and mothers from economically vulnerable backgrounds across more than 80 villages.

Activity: Awareness sessions were conducted for students and staff on health, hygiene, disaster safety, and the use of fire extinguishers by the Finolex Industries Limited OHC Medical Officer and EHS Manager.

Impact: Enhanced safety awareness and preventive health knowledge among school communities near the Masar plant.

The camp included comprehensive screenings such as general health check-ups, eye, skin, dental, orthopaedic, prostate, blood, and urine tests. Spectacles were also distributed and follow-up support ensured.



Impact: Improved healthcare access and early detection of medical issues among drivers and support staff, promoting occupational health and well-being.

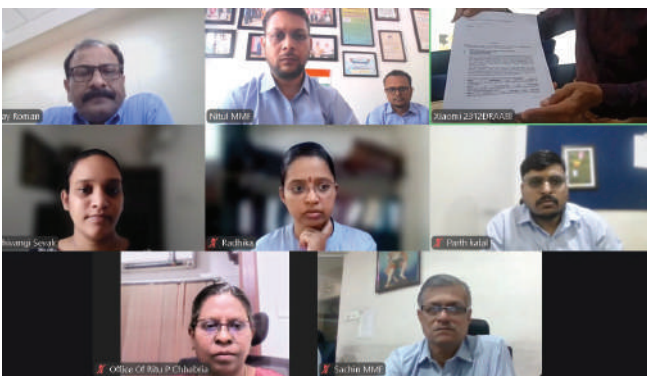
